# HONORARY DOCTORATE DEGREE

## CITATION OF: HON. JEREMY PATRICK CRONIN, MP, DEPUTY MINISTER OF TRANSPORT (Graduation, May 2011)

Mr. Jeremy Patrick Cronin, MP, was born in Durban on 12 September 1949 to Denis and Freda Kemp Cronin. He is married to Gemma Paine and they have two adult children (a son and a daughter).

In his early years, Mr. Cronin attended St Joseph's College, Cape Town. He holds a Bachelor of Arts (Hons) degree from the University of Cape Town and a Master of Arts degree from the Sorbonne University, Paris in France. He lectured at the University of Cape Town from 1973 to 1976.

Mr Cronin is a long-standing leader of the South African Communist Party (SACP) and the African National Congress (ANC). He is a writer, author and published poet.

In pre-democratic South Africa, Mr Cronin contributed to the end of the apartheid regime in various capacities. He worked in the underground unit of the national liberation movement in the early 1970s, mainly in the preparation and dissemination of the banned ANC and SACP material. His work brought him to the attention of the apartheid security forces leading to his arrest in 1976. He was sentenced to seven years imprisonment (1976-1983) for his activities and served his sentence at the Pretoria Maximum-Security Prison.

Following his release from prison, he began working with the United Democratic Front (UDF) which was founded in 1983 and in which he served as its Political Education Officer and editor of its theoretical journal called *Isizwe* (The Nation). He was also involved in various programmes of popular education, but in the late 1980s, increased harassment from the security forces forced him and his wife to leave South Africa and move first to London, and subsequently to Lusaka in Zambia, where he worked closely with the late Joe Slovo for the ANC/SACP alliance.

With the unbanning of the political parties and movements 1990, Mr. Cronin returned to help re-establish the SACP and the ANC in South Africa and to assist in the establishment of a new South Africa. During this period, he played an important role, through his writings, in the re-building of the SACP as a legal mass-vanguard party. He also played a leading role as negotiator at the CODESA Multiparty Negotiations between 1991 and 1993 as a delegate of the SACP. In 1991, he was elected to the National Executive Committee (NEC) of the ANC, a position which he still holds to this day. He was elected Deputy Secretary-General of the South African Communist Party in 1995, a position which he also still holds. In 1999, he was elected to the National Assembly and has been a Member of Parliament since then. Between 1999 and 2009 he was Chairperson of the Portfolio Committee on Transport in the National Assembly. On 11 May 2009, he was appointed by the president to the position of Deputy Minister of Transport.

Indeed, Mr. Cronin is both an activist and an intellectual. His intellectual contributions to major theoretical and political debates in South Africa are unmatched in the broader liberation movement. His extensive writings in the progressive publications genre domestically and internationally include the African Communist, *Umsebenzi*, *Umrabulo* and *Mayibuye*, *Monthly Review* and *Links* and the *Ideologies of Politics* which he edited in 1975. Among some of his political writings are "The national democratic struggle, and the question of transformation" (1986) and "A mass-driven transformation" (1994). Together with Professor Raymond Sutner, he authored the book "30 years of the Freedom Charter", published in 1985, and the subsequent "50 years of the Freedom Charter," published in 2006. Mr. Cronin is also a published poet. His poetic works include *Inside*, which was published in

1983 while he was still in prison. His other collections of poems include *Even the Dead* (1997) and *More Than A Casual Contact* (2006). Some of these poems, depicting the conditions of oppression, struggle and often with Mr. Cronin's usual sense of humor, are being read in South African classrooms and at arts and cultural events in the country. For his writings, Mr. Cronin has been the recipient of two awards, namely, the Sidney Clouts Award given to him in 1997 by the Rhodes University Institute for the Study of English in Africa and the Ingrid Jonker prize for Poetry by the Afrikaanse Skrywerigilde awarded to him in 1984.

Throughout the greater part of his life, Mr. Cronin has worked tirelessly for the establishment of a new South Africa based on respect for human rights and democracy, non-racialism, gender equality, and progressive social, educational and economic development of South African society.

As a white person and communist, Mr. Cronin's contribution is immeasurable. In apartheid South Africa, his political convictions and activities meant that he had to abandon the privileges associated with being a white person; instead, he dedicated much of his life to the liberation of the black majority of South Africans.

Mr. Cronin is well known for his deeper understanding of democracy. He has been consistent in advancing a vision where the people, not its leaders, drive change in all spheres of society. He is a strong advocate of "participatory democracy", and not just "representative democracy", and that for the South African government's endeavours to succeed in its programme for a better life for all, it needs an active citizenry.

Mr. Cronin's political and poetic writings are a reflection of

his deep commitment to a society without class, racial and gender oppression, a society that is organized around the logic and goal of meeting the social needs of the people rather than profit maximization.

The leading role of Mr. Cronin to his organizations and society, and his commitment to encouraging debate and discussion over the future direction of our society, including socio-economic development, broadly conforms to the vision and mission of the University of Fort Hare.

#### ADELEKE FUNMINYI ABIODUN

##### PROFILE

Mr. Adeleke Funminyi Abiodun was born on 23 December 1965 in Nigeria. He was educated at St. Peter's Anglican Primary School and Oduduwa College, Ile-Ife. He then studied at Ibadan Polytechnic where he graduated with a National Diploma in Secretarial Studies in 1987. He obtained his Bachelor of Laws (Hons) degree from Obafemi Awolowo University, Ile-Ife in 1994. In 1995 he attended the Nigerian Law School and was called to the Nigerian Bar as a Barrister-at-Law. He served his compulsory National Youth Service programme in 1996. He obtained his Master of Laws degree in 1998 from the University of Lagos. He was admitted as a member of the Nigerian Institute of Management (AMNIM) in 2005.

In May 1999 Mr. Adeleke was appointed Lecturer II at Lagos State University where he is currently Senior Lecturer and Acting Head of the Department of Public Law. In 2008 he took study leave to come to the University of Port Harcourt on his doctoral thesis which is entitled: *"International Legal Protection of Women's Reproductive Rights: A Comparative Study of Abortion Laws and Policies in Four Jurisdictions – Nigeria, Ghana, United States and South Africa"*.

In his thesis, Mr. Adeleke compares the legal status of the reproductive rights of women to legal and safe abortion under the national laws of the four selected jurisdictions as measured against the standard of legal protection set by various international conventions and other instruments on human rights. While the study reveals that strict and restrictive abortion laws and the failure of States to create safe conditions for abortion constitute infractions of the reproductive rights of women, Mr. Adeleke submits that over-liberalisation of abortion laws and policies could also lead to the infringement of other basic rights. He thus stresses the need for an acceptable legal balance. And although

he acknowledges the important role played by international human rights laws in the protection of women's right to legal and safe abortion, Mr. Adeleke asserts that there can be no single universally acceptable morality governing the right to safe abortion to which all states could subscribe in view of the diverse socio-economic, cultural, religious, and moral affiliations of people in their different communities and states.

The focus of the study is multidisciplinary and cuts across various areas of the law. All the three External Examiners commended Mr. Adeleke's thesis. One of the Examiners reported that Mr. Adeleke "has made a major contribution to an important area of the law". Another stated that "...the thesis represents an academic discourse that is competently presented, is well structured and has some evidence of originality [and] contains good critical arguments". The third Examiner commented "This is a good work. The candidate bravely takes on an otherwise taboo theme and manages to demystify it fully. There is no doubt that this work, if published, will contribute to the on-going debate not only on reproductive rights of women, but also on the right to life. It is therefore a valuable contribution to our appreciation of human rights and particularly as it relates to women."

Mr. Adeleke is a Solicitor and Advocate of the Supreme Court of Nigeria. He is Principal Counsel in the Public Concern Chambers (a Law firm) and is a member of many Non-Governmental Organizations dedicated to the cause of democracy, good governance and human rights protection in Nigeria.

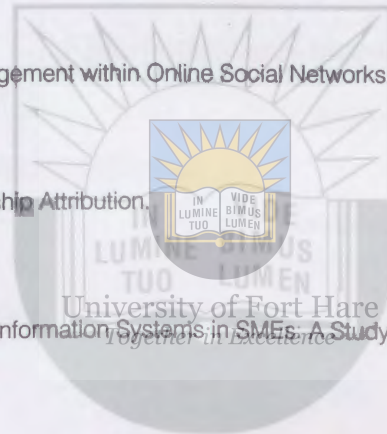

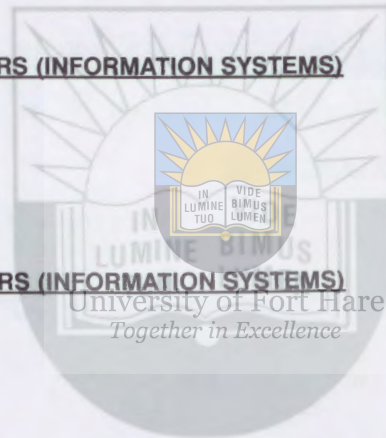

#### **PROFILE**

Anass Bayaga was born on 21st June 1979. He holds a B.Ed (Mathematics) from the University of Cape Coast, Ghana, an M.Ed from the University of Fort Hare and various other certificates covering a number of competences in computing and statistical analysis.

In 2008 he registered for a PhD in Education at the University of Fort Hare. His research was on the applicability of a business risk management framework in higher education quality management. Using a mixed methods design, and informed by a risk management analytical framework, the study established that risk can be measured and predicted in a not-for-profit organization such as a university, as much as it can be done in a for-profit organization. All external examiners agree that the study adds a new, original and innovative angle to the management of quality in higher education. One examiner acknowledged that this "...is an interesting and emerging area that should attract more research..." Three journal articles have already been published from this study.

Many thanks go to Prof. G Moyo, my supervisor for his unremitting guidance and mentorship. The support received from colleagues in the Faculty of Education is also greatly appreciated.

#### **PROFILE**

Maurice Vivian Kok was born in February 1955 in Matatiele in the Eastern Cape. He holds Post Graduate Diploma in Educational Management (Unisa) and Master of Public Administration (Nelson Mandela Metropolitan University, Port Elizabeth).

In 2005 Maurice registered for his PhD at the University of Fort Hare. His research focused on the emerging demand placed on principals to act as organizational change agents. This prompted the need to determine whether distributed leadership was being exercised among a group of principals in a District that was undergoing school reform. Underpinned by the theory of distributed leadership, the research sought to examine the factors feeding into the autocratic or more democratic relations in each school and took a snap-shot view of what was currently happening in the six schools chosen. This study was interpretive in orientation, and utilized mixed data gathering techniques. The study has recognised the complexity of the subject distribution of leadership and the challenging environment in primary schools in the Sisonke Education District. The modern style of leadership poses serious challenges to the conservative school principals. External examiners acknowledged that the study is an important contribution to educational leadership.

#### **PROFILE**

Clifford Mabhena came to Fort Hare in 2005 as a mature student having worked and lectured in the fields of agricultural science, rural development and education in Zimbabwe. His registration for a PhD in Development Studies occurred in the midst of the implementation of the fast track land reform program in Zimbabwe and was inspired by his determination to document the meaning and impact of this program on rural livelihoods in southern Matabeleland.

The resultant thesis, which consolidated years of practical experience together with detailed and careful anthropological fieldwork produced a thesis entitled 'visible hectares, vanishing livelihoods'.

The thesis is a historical ethnography of the failure of the fast track land reform program to translate land into livelihoods, and documents the struggles of ordinary people to operationalise alternative livelihood strategies through activities such as cross-border trading, out-migration and artisanal mining.

Professor Peter Little, a senior scholar at Emory University and author of half a dozen books on Africa examined the thesis and described it as 'an excellent and unprecedented study', claiming that 'I have not read any other empirical account of the fast track program that is as detailed and well-argued'.

### **SIBANDA MANASA**

#### **PROFILE**

Manasa Sibanda came to Fort Hare in 2007 as a mature student with a background in nature conservation work in Zimbabwe. He was granted sabbatical leave from his NGO to undertake research into the implications of the creation of the Great Limpopo Transfrontier Conservation area for rural communities in Zimbabwe. Sibanda registered for a Doctorate in Social Anthropology. His thesis explored the ways in which the prioritization of nature conservation undermined local knowledge and culture and ultimately denied rural people the right to use and exploit their own resources.

Using the Sengwe area as his case study, Sibanda's thesis unpicks the complex web of power relations between national governments, international environmental agencies, NGOs and local communities in the unfolding drama of transnational nature conservation.

The thesis provides a masterful analysis of the relationships between power and knowledge in international development. #### **PROFILE**

Born in Imo State, Nigeria, Ikechukwu Umejese was educated at the Federal School of Arts and Science, Ogoja. He holds an Honours degree in History and a Master's in Industrial Sociology and Personnel Management from Imo State University. Umejese worked in the private sector in Lagos between 1997 and 2006. During this period, he was also a freelance writer for several Nigerian newspapers.

He registered for the Doctor of Philosophy in Social Science at the University of Fort Hare in 2007, with Sociology as his home department. His thesis, which was supervised by Professor Wilson Akpan, examines the neoliberal conceptualisation of natural resource conflict, which the prevailing discourse blames on compensational inadequacies and injustices. The popular argument is that indigenous mining communities in Nigeria – as elsewhere in postcolonial Africa – take up arms against the state and mining corporations when their land is expropriated or wasted as a result of mining operations. Deploying the concepts of collective memory and rational plurality, Umejese's thesis finds a better explanation for such conflict. He locates it not merely in economic inadequacies but more crucially in the wider socio-historical matrix of the quest for ecological and natural resource sovereignty – the matrix within which the state and local communities confront each other.

The thesis found that compensation demands by the local communities he studied are textured and fall outside, rather than, within local ideas of "justness" and "fairness". Communities do utilise as a weapon collective memory of how they were dispossessed in the first place and how the colonial and postcolonial state became "sovereign". Because of this, grievances and violent agitation persist regardless of whether or not community demands for

compensation are adequately met by the state and extractive corporations. Umejese has been assisting the Department of Sociology in teaching and supervision of research projects at undergraduate and postgraduate levels. In 2009, he was one of only two fellows selected from Africa to take part in a three-month Young Scientists Program of the International Institute for Applied Systems Analysis in Laxenburg, Austria.

He is a member of the Chartered Institute of Personnel Management of Nigeria, South African Sociological Association, Junior Sociologists Network, and the Austria-based IIASA Society. He has presented papers at different national and international conferences. His publications include a book and journal articles. Umejese is happily married with one son.

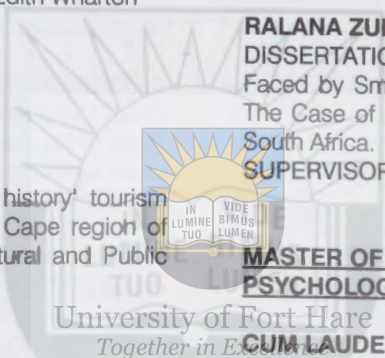

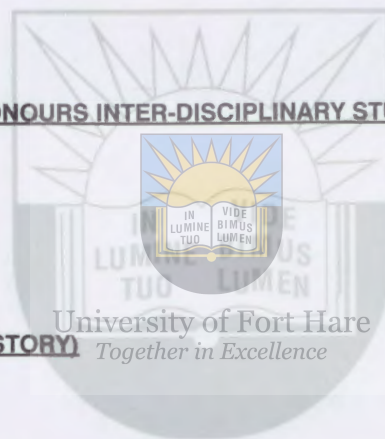

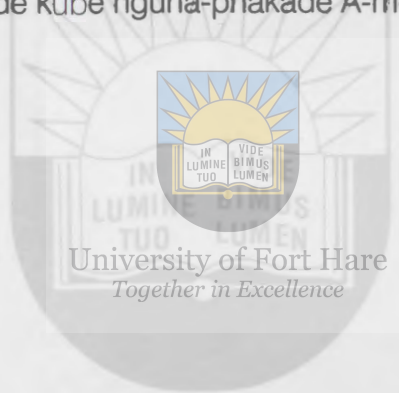
