PROFILE

Nkosinohando Mpofo was born in Hwange, Zimbabwe, in 1983. She obtained a Bachelor's Degree in Applied Communication Management in 2007 at the University of Fort Hare and a Post-Graduate Diploma in Media Management from Rhodes University in 2008. In 2011, Nkosinohando graduated for a Master of Social Science in Communication which was a motivation to enrol for PhD in Communication at the University of Fort Hare.

The dissertation was completed between 2011 and 2013. The goal of the thesis was to conduct an investigation into whether current HIV/AIDS communication campaigns have been limited when it comes to communicating with young women regarding HIV/AIDS related issues. In this study, Mpofo implores that HIV/AIDS communication policy and efforts should emphasize extensive use of indigenous languages.

Mpofo has articles published in peer reviewed journals and has presented at a national conference in South Africa. She has expressed her gratitude to the relevant personnel in the Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanities, the Department of Communication, the Govan Mbeki Research Development Centre, the University of Fort Hare and her Supervisor Prof A Salawu for their much appreciated support during the course of her studies.

Sam Erevbenagie Usadolo was born in Benin City, Nigeria. He had his secondary and teaching qualification in Nigeria. In 2006, he obtained his M.A Sociolinguistics from the University of South Africa, and in 2007 he obtained his B.Tech Public Relations Management from Walter Sisulu University.

He got his first PhD from the Nelson Mandela Metropolitan University in Applied Language Studies. He enrolled for and completed another PhD in Communication at the University of Fort Hare in 2012. His thesis examined participatory communication in small-scale rural cattle project as it relates to the theoretical conception of participatory communication and how it applies practically in development projects. With regard to the project examined, the analysis showed that stakeholder relationship, especially stakeholders identified in the study as field officers, was weak.

The findings of this study showed that there was no clear role and identification of responsibilities let alone coordination of all actors involved in the project. Through the selected rural project, the study explored theoretical implication for participatory communication practices. It highlighted the fact that in participatory communication discourse there is no clear solution to challenges field officers encounter in practice.

PROFILE

Blessing Makwambeni was born in Chiredzi, Zimbabwe in May, 1980. He holds degrees from the University of Zimbabwe and Midlands State University. Blessing enrolled at the University of Fort Hare in 2008 to pursue a PhD in Communication.

His study investigated the praxis and reception of entertainment education (E-E) interventions on HIV and AIDS in subaltern spaces. It employed Cultural Studies and Reception theory to explore the consumption of Tsha Tsha, a television drama, by South African youths. Communication for Social Change was used to locate the production of Tsha Tsha within the trajectory of development communication.

The study posits that Tsha Tsha is a key exemplar of an E-E intervention that transcends modernisation. Audience readings of Tsha Tsha show that E-E interventions face substantial resistances at the reception level. The thesis contends that subaltern youths do not 'unproblematically' read the 'preferred meanings', but rather use their 'situated discourses' to re-interpret and at times resist the 'preferred text'.

The examiners described the study as 'brilliant', 'comprehensive' and 'rich'. They concurred that the claims made were 'substantial', 'founded', 'coherent', 'consistent' and 'persuasive' in ways that are commensurate with a high standard of scholarship. Blessing is sincerely grateful to Professor Salawu his supervisor.

PROFILE

Ajiboye Oyeleke studied at Obafemi Awolowo University for his first degree in History/Sociology. He later moved to the University of Ibadan where he completed two master degrees in Social Work in 2007 and Medical sociology in 2010. He began his doctorate studies at the University of Fort Hare in 2011. The title of his thesis is Determinants of psycho-social of informal caregivers of children with disabilities in Southwestern Nigeria.

The goal of the thesis was to examine the determinants of psycho-social well-being of informal caregivers of children with disabilities in South-West Nigeria. The findings show that social support, satisfaction level and social economic factors (Education, Income, Occupation, Gender and Marital Status) predict the well-being of informal caregivers of children with disabilities. This study was the first of its kind to be carried out at such a wide scope on caregivers of children with disabilities in South West Nigeria. All the three examiners found the work very engrossing and fascinating.

Ajiboye Oyeleke was able to write five research papers with his supervisor on Delinquency, HIV/AIDS and well-being of informal caregivers of children with disabilities. Three of the papers have been published while two are under review with different peer review journals.

Ajiboye Oyeleke expressed sincere gratitude to GMRDC for financial support; the staff of the Department of Social Work; his Supervisor, Professor Tanga for his assistance during his studies.

PROFILE

Patricia Muhuro was born in Chinhoyi, in Mashonaland West province of Zimbabwe. She holds Licentiate Degree in Computer Science and Mathematics from José Varona University, Cuba and Master's Degree in Education from the University of Fort Hare.

She registered for PhD in education at the University of Fort Hare in 2009. Her study examined the implementation of five student retention programmes in two South African Universities. The programmes are student orientation, tutorials, Supplemental instruction, counseling and student tracking and monitoring. The study adopted a post-positivist paradigm and used the concurrent triangulation design as the operational framework for data gathering.

The study revealed minimal student participation in all programmes, including those that were compulsory, owing to inconsistent enforcement of policies, stigmatisation, and poor perceptions about these programmes. The study found challenges in selection, support and monitoring of peer facilitators in almost all the programmes. This was linked to limited qualified staff, high dependence on borrowed delivery models and poor co-ordination among stakeholders. The study proposed Comprehensive

Model for Student Retention, which includes among other aspects co-ordinated selection and monitoring of the five programmes as well as ongoing training of all facilitators in functional literacies, basic counselling and handling diversity.

Patricia is currently Senior Teaching and Learning Consultant at the University of Fort Hare. To date she has produced three research articles from her thesis and is involved in a multi-institutional research project on student retention and academic development.

Lily Kisaka was born in Bungoma, Western, Kenya on 1st May, 1968. She matriculated at St. Brigid's Girls High School Kenya in 1986. Lily obtained a BSc. (Honours) in Agricultural Economics in 1990 from Egerton University, Njoro and an MPhil in Agricultural Resource Economics and Management in 2004 from Moi University. Lily has worked with the Ministry of Agriculture, Kenya and taught at Bukura Agricultural College before joining the Nile Basin Initiative as National Project Coordinator for the Transboundary Environmental Management Project. She is currently a Senior Programme Officer with the East African Community's Lake Victoria Basin Commission.

For her PhD, Lily has submitted a thesis entitled: *Modelling payment systems for environmental services in the Mt. Elgon ecosystem of Kenya*. Using the contingent valuation techniques and diverse econometric and statistical procedures, the study determined farmers' preferences for management options in a Payment for Environmental Services Scheme. The study established the Willingness to Accept Payment and the Willingness to Pay for environmental services and concludes that Payment for Environmental Services is viable. The candidate therefore makes important recommendations on the future directions for natural resource management policy.

Two articles based on the thesis have been accepted for publication and another paper accepted for the FAO-hosted session at the International Food and Agribusiness Management Association's (IFAMA) conference in June 2014.

Adornis Dakarai Nciizah was born in Gweru in the Midlands province, Zimbabwe. He obtained Bachelor of Science Honours in Crop production and Horticulture from the Midlands State University in Zimbabwe in 2005. Thereafter, he joined the Department of Research and Specialist Services in Zimbabwe as a Senior Research Agronomist before proceeding to study for a Master of Science in Agriculture (Crop Science) degree at the University of Fort Hare in 2009.

For his PhD studies, Adornis studied soil surface structural conditions and properties related to soil quality affecting agricultural production in Eastern Cape province. The rationale of the work was that the soil-atmosphere interface affects the physical processes like surface sealing and crusting that control important agronomic processes like seed germination and emergence. The results indicated that total soil organic matter is closely related to

the clay fraction and not the clay plus silt fraction as earlier thought. The results also highlighted the existence of soil-climate interactions and stressed that changes in rainfall pattern and intensity due to climate change are likely to lead to high soil crusting and delayed seedling emergence. The work was presented at several conferences and published in peer-reviewed journals nationally and internationally.

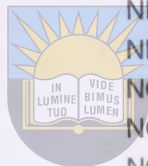

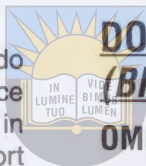
Beauty Etinosa Omoruyi was born in Benin City, Edo State, Nigeria. She obtained a Bachelor of Science Honours in Biochemistry and Master of Science in Biochemistry degrees from the University of Fort Hare (2008 & 2011).

For her PhD studies, Ms Omoruyi evaluated the efficacy of *Carpobrotus edulis* (L.) *bolus* leaf, used as a traditional treatment for the management of HIV/AIDS and other opportunistic infections. An ethno-medical survey confirmed that *Carpobrotus edulis* (L.) *bolus* is the most commonly used species, out of 18 used, for the management of HIV infections and other opportunistic diseases such as tuberculosis, diabetes mellitus and bacterial or fungal infections.

The foliar micro-morphological content of the plant, its phytochemical and antioxidant activity, its *in vitro* antimicrobial and antifungal activity, inhibitory effect against HIV-1 protease and reverse transcriptase, as well as possible mechanisms of action and cytotoxicity were investigated. Currently three papers in international peer-reviewed journals have been published with an additional three to be submitted. This study has verified the biochemical

basis and proposed a possible mechanism for the efficacy of *Carpobrotus edulis* (L.) *bolus* leaf as a traditional treatment for the management of HIV/AIDS and other opportunistic infections.

The Govan Mbeki Research and Development Centre at UFH and the National Research Foundation are acknowledged for their financial support during this study.

He proceeded to the University of Ibadan for a Master of Science degree in physical chemistry in 2007 and participated in Erasmus Mundus ATOSIM master

program in three European countries in 2008 to 2009 before returning to Ibadan to complete his MSc in 2010.

Adebayo's doctoral thesis focused on computational studies, synthesis and characterization of ruthenium (II) anticancer compounds. His research uses state-of-the-art supercomputer simulations at the Centre for High Performance Computing (CHPC) to study the pharmacokinetics of anticancer drugs and use their mode of interactions to develop novel chemotherapeutic agents that can act as "magic bullets" against cancer cells.

He has published ten peer reviewed journal articles and presented some of his work at conferences. Adebayo gratefully acknowledges Govan Mbeki Research and Development for supervisor-linked bursary, CHPC and all the people that God has used as instrument of support for him. He describe his life journey with the scripture that says "... weeping may endure for a night, but joy cometh in the morning" (Psalms 30:5).

Omoruyi's PhD research focuses on the development of new synthetic acylpyrazolone heterocycles of therapeutic importance that may be better alternatives for medicinal drugs which have become disease resistant. This research has so far produced over twenty new compounds with therapeutic properties which have been characterized and identified, most of which have been deposited at the Cambridge Crystallographic Data Centre (CCDC) London, as new crystal structures. Also from his PhD studies are three published research articles and numerous scientific conferences attendances.

He was recently awarded the Carl Storm International Diversity (CSID) Fellowship towards attendance and presentation of a paper at the Gordon Research Conference/Seminar on Bio-inorganic Chemistry and Metals in 2014 in Ventura CA, USA.

He joined the University of Fort Hare in 2007 and obtained Bachelor of Science Honours degree in chemistry (Cum Laude). He then joined Fort Hare Institute of Technology (FHIT) as a researcher. He obtained Master of Science in Chemistry in 2010 and registered for doctoral degree.

Raymond is doctoral thesis focussed on nano

titanium dioxide particles in order to evaluate changes in their physical properties as the particle size change from bulk materials to nano domain. He designed and assembled a novel ultrasonic spray pyrolysis system for production of titanium dioxide nano-materials and developed a new droplet correlation model for estimating the final titanium dioxide particle size. The titanium dioxide was doped with carbon and used to fabricate photo-electrochemical solar cell devices. His results showed that carbon doping increased the efficiency of the dye sensitized solar cells by about 5 times over the solar cell with pristine TiO₂.

His work has been published in several peer reviewed journals and presented at several conferences. Raymond is also an integral member of the Measurement & Verification (M&V) team at the University of Fort Hare and conducted several energy audits of a variety of Eskom funded energy initiatives in all energy sectors around the country.

Nobert Rangarirai Jere was born in Chirumanzu in the Midlands province of Zimbabwe. He obtained his Honours in Information Systems from Midlands State University in Zimbabwe in 2006.

His PhD research focused on the development of a methodological framework for an ICT roadmap for rural areas. This was facilitated through the exchange program between Aalto University (Finland) and the University of Fort Hare (Computer Science). It is glaring that food security has become an increasing concern not only in Africa but the whole world. In an effort to alleviate this problem especially in poor and marginalized rural communities, he proposed the revitalization of wild vegetables through cultivation, consumption and preservation, a practice that is slowly going extinct. He identified several wild vegetable species that are consumed by the rural populace of the Eastern Cape and singled out *Solanum nigrum* L., one of the most popular species. Through a series of carefully planned scientific experiments and guided research methodology, he was able to conduct agronomic trials and bioactivity guided research on *Solanum nigrum*. From this

research, he was able to determine the agronomic data required for the successful cultivation of this food plant, determine its nutritional composition per growth stage and the optimum harvesting period as determined by specific nutritional interventions. Bacterial growth was present in all food types tested and multidrug resistance was noted. The study also revealed a high prevalence of *bla*-_{TEM} including mutant strains. Two virulence genes (*ucaA* and *hlyA*) were also detected in *E. cloacae* isolates.

Mirriam has to her credit seven publications in peer-reviewed journals and four are under review. Mirriam is married to Wilson and blessed with a daughter, Nancy. Four most abundant substrates found in the Eastern Cape were co-digested to optimize the methane yield. The methane yield was found to be in the range of 60% to 75% of the bio-gas produced. Prediction models corresponding to the mixing ratios of the highest methane yield were developed.

The developed prediction models are based on ambient weather parameters and properties of the substrates. Insulation of the bio-digester with sawdust was observed to increase the methane yield as the temperature fluctuations were minimized. The model will help bio-digester designers to predict methane production on the early design stage.

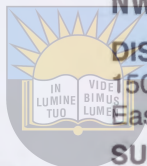

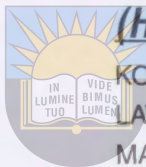

HONORARY DOCTORATE DEGREE

CITATION: Dr Nkosazana Clarice Dlamini-Zuma (Doctor of ADMINISTRATION) (Honorius Causa)

PROFILE

Dr Dlamini-Zuma was born in Southern KwaZulu-Natal on 27 January 1949. Her achievements are well-known. Not only did she manage to acquire a good education despite her very humble beginnings, but she has displayed clear leadership ability throughout her life – beginning from her student days. The leadership positions she occupied during her student days include being appointed as Vice-President of the South African Student Organization in 1976 and being the Chairperson of the ANC's Youth League in 1978 while in exile in England.

After her return to South Africa in the early 1990s, she assumed various leadership positions in the new democratic government. She became the first Minister of Health under the presidency of Dr Nelson Mandela. She became the Minister of Foreign Affairs under former President Thabo Mbeki, and the Minister of Home Affairs under President Jacob Zuma. In all these positions, she received accolades for her outstanding performance. She has also never been accused of fraud or corruption of any kind.

Her most striking achievement thus far, however, has been her appointment as the first female Chairperson of the African Union Commission in 2012.

She has received the following achievement awards over the years:

- *International Renaissance Woman of the Year Award - Awarded by the Palazzo Strozzi Foundation of the USA in 2012;*

- *Stateswoman of the year Award - Awarded by BBQ (Black Business) in 2004;*
- *Grand Maire de L'Orde National – Awarded by the Republic of Mali in 2002;*
- *Tribute Achievers Award – Awarded by Tribute Magazine in 2002;*
- *Women Who Make a Difference Award – Awarded by the Presidential Commission on the Status of Women (based at Southern Illinois University) in 2002;*
- *Tobacco-Free World Award – Awarded by the World Health Organization in 1999;*
- *Honorary LLD – Awarded by Bristol University in 1996;*
- *Honorary LLD – Awarded by the University of KwaZulu-Natal in 1995.*

In June 1999, an article in the Mail and Guardian described Dr Dlamini-Zuma as “a determined fighter for change willing to head-butt any vested interest, including pharmaceutical and tobacco companies.” This gives evidence of her determination to selflessly stand up for human rights.

Some of the societies that she is or has been a member of are also evidence of her concern for human rights. Some of these societies are the following:

- *Chairperson: Peace and Security Council of the African Union – 2004;*
- *Deputy Chairperson: Aids Board of the South African Permanent Mission – 1995;*





- Board Member: Centre for Social Development Studies (UNO) – 1992;
- Member of the Steering Committee of the South African National Aids Coordinating Committee – 1992;
- Research Scientist: South African Medical Research Council – 1991-1994;
- Director: Refugee Health Trust, United Kingdom – 1988-1990.

When asked what her greatest achievement was during her tenure as Minister of Health, Dr Dlamini-Zuma said it was the provision of free health care for children under the age of six. She said she had also made it her priority to “deliver public health care to the millions of dispossessed South Africans.”

Dr Dlamini-Zuma’s long-standing commitment to democracy is clearly demonstrated by the democracy-seeking organizations that she has been a member of at various stages of her life. While she was a medical student at the University of KwaZulu-Natal in the early 1970s, she joined the Black Consciousness Movement and was appointed the Vice-President of the South African Students’ Organization in 1976. She also joined the African National Congress at the same time and became active in the underground organizing activities of these movements.

Due to the persecution of members of these organizations by the apartheid government, Dr Dlamini-Zuma left the country for exile and temporarily abandoned her studies. While in exile, she served as the Chairperson of the ANC’s Youth League in England. She subsequently became the Vice-Chairperson and later the Chairperson of the Regional Committee of the ANC in England.

After returning from exile in the early 1990s (having qualified as a medical doctor from the University of Bristol in 1978), she served as both the Executive Committee member and the Chairperson of the Southern KwaZulu-Natal Region of the ANC from 1991 to 1993.

Her enduring commitment to democracy is further demonstrated by the active role she played in assisting former President Nelson Mandela to install a new government in Burundi and in assisting former President Thabo Mbeki to play a meaningful role in bringing about peace in the Middle East.

According to its Vision and Mission, the University of Fort Hare is not only committed to teaching and research excellence, but it also aspires to use the knowledge thus generated for the scientific, technological, and socio-economic development of our nation and the wider world. This is exactly what Dr Dlamini-Zuma has done over many years and still continues to do. She has acquired deep and wide-ranging knowledge relating particularly to medicine and administration. She has, for many years, used this knowledge for the socio-economic development of the people of South Africa, Africa, and beyond. Her main focus has previously been on South Africa, but by virtue of her recent appointment as the Chairperson of the African Union Commission, her main focus will now be on the African Continent as a whole.

PROFILE

Antony Matemba Sambumbu was born at Mawusheni Location in Tsomo in the Eastern Cape Province. Antony's Doctoral thesis provides a critical evaluation and insight into the process for the implementation of Integrated Quality Management System (IQMS) in the South African schools so as to postulate a new theory for improving implementation of IQMS.

The thesis is underpinned by the argument that despite the implementation of IQMS currently, empirical evidence indicates that the effective performance of most South African schools still continues to be marred by quality related challenges. Deriving from this limitation the study posits in its overriding hypothesis that the effectiveness of IQMS implementation is measured by five constructs encompassing quality, performance management

and appraisal, IQMS key success factors, prescribed implementation process and monitoring and evaluation.

The results of confirmatory factor analysis indicated that the application of the hypothesized IQMS implementation model would significantly influence the successful IQMS implementation in South African schools. Basing on these findings it was recommended that the Eastern Cape Department of Education in conjunction with the National Department of Education must consider implementing IQMS in line with the new postulated theory.

Mr. Henry Jacob Festus Ssekibuule born on 16th February 1963 in Masaka Uganda; completed Secondary education in 1984; he holds certificates in Cooperative Business Administration, Training of Trainers ; Diploma in Business Management;

BA degree in Public Administration; 2010, Master of Public Administration at the University of Fort Hare. 2013, Doctor of Administration in Public Administration from the University of Fort Hare, His thesis was titled: *“An Evaluation of Women Participation in Housing Delivery: The case study of Mdantsane Township, BCM in the Eastern Cape Province”*.

His analysis revealed that to understand women’s role in the housing process, there is a need to move beyond the project approach used by most implementing agencies, the finding of his study was that colonial imperialism is the major independent variable in the study area. Dependent variables, such as unemployment, homelessness and squatting proved to be a function of resource inequalities amongst Whites and Blacks. The legacy of apartheid capitalism seemed to favour middle-income housing delivery at the expense of the marginalised.

He has presented papers at both national and international conferences, and has published three articles in peer reviewed accredited journals. He is married and blessed with six children of who two are twins.

PROFILE

Mangizvo Remigios Vurayayi was born in Chirumanzu, Zimbabwe. Mangizvo's thesis is entitled *"An assessment of energy use as a rural development strategy: The case of Chiwundura Communal Area, Zimbabwe"*.



The study argues that there is little energy transition in the rural areas of Zimbabwe. Rural areas continue to rely on traditional energy sources particularly wood fuel because households do not have incomes that enable them to adopt modern energy forms such as grid electricity.

The study asserts modern energy forms such as liquid petroleum gas, solar house systems and electric generators are priced beyond the reach of most. The research contends that households will not attain Millennium Development Goals because of the continued use of traditional energy sources.

The study recommends that the national government must subsidise rural households in their endeavour to acquire modern energy forms. All the examiners appreciated the study and suggested that the recommendations be shared with all the stakeholders.

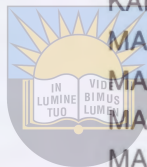

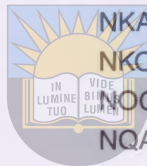
