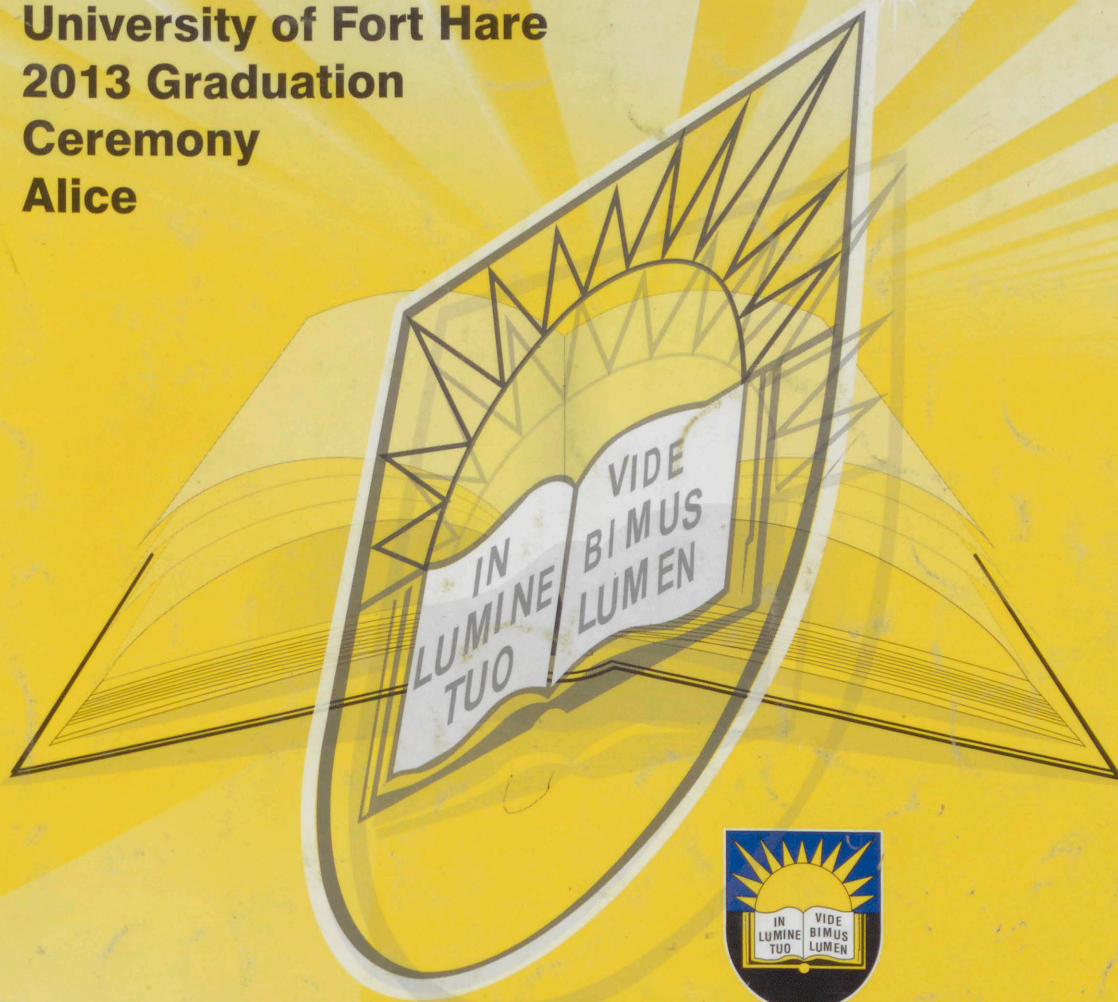

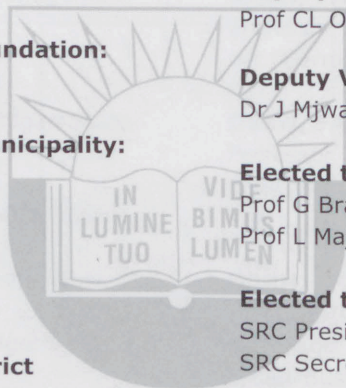

MABINYA Leonard Vuyani - 2010

PROFILE

Leonard Vuyani Mabinya was born at Zwelitsha near King Williams Town. He attended Forbes Grant Secondary and Healdtown High Schools for his secondary education and registered for tertiary studies at the University of Fort Hare. His PhD studies assessed biofloculant production by axenic and consortia cultures of three bacterial isolates including *Arthrobacter* sp. Raats, *Halomonas* sp. Mvuyo and *Micrococcus* sp. Leo. The findings revealed the immense potential of the organisms to produce biofloculant that could stand as alternatives to inorganic and synthetic flocculants use in water treatment. Three articles have so far been published from this research. Mr Mabinya is currently a Senior Lecturer in the Department of Biochemistry and Microbiology at the University of Fort Hare.

Olubukola Sinbad Olorunnisola was born in Nigeria. He obtained his BSc (Biochemistry) and MSc (Biochemistry and Chemical Pathology) both at the University of Ibadan, Nigeria. He registered for his PhD programme in 2010 at the University of Fort Hare. His research was focused on the biochemical actions of *Tulbaghia violacea*, the rhizome of which is used in South African to manage heart diseases.

During the study, he also identified several other plants that are effective in the treatment of cardiovascular diseases. Using *in vivo* and *in vitro* experiments Olubukola was able to validate and justify the use of this plant in the management of diet induced atherogenic disease and also discovered likely biochemical mechanisms of action of the plant. The three examiners praised this project as an outstanding research work from which he has published 8 articles in international journals.

Mavula Kikwe Vala, from the Democratic Republic of Congo, holds a BSc in Chemistry and two Masters Degrees in Science: one in Environmental Management (University of Kinshasa, DR Congo) and the other in Chemistry (University of Fort Hare, South Africa). He also holds a Rhodes University-SADC International Certificate in Environmental Education and two certificates in National Evaluation Capacity Development for Country-led M & E Systems and Emerging Practices in Development administered by UNICEF in

collaboration with Claremont Graduate University, International Organisation for Cooperation in Evaluation (IOCE) and the Rockefeller Foundation. With these qualifications and experience, it comes as no surprise that Mavula, who speaks fluent French and English, has been a very effective mentor to a lot of students in the Department of Chemistry over the years.

For his PhD thesis entitled "Development & Evaluation of Modified Lignocellulose-Clinoptilolite Composites for Water Treatment". His external examiners highly commended the originality of his work in which he prepared novel materials which showed excellent adsorption and nano-filtration properties in the removal of dyes, cyanide and used motor oil from polluted water. The new materials were prepared from natural grass and clinoptilolite from Heidelberg in the Western Cape, South Africa. Seven manuscripts which are either in press or under review for publication have been generated from his research. The candidate recently presented his work at the UNESCO international conference.

Anthony Ayodeji Adegoke is a lecturer at the University of Uyo in Akwa Ibom State, Nigeria. His Ph.D research is titled "Commensal bacteria belonging to the *Staphylococcus*, *Acinetobacter* and *Stenotrophomonas* genera as reservoirs of antibiotic resistance determinants in the environment of Nkonkobe Municipality, Eastern Cape Province, South Africa". With the benefit of culture and molecular based techniques he established that antibiotic resistance genes are resident in farm animals, plants' rhizosphere and the environment suggesting the need for the prudent use of antibiotics.

The findings of this study have been presented in both national and international conferences as well as published as three articles in accredited journals. He is married to Mrs Olufunso Adegoke and they're blessed with three children.

PROFILE

Mr. Vincent Nnamdigadi Chigor was born on July 13th 1970 in Igbo land, Nigeria. Before his arrival at the University of Fort Hare as a PhD student in March 2010, Mr. Chigor studied at Boys' High School, Umuoji (1983 – 1989), the University of Nigeria, Nsukka (BSc [Hons.] in Microbiology, 1997) and at Ahmadu Bello University, Zaria, Nigeria (MSc in Microbiology, 2004). Having joined the University of Nigeria as an Assistant Lecturer in 2006, Mr. Chigor was, in 2009, awarded the Education Trust Fund Grant to pursue his PhD degree. Chigor's doctoral study assessed the water quality, incidence of enteric viruses and microbial risks in the Buffalo River, an important water resource in the Eastern Cape Province of South Africa. He demonstrated a lack of correlation between the human enteric viruses detected (adenoviruses, hepatitis A virus, rotaviruses and enteroviruses) and all the tested chemical and bacteriological parameters. With Quantitative Microbial Risk Assessment data that revealed unacceptably high risks of enteric

virus infections, he concluded that the Buffalo River and its dams are contaminated waters that may constitute significant public health hazards. The study has been presented in some national and international conferences and so far published as 4 articles in accredited journals.

Mr. Chigor is a member of the Nigerian Society for Microbiology, the American Society for Microbiology and the South African Society for Microbiology.

During his studentship, Mr. Chigor served as the Pastor of *Rock of Ages International*, Fort Hare Congregation from March 2011 to March 2013. Mr. Chigor is married to Chinyere Chigor and they are blessed with 2 sons.

PROFILE

Sekelwa Cosa was born in Middledrift in the Eastern Cape of South Africa. She had her

primary and secondary education in Port Elizabeth. She graduated with Bsc. (Hons) – *Cum laude* and Msc degree in Microbiology in 2010 and 2011 respectively from the University of Fort Hare. Her doctoral research was based on exploring for safe and environmentally friendly alternatives to the conventional chemical flocculants used in water treatment and other downstream processes and which have been well documented to have hazardous properties. To achieve this, she assessed bioflocculant production by three bacterial species including *Oceanobacillus* sp. Pinky, *Halobacillus* sp. Okoh and *Virgibacillus* sp. Rob which were isolated from the sediment samples of Algoa bay, South Africa. Key highlight of the study is the production of bioflocculants by consortia of the organisms which showed high flocculating efficiency in treatment of river water and some wastewaters and promises to be an important alternative to the hazardous chemical flocculants that are currently widely used in water treatment.

Her findings bear credence to the need to explore our indigenous microbial resources within the framework of sustainable development. From this work, five articles have been published in various international peer-reviewed journals, as well as presented in several national and International conferences.

Sekelwa won Top Student Award at the South African Society for Microbiology Conference in 2011. She is a member of South African Society of Microbiology (SASM), Federation of European Microbiological Societies (FEMS) and reviews for some international journals. She is currently a

Postdoctoral Research Fellow at the University of KwaZulu Natal.

Isoken Igbinsosa was born in Benin City, Nigeria. She obtained a Bachelor of Science (Hons) degree in Microbiology from the Obafemi Awolowo University Ile-Ife, Nigeria in 2006 and Honours degree in Microbiology from University of Fort Hare, South Africa in 2008. In 2010, she obtained a Masters of Science in Microbiology *Cum laude* from University of Fort Hare and immediately proceeded for her PhD studies. Her doctoral thesis assessed the incidences of commensal *Pseudomonas* and *Aeromonas* species in the Eastern Cape Province of South Africa, and their potentials as reservoirs of antibiotic resistance in the environment. The study demonstrated that commensal *Pseudomonas* and *Aeromonas* in the studied

microhabitat are highly multidrug resistant and consequently of importance to clinical and public health especially from the perspectives of antimicrobial chemotherapy options for infections associated with *Pseudomonas* and *Aeromonas* species.

Also, the presence of integrons gene cassettes and virulence determinants in some of the *Pseudomonas* and *Aeromonas* strains suggests these bacteria to be potential reservoirs of antibiotic resistance determinants in the environment of the Eastern Cape Province.

The findings of the study have been presented in both national and international conferences and has so far been published as 5 articles in accredited journals. She is a member of several professional bodies among which are Organization for Women in Science for the Developing World (OWSD), South African Society for Microbiology (SASM), Water Institute of Southern Africa (WISA) and Nigerian Red Cross Society. Isoken is married to Dr. Etinosa Igbinsosa and blessed with children.

Miss Siziwe Koba was born on the 1st of August 1986 in Port Elizabeth. She did her primary education in Romanslaagte Primary School in Queenstown and her secondary school in Sakhisizwe Senior Secondary School in Port Elizabeth. She proceeded to register at the University of Fort Hare for a Bachelor of Science Degree in Microbiology and Biochemistry.

In 2008, she registered for Honours degree programme in Microbiology and in and duly went on to register for Masters upon completion in 2009. Her PhD thesis, under the supervision of Prof AI Okoh, was titled "Assessment of the incidence of *E.coli* in Tyume and Bufallo rivers in the Eastern Cape Province of South Africa". The investigations revealed the presence of several *Escherichia coli* pathotypes with the Enteroaggregative and Enterotoxigenic *E.coli* been dominant. Also, the drug resistant profiles of these pathogenic *E.coli* strains were established and it was found that a large proportion were multi drug resistant (MAR).

Furthermore, genes responsible for antibiotic resistance were also detected in the organisms. The findings suggest that use of untreated river water for domestic purposes might have public health implications, considering the virulence of some of the *E. coli* pathotypes such as the *E.coli* O157:H7 which recently caused serious outbreaks in Europe.

PROFILE

Mr Uchechukwu Nwodo hails from Amachara-Ovoko, Igbo-Eze South LGA, Enugu State, Nigeria. His primary and secondary education was at Model Primary School Secretariat Rd. and Federal Science College respectively, in Sokoto State, Nigeria. His higher education started at the University of Nigeria, Nsukka where he obtained a B.Sc. combined honors in Microbiology and Biochemistry. Similarly, he obtained a M.Sc. (Medical Virology) in the same institution, after a gallant one year compulsory national youth service.

His PhD thesis was on the evaluation of consortia of three freshwater actinobacterial species including *Streptomyces* sp. Gansen, *Brachybacterium* sp. UFH and *Cellulomonas* sp. Okoh for bioflocculant production. The conditions needed for optimal production of bioflocculants by the axenic cultures were established and the bioflocculants were found to be heteropolysaccharide and glycosaminoglycan

polysaccharides in nature. Their morphologies were lattice and maze like structures of interlaced flakes as well as horizontal pleats of membranous sheets closely packed. In addition, the application of actinobacteria species in pairwise consortium for bioflocculant production and media optimization for the consortia via response surface methodology showed critical media components and optimum concentrations needed for the production of the bioflocculants. The findings from the investigations is anticipated to yield the following prospects (1) replace the conventionally used flocculants which are hazardous to human health and the environment, (2) source of revenue to the University of Fort Hare and the research team as relevant agencies are prospecting on their economic viability.

Three conference presentations and four articles have been published from this research in international peer-reviewed journals, while others papers are pending publication.

Timothy Sibanda was born in Kadoma, Zimbabwe, and grew up in Filabusi, Matabeleland South Province. He attended JZ Moyo High School before proceeding to Midlands State University where he obtained a BSc Hons Degree in Biological Sciences in 2005. He worked as a Biology teacher between 2006 and 2007. In 2008, he joined Lupane State University as a Teaching Assistant in the Department of Agriculture. In 2009, he came to the University of Fort Hare, South Africa, to study Microbiology at MSc level and conducted his research at the Applied and Environmental Microbiology Research Group (AEMREG). He completed his MSc the same year. In March 2010, Timothy began his PhD work in the same group under the tutelage of Professor A.I Okoh in a WRC funded project. In his PhD thesis, Timothy assessed the fitness of use of Tyume River water for different categories of use ranging from domestic, recreational and agricultural purposes. He used culture-based methods for isolating and quantifying faecal indicator bacteria; and real-time PCR techniques for quantitatively detecting enteric viruses in water samples.

His findings indicated that the river is polluted with human faecal matter, presumably coming from wastewater treatment plant effluents. Unacceptably high counts of faecal indicator bacteria and enteric viruses were detected in the river thus presenting a considerable public health risk to people exposed to it.

To date, Timothy has published six articles in peer-reviewed journals from the study as well as presented the finding in several conferences. Timothy is happily married to Elisa Sibanda and they're blessed with a child.

PROFILE

Sunday Yiseyon Hosu was born in Gboje; Ado-Odo in Ogun State of Nigeria. He completed Bachelor's degree in Agricultural Economics and Farm Management from the Federal University of Agriculture, Abeokuta, Nigeria in 2004. He obtained a Masters Degree from Nigeria's premier university: the University of Ibadan, Nigeria, in 2007.

Sunday worked as a cashier in a Community Bank in Nigeria for 3 years. He has also worked as an Economist/Capital Market Analyst in the Nigerian Capital Market from 2006 to 2009. He also had the opportunity to work in a project office, Paragon Holdings Ltd as a Project Monitor till February 2011, the post from which he resigned to embark on his doctoral studies.

His PhD thesis is a holistic attempt to know the determinants of food system among the poor households in the semi-arid region; the Eastern Cape Province of South Africa. He focused on modeling small farms' optimal productivity under stressed environmental conditions, resource utilisation and effective institutional services provision. His study made insights on the necessary conditions to boost smallholder

productivity and food security among the small-holder farmers in the Eastern Cape Province. Presently, 3 papers from his thesis are under review.

Before joining University of Fort Hare in 2011, Douglas studied at Kyambogo University and Makerere University in Uganda, obtaining a Diploma in Food Processing Technology, B (Hons) Agribusiness Management and MSc. Agricultural and Applied Economics. Subsequently, he worked with the Department of Agricultural Economics at Makerere University before joining the UK volunteer agency, VSO, as livelihood development advisor in Ghana. Douglas runs the NGO: *Springs of Hope Foundation International* (SHFI).

For his thesis, Douglas employed diverse statistical and econometric techniques to quantify for the first time in South African agriculture such components of human dimensions as entrepreneurial spirit and positive psychological capital and established their strong influence on farm commercialization. The candidate makes policy recommendations with important practical implications for agrarian reform in the Eastern Cape and beyond. Four articles have been accepted for publication and two manuscripts are under active review. The candidate and supervisor gratefully acknowledge the financial and intellectual support of the Water Research Commission (WRC).

Kenneth Nhundu was born in Gweru, Zimbabwe on the 7th of February 1980. He graduated with a B.Sc (Hon) in Agricultural Economics in August 2003 from the University of Zimbabwe. In December 2003, he was employed as an Agricultural Economist in the Irrigation Department, Ministry of Water Resources Development & Development. He was appointed a Chief Agricultural Economist in the same department in 2004, a position he held until he decided to pursue further studies.

In 2008, Kenneth enrolled with the University of Fort Hare, where he obtained his second B.Sc (Hon) in Agricultural Economics (*cum laude*) and M.Sc in Agricultural Economics in 2009 & 2010 respectively. His studies up to Ph.D were funded by the Zimbabwe Presidential Scholarship.

His Ph.D thesis applies the New Institutional Economics theory to evaluate the effectiveness of irrigation water institutions in the management of water resources. The major policy implications being that water management stakeholders should not

uncritically embrace the formal state-based institutions as a panacea for water management, but these should be amalgamated with the localised informal rules to bring forth a real integrated irrigation water resource management framework. One of the examiners commended, *"This is a timely research..."*

To date, Kenneth has contributed a book chapter, publications and several conferences papers. He also scooped a Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation Travel Award and best poster presentation during the joint AAAE/AEASA conference, 2010 in Cape Town, featuring students from the continent.

PROFILE

Born in Nigeria, Peter Olutope Fayemi attended the University of Agriculture Abeokuta (UNAAB) for his Bachelor's degree (B.Agric. Hons) and Masters (M. Agric) in Monogastric Animal Nutrition. In 2010, he enrolled for his doctoral studies at the University of Fort Hare.

Through a series of carefully planned experiments in his PhD programme, he ventured into one of the hottest topics in molecular genetics where ovUCH L1mRNA and ovPAG-1mRNA quantitation was done from electro-stunned sheep. Combining a multi-disciplinary approach with state-of-the-art facilities, he critically described the muscular architecture and qualities of offal from sheep. The novelty of Olutope's research led to the discovery and patenting of two biomarkers coding for pain and pregnancy. This colossal achievement makes him the first student in the

history of the Department of Livestock and Pasture Science to attain this feat. All the three examiners applauded the innovativeness of his findings. So far, three papers have been published and six others under review from this PhD work.

He has also presented four papers at national and international conferences, including the prestigious 58th International Congress on Meat Science and Technology (ICoMST) in Montreal, Quebec Province, Canada in August 2012. To date, Olutope has published five articles in international peer-reviewed journals. He is a member of the World's Poultry Science Association, South African Society for Animal Science and the American Meat Science Association. Olutope is so grateful to his supervisor (Prof. V. Muchenje) for his iconic intellectual prowess and amiable approach. He also thanks his sponsors GMRDC Project C263, the NRF (Projects T079 and T134) and the THRIP (Project T113)/Red Meat Research and Development Trust (RMRDT) of South Africa for funding his research.

PROFILE

Thobela Nkukwana was born in Durban, KwaZulu-Natal Province, spent her toddler years in Toleni village in Butterworth, Eastern Cape Province, and then moved to Welkom, Free State Province, where she completed her primary and secondary education. She obtained the BSc. (Animal Production Science) degree in Agriculture in 1999 at the then University of the North and a MSc. in Poultry Science (Animal Nutrition) in 2005 at the University of KwaZulu-Natal. In 2004, she joined NuTec Southern Africa (a subsidiary of Astral) as a mono-gastric nutritionist; and left in August 2005 to join the University of Fort Hare (UFH) as a lecturer, until to date.

Thobela registered for her PhD programme in Animal Science at the UFH as a part-time student in 2008. For her thesis, a comprehensive study, the first of its kind, to evaluate the effect of supplementing *Moringa oleifera* leaf meal at additive level as a possible alternative to antibiotic growth promoters (AGPs) in broiler nutrition, with focus on growth performance, intestinal health and histomorphology, carcass yield and composition, as well as meat physico-chemical attributes, fatty acid profiles, antioxidant activities and bone breaking strength, was conducted. Currently, the use of antibiotic growth promoters is a heated debate that concerns animal nutrition, meat safety and human health arenas.

The thesis is a result of successful collaborations between the University of Fort Hare, University of Stellenbosch and INTA (in Argentina) that used the state-of-the-art commercial poultry rearing facilities, laboratory equipment and experts in fields of poultry production, meat science, fatty acid and oxidation studies. It was found that supplementation of *M. oleifera* leaf meal at additive levels of up to 5% of the bird's dry matter intake has potential to act as a natural feed additive in broiler nutrition that would address public health concerns without compromising the bird's genetic potential for optimal productivity.

From this thesis, six manuscripts are at different stages of review in high impact international journals, such as *Food Chemistry*, *Animal*, *Poultry Science* and *Livestock Science*. Two papers will be presented at the 59th International Congress on Meat Science and Technology (ICoMST) in Turkey, and 3 more at the 46th South African Society for Animal Science (SASAS) in Bloemfontein. Thobela is a first born child, and a mother to Likamva, and her nephew Buhle.

Obert Tada was born 34 years ago in the Midlands Province of Zimbabwe where he attained his primary and high school education. He completed the BSc (Hons) and MSc Degrees in Animal Science at the University of Zimbabwe. He then worked as a lecturer at Midlands State University and Africa University before registering for PhD studies in 2010 under an Adam Fleming Nguni Cattle Project bursary.

He researched on the Nguni Cattle Project, a tripartite project involving the University of Fort Hare (UFH), Industrial Development Co-operation and the Eastern Cape Department of Rural Development and Agrarian Reform. Using a novel technique of choice experiments in determining economic weights of preferential traits in cattle, the first of its kind in the world, he managed to conceptualize a breeding model of enterprises practicing *in-situ* conservation of farm animal genetic resources. An economic weight-dependent culling method and a two-tier open nucleus mating strategy were formulated. From his thesis, Obert has published 4 peer-reviewed articles in high impact reputable journals which include *Tropical Animal Health and Production*, and *Livestock Science*. Two more articles are under review. Obert presented parts of his work at two conferences, the 45th

Congress of South Africa Society of Animal Science (SASAS) and the 1st International Research Conference of Technology (Zimbabwe). To his name, Obert has 12 journal articles and 4 conference proceedings. He is a member of the Zimbabwe Young Scientists Academy. He holds an FIVB Level 1 Coaching Certificate. 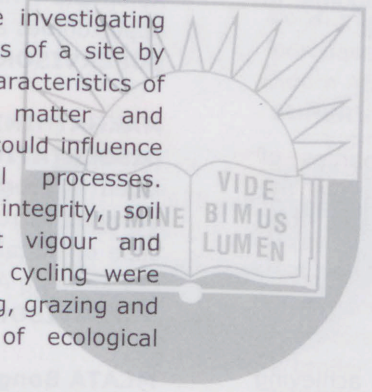

The study has shown that through their effect on vegetation characteristics and organic matter, burning, grazing and browsing could have subsequent effects on some ecological processes of the rangeland ecosystem. HONORARY DOCTORATE DEGREE

CITATION: MR JOHN PAMPALLIS - SPECIAL ADVISOR TO THE MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION AND TRAINING - DOCTOR OF EDUCATION (D ED) (HONORIUS CAUSA)

PROFILE

John Pampallis is special advisor to the Minister of Higher Education, Dr Blade Nzimande. Before that he was Director of the Centre for Education Policy Development, Evaluation and Management (CEPD) from 1997 to 2009. The CEPD is a professionally autonomous Centre established in 1993 on the initiative of the mass democratic movement in order to start developing education policy for a democratic South Africa.

Before moving to the CEPD Mr Pampallis worked as a Research Coordinator and then Director of the Education Policy Unit at the University of Natal. In these capacities he has contributed to the development of new policies for basic education for post apartheid South Africa. He has been particularly active in the development of policies for the governance of schooling. He was also a prominent member of the influential Hunter's Committee on the Organisation Governance and Funding of schools which led to the conceptualisation of the South African Schools Act of 1996. The Hunter Committee was appointed by the Minister of Education to review the organisation governance and funding of education in South Africa. In addition Mr Pampallis has written, edited and acted as a

consultant for a number of publications on education transformation in South Africa as well as the history of the liberation struggle. Before 1991 he taught in schools in South Africa, Botswana, Canada and Tanzania.

As Director of the CEPD, Mr. Pampallis in 2001, was instrumental in establishing an Education Policy Consortium (EPC), which is a partnership of four university-based Education Policy Units, including the one which was based at the University of Fort Hare. The most significant activities of this consortium have been associated with a joint Sida/Dutch programme of research on Human Rights, Democracy and Social Justice in Education and a large research project on Rural Education in South Africa which was conducted with the HSRC for the Nelson Mandela Foundation. Several publications have been produced out of this research. They include the seminal works one entitled, *Emerging Voices: a Report on Education* published by the Nelson Mandela Foundation. The other publication which Mr. Pampallis co-edited is entitled, *Democracy and Human Rights in Education and Society*, published by Orebro University in Sweden.

As a researcher and writer disseminating progressive ideas, Mr Pampallis has other

extensive experience in the fields of education, social and economic development. His contribution in this regard is backed by a series of publications covering titles on non-racialism and gender equality. Amongst the publications are the following:

- *Foundations of the New South Africa*
- *Private Schooling: Problems of Elitism and Democracy in Education.*
- *Education in a Future South Africa: Issues for Policy Transformation*
- *Education and Equity: The Impact of State Policies on South African Education*
- *Developing School Infrastructure through Public-Private Partnerships*
- *Ten Years after: Education and Social Change in South Africa*

In addition to the above, Mr. Pampallis was series editor of 13 other publications of biographies called **'They Fought for Freedom'**.

Mr Pampallis' passion for education, justice and democracy can be seen not only in his writings but also in the activism that has characterised his life. From May 1980 to December 1989 he was in exile in Tanzania working as a staff member of the Solomon Mahlangu Freedom College (SOMAFCO). He taught History and English, was head of Social Science Department as well as Deputy Vice-Principal of the college. SOMAFCO was established and operated by the African National Congress for the education of South African exiles in Tanzania. His progressive ideas on non-racialism and gender equality saw Mr Pampallis, as director of the

CEPD, introduce a very successful praxis oriented programmes, among which are the *Capacity Building Internships* and *Forums*.

Under the Capacity Building Internships the CEPD recruits young research professionals and develop them in all aspects of the Centre's work over a one year period – primarily in research on education and social transformation. This programme started in 1997 and the CEPD normally has two interns at any one time. Former interns have generally moved onto responsible positions in the areas of education research or education management. These internships have been extended to the members of the EPC based at four universities around the country.

The *Forums* programme organises regular events and debates on education and social transformation. One of the most successful is the annual Solomon Mahlangu Memorial Lecture. This event was established to honour the Memory and Spirit of Solomon Mahlangu and the ideals for which he paid the ultimate price – a free and equal society in which education would be free and open to all.

The life and work of Mr John Pampallis during the liberation struggle, at the CEDP and currently at Department of Higher Education and Training epitomizes what is espoused in the University of Fort Hare vision and mission.

The University of Fort Hare is honoured to be associated with such a stalwart of education and liberation.

Gladwin Bhebhe was born at Mtshabezi Mission, Zimbabwe. He holds a diploma in education from Hillside Teachers' College, a Bachelor of Education Degree from University of Zimbabwe, Master's Degree, Educational Administration Planning and Policy Studies from Zimbabwe Open University. Currently a lecturer at Midlands State University, Bhebhe registered for PhD at the University of Fort Hare, in 2009.

Bhebhe's study critically explored stakeholder participation in strategic planning processes at three colleges of education in Zimbabwe. It adopted an interpretive paradigm and case study design. It was informed by the combination of Lewin's Planned Change and Arnsteins' Ladder of Participation Theories. These theories also provided data collection frameworks. The study found that strategic planning participation was not all inclusive and the Ministry focuses on the product activities, and seem to ignore the process activities which may promote continuous improvement.

The examiners agreed that the study has theoretical significance and contributes to policy implications in public participation in the

strategic planning processes. One examiner observed that the study provided frameworks that reveal the nuance messages that influence and shape stakeholder participation in the strategic planning processes.

Her study is titled *The Implementation of Tourism curriculum in Secondary schools in Fort Beaufort district, Eastern Cape Province: Implications for sustainable Tourism*. The study adopted a post-positivist paradigm and used concurrent triangulation design as the operational framework for collecting data. The study established a serious shortage of qualified, specialized and experienced Tourism teachers; lack of use of new teaching strategies and assessment; lack of resources and no support and monitoring was given to teachers. The study recommended an ongoing training of teachers, SMTs and subject advisors that should be guided by a framework that is specifically designed for the implementation of Tourism curriculum. The study came up with a new framework or model for the implementation of Sustainable Tourism curriculum.

Bukiwe is a Deputy Chief Education Specialist (DCES) in Fort Beaufort district, Eastern Cape. She presented two papers on different aspects on the implementation of curriculum in national conferences.

The study adopted a post-positivist paradigm and used mixed methods approach and concurrent triangulation design as the operational framework for collecting data.

The study revealed that there are problems of inadequacy of institutional resources; negative attitudes of students; lack of trained professionals; and lack of monitoring of programmes. It also showed that the dominant methods used to implement HIV and AIDS programmes are not appropriate and that research-oriented and value-driven strategies have more impact on the attitudinal behavioural changes of students. The study came up with an alternative model (Higher Education Institutions Based- Curriculum Implementation Programme Model) which the researcher believes would ameliorate the situation.

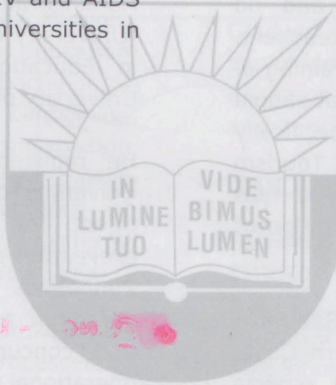

PROFILE

Sindisile Maclean was born in Ginsberg, King William's Town. He is the third born child in a family of five siblings. He is married and blessed with children. He registered at Fort Hare in 2004 to do his Master's degree in Public Administration and completed with three distinctions. In 2009 he registered for his Doctoral Studies which he completed in 2012. Maclean's thesis is entitled "*Assessing Financial Viability of Selected Urban and Rural Municipalities in the Eastern Cape*".

The study argues that municipalities, particularly small and rural ones are not self-sufficient and rely on external funding, including grants, transfers and equitable share to satisfy their immediate goals of meeting basic service delivery needs of communities. The study asserts that most municipalities lack the required financial resources to undertake their constitutional obligations. The research contends that municipalities do not properly and strategically collect tax and rates due to them to augment their revenue.

Major findings include that the municipalities have little borrowing capacity, and that small municipalities have households as their main revenue contributors. Metropolitan municipalities get their big slice of revenue from business. The study recommends that municipalities must meet their targets of revenue collection and management in order to improve their cash flow so that they do not heavily rely on external funding.

All examiners commended the thesis as excellent academic work worthy of award. The candidate was supervised by Professor Dovhani Reckson Thakhathi.
