# CITATION OF: LIVINGSTONE MQOTSI

Livingstone Mqotsi is a son of the Eastern Cape and was born in 1921 in the village of Rabula near Keiskammahoe. After matriculating at Paterson High School in Port Elizabeth, Livingstone – popularly known as Livie – obtained the BA and BA (Hons) degrees by 1948 from UFH under the auspices of the University of South Africa, the University Education Diploma (UED) from Rhodes in 1951, as well as an MA degree in Social Anthropology from the University of the Witwatersrand 1957. Livie's MA dissertation was converted into a book called *Ukutwasa*, which deals with traditional healing and is regarded as an outstanding contribution to Indigenous Knowledge Systems. During his student days Livie Mqotsi also served on the National Executive of NUSAS in 1947 - 48 then under the Presidency of Philip Tobias, who went on to become South Africa's pre-eminent palaeontologist.

The University of Fort Hare has achieved historic repute through producing a disproportionate cadre of leaders who were to serve the liberation movement with distinction, such as Govan Mbeki, Oliver Tambo, Robert Mangaliso Sobukwe, Nelson Mandela, AP Mda, Chris Hani, amongst numerous others, Livie Mqotsi was an integral part of these student debates in the 1940s. A contemporary colleague from the University of Fort Hare describes Livie Mqotsi as a quintessential gentleman, highly eloquent and articulate, extremely composed and unemotional in his contributions to the political discourse, principled and dignified in his adherence to his ideological framework of choice.

In a normal society he would probably have pursued an outstanding academic career but in South Africa he was obstructed at every turn by the racist authorities because of his political beliefs and affiliations:

He was dismissed from his teaching post because of his

political beliefs; he was forced out of employment as a research psychologist at the CSIR, prevented from assuming a senior research post at Rhodes University, and obstructed from taking up a Senior Educational Fellowship at UFH on the instruction of the Native Affairs Department (NAD) and the Broederbond.

In the face of his professional career being obstructed Livie Mqotsi continued to voice the frustrations and resistance of the oppressed by publishing and editing local newspapers, *Khwezi Lomiso*, 'The Morning Star' and *Indaba ZaseMonti*, 'East London News'. During the State of Emergency in 1960 he was locked up for two months without trial in one of South Africa's most dreaded prisons in East London. At this time he served articles of clerkship in Louis Mtshizana's legal office even though he had no desire to be involved in the legal profession. It was simply an expedient way of beating the Group Areas' Act so that he could remain in East London.

After he was dismissed from teaching and placed under house arrest (Banning Orders) he was driven into exile by not being allowed to earn a livelihood in East London where he lived.

In exile he continued the struggle for a South Africa free from Apartheid, fascism and economic exploitation on many fronts. As editor of the 'Unity Newsletter' published from Lusaka, Zambia, political education was provided to many exiled cadres from various liberation movements not only from South Africa. He furthermore also continued to send political missives back into South Africa. The Mqotsi home also provided sanctuary to many young freedom fighters including Chris Hani and Barbara Masekela in Zambia, Zola Skweyiya and others in the UK.

As founder member of the Non-European Unity Movement

in 1945 with publicly espoused principles of non-racialism and non-collaboration, Mr Mqotsi lived Unity Movement philosophy his entire life. His huge body of writings includes books, articles, pamphlets and papers. The common thread through all this work has been a continual re-statement of his life philosophy, that in order for us to be good human beings we should treat our fellow beings with decency and respect. Livie Mqotsi was also the General Secretary of the All-African Convention in the 1950's and was the main architect of that organisation's criticism of Bantu Education.

In his book, *House of Bondage*, he makes his characters speak out against tribalism which he portrays as being a racial, divisive and archaic myth, against blind acceptance of other people's positions without questioning their veracity; and speak up for true democracy which he portrays as defending the right of another person to differ with you.

His collective works are a testimony to his belief that there is only one race, the human race, and that human rights and culture are indivisibly part of this human race and therefore belong to ALL of us as human beings. This he extends to encompass both men and women because together they are the human race, none being superior to the other. Therefore in his dealing with the issue of human rights he contends that no 'race', 'culture' or group of people can unilaterally bequeath themselves certain 'rights' and withhold these same rights from other 'lesser beings'.

All these things he manages to accomplish in a quiet, dignified but very forthright manner – both in his writings and in his personal interactions with others.

On his return to South Africa and in his senior years Livie Mqotsi continued to be involved locally in community (poverty

alleviation) issues, school support and New Unity Movement structures, educating younger cadres.

In addition to being an exemplary renowned education scholar and indefatigable freedom fighter Livie Mqotsi made significant contributions to enhance UFH's standing, He inspired a new younger generation of students with contributions in seminars such as 'Conversations across generations', 'The Politics of Exile' and 'UFH Social Sciences Africa Day Focus'. His last writings, a novel and an academic treatise, were both published in 2008. On 20<sup>th</sup> May 2009 the NAHECS at UFH hosted the opening of the Livie Mqotsi Archival Collection (second largest individual collection after that of A.C. Jordan) which includes the combat boots of legendary freedom fighter, Chris Hani.

He passed away in September 2009 and was fittingly buried at Rabula. He is survived by his wife, Iris, two adult daughters and an adult son.

It is a distinct privilege and honour for the University of Fort Hare to award the degree: Doctor of Literature and Philosophy (D Litt et Phil) (Honoris causa) (posthumously) on Livingstone Mqotsi.

#### JUMA LAURENCE OKEYO

##### PROFILE

Laurence Okeyo Juma was born in Kenya. He completed his Bachelor of Laws degree (LLB) at Nairobi University, and then proceeded to the United States where he obtained both Master of Laws (LLM) and Master of Arts (MA, international peace studies) degrees at the University of Pennsylvania and University of Notre Dame respectively. In between, he has worked as a lawyer for a national NGO engaged in public interest litigation; a corporate compliance manager for a non-profit organisation; and as administrator of a university research programme. He has extensive teaching and research experience. Apart from University of Nairobi where he served as a lecturer in the early part of his career, he has held positions at the National University of Lesotho, University of Fort Hare and at Rhodes University where he is currently an associate professor in the Faculty of Law. He has been a visiting lecturer in universities in Kenya, Belgium, USA, and the Czech Republic. Between June 2001 and September 2002, he was a research fellow at the Danish Centre for Human Rights in Copenhagen and was involved in various research projects focusing on the congruence between human rights and African customary law. He has pursued active research in the fields of African customary law, international human rights law and conflict studies and has published extensively in these fields.

Laurence Juma's doctoral work examined the role of human rights norms in conflict transformation processes. Upon assumption that societies embroiled in conflict and those coming out of it have recourse to human rights norms and institutions, the study elicited entry points for human rights in the conflict continuum. Using concrete examples, and drawing from the experiences of Sierra Leone and Democratic Republic of Congo, the study mapped out human rights interaction with actors and agents of transformation and

assessed the viability of its principles in the effort to establish peace. The study found that the promise of future peace and stability in Africa rests on a recognition of human rights standards and the enforcement of its norms.

The examiners acknowledged that the greatest strength of the study is its illustration of how the idea of a 'continuum' can be adopted to allow for the insertion of human rights norms and methods in conflict resolution processes. Further, they commended the researcher for demonstrating, "by way of case study, how application of human rights in the post-conflict phase can successfully guide processes of national reconciliation and rebuilding". Examiners have also noted that the conclusions and recommendations arrived at in this study will be found useful by those agencies involved in conflict transformation in Africa and elsewhere.

##### PROFILE

Namhla Sotuku is a lecturer at the University of Fort Hare's Faculty of Education. She draws from a varied background as a teacher, lecturer at a teachers college, a researcher, community developer, curriculum trainer, author of Foundation Phase school books and a materials developer for teacher education programmes.

Born in the Eastern in Umtata she did her primary education in Alice at Lovedale Primary and her secondary school at Nyanga High in Engcobo. Namhla further went to Clarkebury College and completed her Secondary Teacher's Diploma. There she practiced as a Primary school teacher in Queenstown. Whilst practicing as a teacher she registered with UNISA where she completed her Bachelor's degree in 1994. In 1995 she got a lecturer's post at Clarkebury College. Her quest for more knowledge pushed her to concurrently register part-time at Rhodes and Stellenbosch University. At Rhodes she was awarded a Further Diploma in Education majoring in Primary School Mathematics, Science and Technology and obtained a Honours degree in African Languages majoring in Linguistics and Literature at the University of Stellenbosch, in 1998.

It was while studying at the two Universities that she got interested in policy issues and their impact on schooling. As a result she registered part-time at the University of Fort Hare in 2002 for her Masters Degree Education Management and Policy. While registered at Fort Hare she worked part-time as a School Support Officer for the University of Fort Hare's Distance Education Project. This position provided her with opportunities to engage with rural communities on policy issues. It was the silent voices of these communities

in education policy matters and the late Alan Kenyon and Professor M.J. Matshazi's encouragement that influenced Namhla to register for her Doctor of Philosophy degree at the University of Fort Hare in February 2008.

**The title of her Doctor of Philosophy degree is thus 'An investigation into the possibilities and limitations of utilizing rural based African communities' participatory institutions as enablers for the exercise of agency in improving participation in education'**

Using a combination of research methods the study led to key findings about the nature of rural communities' participation in issues affecting their lives, which include education. Key issues that emerged include the necessity to bring to the centre a people's indigenous ways of community participation marrying tradition with modernity. The study further highlighted how different structures of participation interact and complement each other while through clear communication they create a platform for meaningful ongoing role negotiation and sustained accountability. The study recommended an "additive approach" to participation- an approach that recognizes and acknowledges the realities of rural African communities. Namhla is currently involved with Community Literacy and Numeracy Groups Research project initiated by the Centre for Education Policy Development (CEPD)

Namhla is greatly indebted to God for sponsoring her with ability to complete her degree, Dr Stunky Duku her Supervisor for being a critical friend, her family and friends for unwavering support and the University of Fort Hare's Govan Mbeki Research and Development Centre for financial support.

#### SHOBER DIANNE

##### PROFILE

Dianne Shober was born on September 26, 1954 in a small Canadian farming community. She completed her honours degree at the University of Waterloo and worked as a social worker for two years before commencing work with an international missions organization. Following her marriage to John, the family came to South Africa in 1994 to work in the Transkei. Dianne completed her masters in Intercultural Studies with Biola University, Los Angeles in 2001 and began teaching in the English Department of Rhodes University in East London. Following the campus' merger with University of Fort Hare, Dianne became the Deputy Head of the English Department. In addition to her lecturing responsibilities, she has successfully supervised the research projects of honours and masters students and presented papers at national and international conferences as well as written articles for *Alternation*, *Literary Encyclopedia* and *SA History*. Additionally, she has published two books with Van Schaik: *Communicating with a Vision* and *Writing English with Style* and is presently working on a novel. John and Dianne have three children: Jacob, Aaron and Sarah.

Her doctoral dissertation is titled "Literary Bridges: The Life and Works of Sindiwe Magona." The project provides a literary biography of a significant black South African woman, whose writings act as a testimony, a historical record, an appeal, and an invitation to experience a culture, literary style and language marginalized by colonization. The trope of bridge building is a new perspective on her work, which elucidates the current

intellectual interest in the literary crossings of the local and global. The thesis argues that Magona transcends the 'Other' popular in western discursive evaluations to identify the Self as an actualized self-reflexive agent who creates a fresh and empowering environment for herself, her family, and ultimately her reader. Through this role as bridge builder, Magona creates an 'Ourness,' a unifying agency that resists the stereotypical literary paradigms of separation and difference. This study examines the genre of life writing which validates someone's lived experiences, provides representation for others enduring similar oppression, and instructs the uninformed about a unique life. Special attention is given to the nature and impact of her oral and literary voice on the South African and global community as she explicates the issues facing black African women.

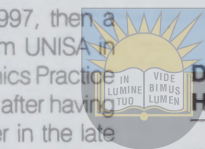
#### PROFILE

John Steele was born in Pretoria quite long ago, went to school mostly in KwaZulu-Natal, and has lived his adult life in various parts of the Eastern Cape. He achieved his BA Degree from Rhodes University in Grahamstown in 1975, then a Higher Education Diploma from UNISA in 1977, then a Honors in History of Art [with Distinction] from UNISA in 1997, then a Master of Arts in Art History [with Distinction] from UNISA in 2002. He now lectures Art Theory as well as Ceramics Practice at Walter Sisulu University, Department of Fine Art, after having previously worked as an independent artist potter in the late 1970s and early 1980s in Rhodes Village near Barkly East, and then managing the Ikhwezi Lokusa Pottery at Mthatha, from the mid 1980s to mid 1990s.

He has published extensively on Art Historical matters, having achieved 15 Articles in Journals such as "Inyathi: a Journal on Arts", as well as in the "South African Journal of Art History", and "De Arte", as well as in "African Arts", and in "National Ceramics". He has presented many Conference Papers both locally and abroad including, for example, at the Triennial Symposium on African Art hosted by UCLA at St Thomas, US Virgin Islands in 2001, as well as at University of Mumbai in India in 2006, and at University of Florida, Gainesville, in the USA in 2007.

His Thesis is entitled "Ubugcisa – made with our knowing hands: reflections on aspects of Alice Gqa Nongebeza ceramics praxis, Eastern Cape, South Africa". It delves into multifaceted palimpsests of ceramics visual arts practice in the Eastern Cape Province. Focus on octogenarian potter Alice Gqa Nongebeza, of Nkonxeni Village at Tombo near Port St Johns, and her manipulation of clay as medium, serves to foreground zero electricity usage ceramics technology as

means to creation of vibrant artworks. This Thesis challenges ways of thinking and marketing art which have previously sometimes disparaged entire genres of artworks such as pots created for domestic usage, often by women. The visual arts practices of Alice Gqa Nongebeza, and other featured Eastern Cape potters, are shown in this Thesis to be particularly inventive, and attitudes as well as beliefs associated with clayworking practice are also considered and contextualized with reference to other potters in southern Africa, and elsewhere.

#### PROFILE

Gillian Vernon was born on 24 December 1937, in Bulawayo in Zimbabwe. She was educated in Bulawayo, obtaining Cambridge Higher School Certificate in 1954. She then studied at the University of Cape Town, graduating with a BA in 1958 (majoring in History and Geography) and a University Education Diploma in 1959. Working through UNISA, she obtained a BA Hons, in History, with distinction in 1992 and an MA, also in History in 1998.

After graduating from UCT, she began a teaching career in Bulawayo. Marriage and children interrupted, but relief teaching at various schools was undertaken. She moved to East London in 1967 and taught Matric history for a year at Clarendon High School in 1970. She later took up a full time post at Clarendon in 1977, teaching English and Geography (having done a further course in English at UNISA in 1975). In 1979 she was offered the post as Historian at the East London Museum, which she occupied from 1979 to 1998. She then became Director of the Museum in 1998, a post which she held until her retirement in 2003.

Her dissertation is entitled "A new light on the pre-colonial history of South-East Africa, where the 'Other' is the European' and the 'Silence' has a voice, based on evidence from shipwreck survivor narratives: 1552-1782."

While working at the Museum, she had the privilege of working with the late Graham Bell-Cross, who was engaged in researching the wreck sites of the Portuguese shipwrecks which had occurred along the coast of south-east Africa. His work was published in 1989 in *Dias and his Successors*, edited by Professor Eric Axelson. She was aware at the time of the possibilities of investigating the implications of this work as applied to further knowledge of pre-colonial history, but her

other studies and duties prevented her from further research in this field. On her retirement, she had time to undertake further research and her ideas to follow up the shipwreck narratives with a view to adding to the pre-colonial historical record was well received by Fort Hare University.

The study involved first identifying the routes and itineraries of the various shipwreck survivors, and the scope was enlarged from the Portuguese wrecks to include the other significant accounts of two Dutch and two English wrecks of the 18<sup>th</sup> century. Following this the results were analysed.

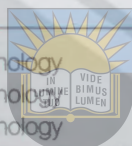
