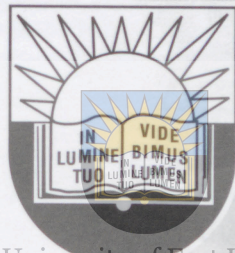

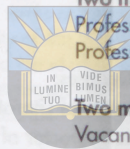

Doctor of Literature and Philosophy (D.Litt. et Phil) (Honoris Causa) in Music

PROF. JAMES STEPHEN MZILIKAZI KHUMALO A PROFILE

James Stephen Mzilikazi Khumalo was born on the farm 'Kwa Ngwelo' in the Vryheid district of KwaZulu Natal. He is named after the great clan leader, Mzilikazi Khumalo, who was from the same district and who fled Shaka's turbulence to establish the Ndebele kingdom in Zimbabwe. He was exposed to a musical upbringing through both his parents' love of music: his mother's beautiful soprano voice and love of traditional Zulu music and to Western music and staff notation through his father's work as the strict and precise conductor in the Salvation Army. Prof. Khumalo's fondest memory from his youth is the singing that took place at weddings, namely, the fierce competition between the singers in the bride's group (umthimba), and those in the groom's group (ikhetho). He was similarly in awe of the choir leaders (ababhidi) who were highly sought after to lead these groups at weddings.

Prof. Mzilikazi Khumalo has a highly impressive academic profile both in terms of formal academic qualifications as well as his professional career. He holds a Masters and a Doctoral degree in African Languages from the University of the Witwatersrand, and was the first black academic to rise through the ranks from Lecturer, Senior Lecturer, Associate Professor, and finally Professor and Head of African Languages at the same institution in a career spanning the period 1969 – to the present. He is currently an Emeritus Professor in African Languages and Linguistics at Wits. He has numerous publications in Zulu morphology and tonology and during a visiting fellowship to Illinois in the USA was described by academic peers as "a language teacher of the highest competence".

However the main thrust of the award of an honorary doctorate to Prof. Khumalo is in recognition of his contribution to the advancement of African arts, culture and heritage. Prof Khumalo has become the iconic figure in the sphere of African choral music and African traditional music in South Africa. He has been widely acclaimed for his momentous contributions to African music as composer, arranger, choirmaster, and adjudicator. His composition of the operatic epic "uShaka Ka Senzangakhona" in collaboration with Prof. Themba Msimang has been widely acclaimed both in South Africa and abroad. Prof. Khumalo's earliest compositions e.g. "Ma Ngificwa Ukufa," "KwaDedangendlale," "Ugqozi," "Izibongo ZikaShaka," are still popular even today, some of them are still being prescribed for premier choral competitions in the country. Some of Prof. Khumalo's arrangements of traditional African songs e.g. "Sangena," "Ingoma KaNtsikana," "Sizongena Laph'emzini," are sung by some of our leading choirs in the country. In May 2002 Prof. Khumalo completed the vocal score of his first opera, "Princess Magogo KaDinizulu" which premiered in Durban in the same year. Prof. Khumalo is a strong advocate of the notion that there is only one Black nation in South Africa and the ethnic references in songs that reflect the history, joys, and woes, triumphs and failures of a particular group are but strands in the broader fabric of this nation.

A sample of Prof. Khumalo's outstanding achievements reads as follows:

Prof. Khumalo was chairman of the government's "National Anthem Committee" that worked out the musical setting of the current South African national anthem (1995); he was a member of the "Sontonga Committee" of the National Monuments Council that researched and discovered the grave of Enoch Sontonga, composer of "Nkosi Sikelel-Afrika," and organized the erection and also the official unveiling of his monument by President Mandela in 1996; he is the Vice-Chairman of the board of SAMRO (South African music rights organization) and serves in various portfolios within the organization; was Music Director with Richard Cock of the Soweto Massed Choir Festival from its inception in 1989 to 2003. He is now patron of this festival; Prof. Khumalo holds honorary doctorates from University of South Africa (2000), the University of Zululand (2001), and the University of Stellenbosch (2002) all for his outstanding contribution to the advancement of African music and for creating an awareness of African idiom not only nationally but also internationally; in September 2003 he received the lifetime Achievement Award of the Arts and Culture Trust for being in the words of the Chief Executive "a true caretaker of our arts, culture and heritage; in his final National Orders Presentation Ceremony in June 1999, President Nelson Mandela bestowed the Order of the Star of South Africa on Prof. Khumalo.

Prof. Khumalo is married to Rose L Khumalo and they have four children.

MS WENDY YVONNE NOMATHEMBA LUHABE A PROFILE

Wendy Yvonne Nomathemba Luhabe was born in Old Benoni Location and is the second child in a family of four. When she was eight years old the community was forcibly removed to Daveyton and at the age of eleven went to live in Cradock where she completed her junior high school. Her high school education was at Healdtown and she studied social sciences at Fort Hare (UFH) from 1976 – 1977. We are extremely proud at UFH that Ms. Luhabe is an alumnus of this institution and that we have contributed in some measure to shaping her life and career. She left Fort Hare towards the end of 1977 to study at the University of Lesotho where she graduated in 1981 with a Bachelor of Commerce. After looking for a job for almost a year, she found the market completely unprepared for a black female commerce graduate. She eventually found employment as a marketing assistant to develop the black market for a cosmetic company. Her challenging entry into the job market enabled Ms Luhabe to develop very strong leadership and pioneering qualities which have set her apart from many of her peers. Over the years, Ms Luhabe has consistently pioneered the breaking down of barriers and boundaries of any kind. Ms Luhabe spent ten years in various senior marketing management positions in the cosmetics and the automotive industries. She had an opportunity to work in Germany and the USA for BMW before she left to pursue her own business interests.

In 1992 she founded Bridging the Gap, a Human Capital Development and Management Consulting Practice. Through this company she opened opportunities for those previously disadvantaged by facilitating job creation and empowerment. In 1994 Ms. Luhabe pioneered the founding of the first investment company to be owned by women, called Women Investment Portfolio Holdings (Wiphold). This initiative revolutionized the participation of women in the economy by making it the first women-owned company to be listed on the Johannesburg Stock Exchange. In 1998 Ms. Luhabe established Alliance Capital in South Africa. The company currently manages assets of approximately R8 billion. Ms. Luhabe also serves on the boards of the following companies: The Johannesburg Securities Exchange, the Industrial Development Corporation, Vodacom, Women Private Equity Fund, Alliance Capital, the International Marketing Council. She has received the following awards: In 1997 she was nominated by the World Economic Forum in Geneva as a Global Leader for Tomorrow; in the same year by the Osaka Junior Chamber in Japan as "The Outstanding Young Person;" by the UNISA Business School for Leadership in Practice (1997); in April 1999 she was honoured in Monaco as one of 50 Leading Women Entrepreneurs of the World for 1999 by the STAR Group in Los Angeles for her contribution to society nationally and internationally. *The Financial Mail* (30 April 2004) placed her top of South Africa's 20 most powerful women in business; In 2004 she was featured by the Financial Mail as the most influential leader and business woman among her peers; She has been invited on various high level speaking engagements to the UK, France, Sweden, South America, USA, Indonesia, Japan and Africa; In February 2003 she launched a R120m Venture Capital Fund for women owned enterprises, a first fund of this nature for South Africa.

Ms. Luhabe's unique business savvy, courage, vision and experience have been invaluable assets that have introduced her to the corridors of power at a relatively young age. Ms. Luhabe has published the following: a chapter in a book published in the USA called "Working Together: Producing Synergy by Honoring Diversity;" a chapter in book published in South Africa called "Women Creating the Future;" she published her first book in August 2002 called *Defining Moments* on the experiences of black executives in South Africa's workplace over 30 years. Through her relentless pursuit of democracy and freedom especially in business most doors that were closed to women are now flung open. Ms. Luhabe regards herself as a catalyst for transformation through her diverse activities which range from speaking engagements, human potential development, writing, the meaningful participation of women in the economic landscape of South Africa and her role as a non-executive director and chairman of diverse industries. As first lady of the Gauteng Province she intends to accelerate the participation of women in the economic landscape of Gauteng, as well as to work with youth related initiatives to build bridges between generations, especially to nurture the leadership development of younger or less experienced women. Ms. Luhabe is a great optimist about this country and believes there is no place like South Africa because of its diversity, the quality of its people, and the country's proven ability to adapt to change.

Ms. Luhabe is married to the Premier of Gauteng Province, the Honorable Mr. Mbhazima Shilowa, and they have two grown-up sons and a grandson.

MS LULI CALLINICOS A PROFILE

Luli Callinicos was born in Johannesburg to parents of Greek extraction and did her schooling in Johannesburg where she matriculated at Parktown Girls High. She holds a BA degree from the University of the Witwatersrand (1963) and a Diploma in Higher Education from the Johannesburg College of Education (1965). She has lectured in numerous institutions of higher learning.

The salient characteristics in Ms. Callinicos' profile are the following: Ms. Callinicos was arguably the central public historian in the crucial 1980s and early 1990s in creating a widespread and accessible understanding of the South African mineral revolution, with the concomitant urbanization, industrialization and labour movements.

Her seminal texts: *Gold and Workers: 1886-1924 – A People's History of South Africa Volume 1*, and *Working Life: Factories, Townships and Popular Culture on the Rand, 1886-1940 – A People's History of South Africa Volume 2*, revolutionized the teaching of Social and People's History at South African universities. Other important publications by Ms Callinicos are *A Place in the City* (1993), *The World that made Mandela: a Heritage Trail* (2000) .

Her recent biography on the life of the late OR Tambo: *Oliver Tambo: Beyond the Engeli Mountains* (2004), has received critical acclaim and has been nominated for literary awards. Ms. Callinicos has approximately forty academic and occasional publications in reputable academic journals, labour bulletins, and in diverse cultural and educational publications.

Ms. Callinicos was a leading educational activist in the anti-apartheid trade union movement in the formative late 1970s and 1980s and produced commensurate educational materials. In this regard she wrote the history page for *Abasebenzi* a workers' newspaper in Durban.

She has received numerous national and international research awards and grants from a range of sources such as the Friedrich Ebert Stiftung, the British Council, the USIS, the Netherlands Institute for South Africa, the Oliver Tambo Foundation, and the Ford Foundation.

Ms. Callinicos has served on numerous national committees and commissions and editorial boards: selected from a wide range: She was a member of the History Commission of the National Education Crisis Committee (1986-91); is a board member of the South African History Archives (1993 to the present); appointed by the Minister of Water Affairs to the National Advisory Committee on the naming of State Water Schemes (1994); appointed by the Minister of Arts and Culture to the Arts and Culture Task Group (ACTAG) to sit on the two sub-committees of Heritage and Community Arts and Culture (1994-95); appointed by the Gauteng Minister of Arts and Culture to the Strategic Management Task Team to advise on redesigning provincial functions and structures for heritage; appointed by the Minister of Arts, Culture, Science, and Technology as Councillor for the National Monuments Council (1996-2000); appointed by the Minister of Arts, Culture, Science and Technology as Council Member for the South African Heritage Resources Agency (2000-2002); appointed by the President as Trustee of Freedom Park, a heritage development project and Legacy Project (2000-to the present).

She is currently serving as the Non-Executive Chairperson of the National Heritage Council.

For her contribution to South African society and outstanding citizenship she was awarded the prestigious Commander of the Order of the Phoenix (1997) by the President of the Democracy of Greece in recognition of the achievements of persons in the Hellenic (Greek) Diaspora.

Ms Callinicos is married to renowned academic, Prof Eddie Webster, and they have four children.

PATRICK MASIKA A PROFILE

Patrick Julius Masika was born on the 1st January 1962 and matriculated at Caltec Academy in 1982, in Uganda. He obtained his Bachelor of Veterinary Medicine degree at Makerere University in 1987, and an MSc in Animal Production and Health at the University of Edinburgh, Scotland in 1991. He further obtained an MSc (Agric) in Reproduction Physiology at the University of Stellenbosch in 1999.

He began his career as a State Veterinarian (Uganda) in 1988 until he joined the Agricultural and Rural Development Research Institute (ARDRI) in 1992 as an Agricultural Advisor. For the period 1996 – 2000 he lectured in the Department of Livestock Science, at the University of Fort Hare. He is presently the Director of ARDRI at the University of Fort Hare.

For his doctoral research, an ethnoveterinary study of plants used to treat livestock diseases was undertaken. Livestock owners and traditional herbalists were consulted for information and laboratory research was conducted to determine the effect of different plants on bacteria, fungi and organisms that cause redwater and heartwater in livestock. Further research resulted in the isolation of several bio-active compounds thus completing a thorough investigation providing justification for the traditional use of the plants studied. The long-term objective of this research is to stimulate future initiative in the field of organic livestock production and new drug development from the plants of the Eastern Cape.

Three peer-reviewed papers have already been published from this research; two in the Pharmaceutical Biology, a third in the Journal of Ethnopharmacology and a fourth has been accepted by the South African Journal of Botany and is currently in press.

ABYSSINIA BATSIRA MUSHUNJE A PROFILE

Abbyssinia Batsira Mushunje was born on 8 September 1969 in Mushunje Village (Mutare district) of Manicaland Province in Zimbabwe. He completed his Advanced level studies at Goromonzi High School in 1987, before registering in the Faculty of Agriculture at the University of Zimbabwe where he graduated with a B Sc Agricultural Economics degree in 1991.

From 1992 to 1998 he was in the employment of the Ministry of Education in Zimbabwe as a high school Mathematics and Agriculture teacher at Nyakatsapa Secondary School, where he was promoted to deputy principal, and St Killians Secondary School in the Manicaland Province. In 1994 he returned to the University of Zimbabwe where he did a Graduate Certificate in Education.

In 1999 he got the Zimbabwe Presidential Scholarship to come to Fort Hare University where, in 2001, he graduated with an M Sc Agricultural Economics degree, with distinction. This prompted the patron of the Presidential Scholarship to give him a scholarship to do a Ph D degree in Agricultural Economics at the University of Fort Hare.

His doctoral thesis is: "Farm Efficiency and Land Reform in Zimbabwe". The objectives of the study were to estimate the technical efficiency of the communal, resettlement and large-scale commercial farmers of Zimbabwe, and to investigate the influence which some basic farmer-specific inputs have on technical inefficiency of the three farming sectors of Zimbabwe. He is the first Zimbabwean under the Presidential Scholarship programme to be awarded a doctorate.

In 2001, he was appointed as the Land Bank Researcher in the Department of Agricultural Economics and Extension. Abbyssinia is happily married to Martha and they have two children: Patson and Lavender.

ALVIN BENITO PETERSON

A PROFILE

Alvin Benito Petersen was born in Wynberg, Cape Town, the eldest of six children. His earliest exposure to music was via the informal route. As a self-taught musician he became an accomplished piano accordionist and church organist during his pre-teenage years.

Upon matriculation at St Columba's Boys' High School Mr Petersen enrolled at the University of Cape Town for the degree of Bachelor of Science (Chemical Engineering). However, because of his passion for music he changed his degree to the Bachelor of Music, which he pursued at the South African College of Music at the same university. A product of the struggle era, he refused financial assistance from the Department of Coloured Affairs and funded his undergraduate studies through part-time employment.

Alvin holds the following qualifications in addition to the Bachelor of Music:

Higher Diploma in Education and Masters in Music from the University of Cape Town,

Bachelor of Education from the University of South Africa and a Masters in Music from Butler University (Indianapolis, Indiana, USA).

As a music educator Alvin taught at the following institutions:

Hewat College of Education (Crawford, Cape Town); the University of the Western Cape and Cape Town High School. He is currently employed at the University of Fort Hare as the Head of the Creative Arts Programme of the Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities.

Alvin has served on several music related boards and committees, most significantly, as an executive board member of the International Society for Music Education, in which capacity he represented the African continent. He is also a provincial and national selection member for the Fulbright Scholarship Programme.

The central tenet of his thesis concerns informal music making in the Western Cape and how this can and should be recognized as a valuable educational tool, at all levels of school and university music education programmes, along with all the other kinds of informal music-making genres practiced in South Africa as a whole.

In the words of one of his external examiners: "This is the first known attempt at defining a truly relevant South African philosophy of music education."

Alvin is married to Cheryl and resides in Fort Beaufort.

MOSES OUMA PUNDO A PROFILE

Moses Ouma Pundo was born on 24 September 1965 on Rusinga Island, Lake Victoria, Kenya, and completed his secondary education at Homa Bay High School in 1984. In 1988, he obtained his Advanced Level Certificate of Education from Taranganya High in Economics, Geography, and Religious Studies.

With financial assistance from Raymond and Barbara Kane (a couple from Maryland, USA), Moses got admission to King's College, Pennsylvania in 1991 and graduated with B Sc in Economics and International Business in 1993. He applied for the Masters program in Agricultural Economics at the Pennsylvania State University and was accepted with an academic scholarship in September 1994. In 1997, he graduated with M Sc in Agricultural Economics. His thesis title was: "A Multinomial Logit Analysis of Factors Affecting Household Cooking Fuel Choice in Tanzania".

After returning to Kenya in 1999, he briefly worked for the International Research Network in Nairobi, before accepting a lecturing position at the Catholic University of Eastern Africa, as an assistant lecturer in the Department of Social Sciences (Economics Section). In 2003, the Catholic University granted him study leave to pursue a doctoral degree in Agricultural Economics at the University of Fort Hare.

His doctoral thesis is: "An Input-Output Analysis of Economic Impacts of Agriculture: A Case for Revitalisation of Smallholder Irrigation Schemes in Eastern Cape, South Africa". The objectives of the study were to analyse output, income, and employment impacts of agriculture at the national level, and to use the output, income and employment benefits generated by Zanyokwe Irrigation Scheme to argue a case for revitalising smallholder irrigation schemes in Eastern Cape. The study was guided by the hypotheses that agriculture makes immense positive contributions in this economy, and that smallholder farming by resource-poor households can also significantly contribute to the fight against household food insecurity, poverty, and unemployment in Eastern Cape.

TEMBAKAZI THEODORA SILWANA A PROFILE

Tembakazi Theodora Silwana was born on 14 April 1964 on her grandfather's farm near Cala, Eastern Cape. She attended school at Cala and at Ntsonkotha High School in Lady Frere.

After matriculating, she enrolled for a B Sc degree at the University of Transkei, majoring in Botany and Zoology. She subsequently obtained a scholarship to study for the B Sc Agric (Hons) degree at Reading University, UK, graduating in 1990.

After working for the Transkei Agricultural Corporation (TRACOR), she joined the Department of Agronomy of the Faculty of Agriculture, UFH, in 1999. She completed her Masters degree in 2000 and subsequently registered for a Ph D programme, funded by the Norwegian University Fund, the National Research Foundation and the Third World Organisation for Women in Science, the latter funding enabling her to complete her Ph D programme with her supervisor, Prof. E. O. Lucas.

Intercropping is a traditional cropping system among smallholder farmers in parts of the Eastern Cape but agronomic packages for them are frequently based on sole cropping. The practice of intercropping has not been researched much in South Africa, which makes this study particularly relevant.

Tembakazi Silwana's doctoral study on maize/bean intercrop showed that organic manure had the potential to improve the crop yield of smallholder farmers who cannot afford to buy inorganic fertilizers yearly. Intercropping was found to be the best cropping system for smallholder farmers as it reduces the frequency of weeding, which is another major factor which escalates production costs.

One of the examiners commented that "very important contributions have been made to the body of knowledge regarding the importance of organic fertilization as well as residual effects in improving intercropping systems. This information is largely lacking, especially in South Africa...".

Tembakazi Silwana is currently employed by the Department of Agriculture of the Eastern Cape Province and is based at Dohne. She has three children.

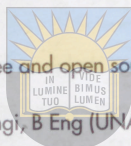

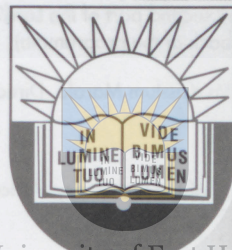

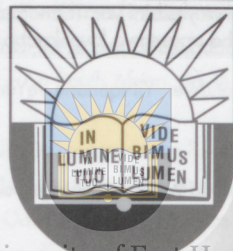
