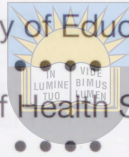

PROFILE

Alfred Musarurwa's PhD thesis argues that employees in the banking industry have become unintended administrators of the mobile devices that they own and use for work purposes. While there are technical solutions available to assist the organisation to manage this information security risk, these are often not sufficient.

The study's literature review identified the following six individual and organisational traits of attitude, knowledge, habit, environment, governance and awareness that he then combined to form the BYOD Information Security Behavioural (BISB) model. In order to test and evaluate the model, a survey was conducted with 179 bank employees.

This study recommends that banking organisations should make use of the BISB model to mitigate the information security risks that are posed by the unintended administrator. Alfred has presented a paper at an information security conference in Nevada (USA) and authored two journal papers from this study.

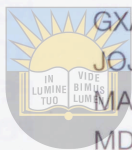

Adawi Adeola Adeleke was prompted by the need to assess the achievement of the set goals not only across the countries but also within the local context of each country. She, therefore, carried out a qualitative assessment of the achievement of gender equality under education for all (EFA) goals using Lagos State, Nigeria as a case study. Underpinned by the social justice theory and the social justice praxis theory, the study followed qualitative research approach which utilizes an interpretive research paradigm that provides a collective voice from the participants. The study revealed that the State government had established policies and measures to provide qualitative education for all the citizens on a non-discriminatory basis. Thus, the goal of gender parity in terms of enrollment of boys and girls has been relatively achieved in the state. However, there were still some challenges of equality in the learning process and outcome. Three manuscripts have been developed from the thesis and submitted to accredited journals.

PROFILE

Adekunle Babatunde Dada's study sought to find the effect of a participatory voter education programme on secondary school students' political knowledge and attitude. It also investigated the moderating effects of school location and gender on the dependent variables. The study revealed that there was a significant effect of treatment on secondary school students' political knowledge and attitude and the urban area obtained higher mean political knowledge score than those in the rural area. However, there was no significant main effect of gender on secondary school students' political knowledge and attitude.

The study concludes that there is a need for educators to shift from teacher-centered instructional strategies that portend serious retardation to the acquisition of political knowledge and attitude to the more efficient, result oriented and learner-centered strategy that could provide opportunities for learners to be actively involved in the teaching-learning process. The study has produced four (4) articles in accredited journals.

Eesuola, Omobola's study investigated the relationship between parental involvement and Grade 8 learners' academic achievement in Mathematics. The outcomes of the investigation revealed that parental involvement enhances the academic achievement of Grade 8 learners irrespective of a definition of it or the measure of achievement. Furthermore, the results of this findings indicate that good parenting styles, parental support and parental educational background, respectively, are prerequisite for learners' academic achievement in mathematics.

The study therefore, recommended that parental involvement should be beefed up especially in areas of communication and family structure, by both the parents and teachers in order to enhance learners' academic achievement in Mathematics. Two manuscript has been extracted from the thesis and submitted to accredited journals.

It also emerged that, other factors that contribute to the non-involvement of parents are poverty, lack of knowledge, culture, and attitudes.

Mpu Nondumiso Yolanda's study is on Educators' perceptions of Inclusive Education for learners with physical disabilities in mainstream classrooms in three schools in the Mthatha education district. The study revealed that inclusion in schools still has glitches as most of the respondents felt it was not properly communicated.

Another glaring problem was that little support is given by District Based Support Teams (DBSTs) as they are key personnel in the process. Policies regarding inclusion are not well advocated and the resources are not enough for perfect implementation.

When comparing with other studies that were conducted in other Provinces and abroad, the researcher noticed that there is still a noticeable huge gap on how the issue of inclusion is handled and as such recommends further study as not very much is done about it.

MUFUTAU Monsuru Atanda's study focused on the engagement of fathers in early childhood care and education provisioning in one Eastern Cape Province Education District. The study revealed that stakeholders have positive views about fathers' engagement in early childhood care and education provisioning.

Results indicate that schools do provide support mechanisms to encourage fathers' participation. Results also show that functional policy and practice is likely to improve and encourage more active engagement of fathers in Early Childhood Care and Education provisioning. Three manuscripts have been developed from the thesis and submitted to an accredited journal.

Mrs. Astrid Napier adopted a case study design, situated in a qualitative approach and an interpretive paradigm to investigate the Promotion of Healthy and Safe School Environments, focusing on environmental health elements. The findings indicated that although support services were in place, promoting a healthy and safe school environment was a challenge at all of the schools in the study.

Various contributing factors such as lack of support from the Department of Basic Education (DBE) for schools and district officials, non-implementation of policies, lack of infrastructure, human and other resources, security personnel and vandalism, prohibited the promotion of healthy and safe school environments. The study recommended that the DBE should pay urgent attention to these elements to ensure the health and safety of all on the school premises. She has published a peer-reviewed article in an international Conference proceeding.

It revealed that students needed to be assisted academically and non-academically by making them understand the institution's academic and support programmes in order to develop their own academic plan. Based on the results of the study, Stofile proposed a framework to assist in enhancing student satisfaction in higher education in South Africa. The study provided therefore the useful data for institutions to use in their quality enhancement activities.

One manuscript has been drawn from the study and is currently under review for possible publication in an accredited journal.

Adesegun Benedict Titus' study investigated the influence of trans-border trading activities on senior secondary school students' academic performance in Economics in Ogun State, Nigeria. It also investigated the moderating effects of school location and gender on the dependent variables. The study revealed that there was a positive significant influence of smuggling on students' academic performance in economic concepts and a negative significant influence of school location on students' academic performance in economic concepts. It also revealed that the most prevalent trans-border trading activities such as smuggling of used tyres, small firearms and fairly used clothes had a negative influence on students' academic performance.

The study concludes that the involvement of the students' in trans-border trading activities was due to the proximity of schools to border towns, and this had a negative influence on their academic performance. The thesis has produced six (6) articles in peer-reviewed journals.

Zendah Tonderai James' study sought to examine the influence of teacher conduct on the teaching and learning environment. Informed by Virtue Ethical Theory, the study was located in the pragmatist paradigm, adopting a mixed methods approach. Survey findings revealed that teachers engaged in unethical conduct, whose prevalence was confirmed.

The data clustered towards the negative influence of teacher unethical conduct on the teaching and learning environment. Teacher indiscipline was attributable, in part, to the absence of a professional teaching council and a code of ethics for teachers.

Teacher conduct requires monitoring through appropriate management structures of the teaching council guided by a code of ethics. The study proposed an integrative professionalization framework for teaching. Zendah has presented papers at international and national conferences and has three previous journal publications to his credit. Two manuscripts are currently under review for publication from this thesis.

He also analysed the practice of self-representation within the theoretical and operational assumptions of the adversarial system in general, and the criminal adjudicatory system of Ghana in particular. Tufuor's research brought valuable insights into the strategies of making the adversarial system more accommodating of self-representation in criminal trials, in terms of securing the procedural goals of fairness, procedural equity and justice for self-represented accused persons.

Martin Glynis Michelle's doctoral study focused on the role of executive self-regulation in predicting academic success during early childhood. The study developed a comprehensive conceptual model for the predictive role and interactions between complex executive functions, socio-emotional competence, learning aptitudes and visuomotor skills, in predicting early academic performance. The study further indicates significant influences of caregiver factors and home language on academic performance. This innovative neuro-cognitive model confirms that learning aptitudes mediates the effects of complex executive function and visuomotor skills on early academic performance. This contribution enhances the ability of stakeholders and policymakers towards developing effective strategies for academic success in early childhood.

Leo Tsakata Mafuso's doctoral thesis unveils the narratives of skilled Zimbabwean citizens living and working in East London, South Africa, with specific regard to the extent to which the home remittances made by skilled Zimbabwean citizens abroad offset the skills lost by the Zimbabwean economy through skilled emigration.



The study reveals, among other things, that while skilled emigrants regularly send money home, the socio-economic consequences of skills lost to the Zimbabwean economy are quite severe and can hardly be remedied through home remittances.

The study thus cuts through the dominant discourse on the developmental significance of home remittances and provides insights into the consequences of skilled emigration in the Zimbabwean context, especially the consequences of treating skilled expatriates simply as "remitters" of foreign exchange.

Jonathan Oshupeng Maseng's doctoral study engaged the perspectives, narratives and idealisations of African migrants and South African nationals in Sunnyside, Pretoria, on cross-border migration, social cohesion and African continental integration. The aim was to interrogate the dominant discourse and assumption in migration scholarship that holds that contact between nationals and immigrants is inherently conflict-inducing.

The study found that while many respondents expressed negative sentiments with regard to how cross-border migration affected their experiences of social cohesion and idealisations about African continental integration, the relations between the immigrants and South African nationals were overwhelmingly congenial – even in the absence of policy-oriented action by government to promote such relations. While some respondents viewed the relative dominance of immigrants in the Sunnyside small business sector as a “threat” to social cohesion, the overwhelming congeniality in intergroup relations appeared to rest firmly on the ‘logic’ of mutual socio-economic dependence between the two population groups.

Howard Gomwe's PhD sought to develop the model for promoting physical fitness and healthy lifestyle of primary school learners in the Eastern Cape, South Africa.

The findings demonstrated high prevalence of overweight and obesity among the school learners, and low level of physical fitness, which have implications for health, growth and development of children. Based on these findings, the candidate developed a conceptual framework which led to the description of the behavioural model to enhance physical fitness and prevent or reduce overweight and obesity among school learners was developed.

This study will stem the tide of low physical fitness and rising trend of overweight and obesity among children in the region. Three manuscripts have been submitted for peer-reviewed in accredited journals.

Sizeka Monakali's study determined ethnic specific cut-off values in diagnosing the prevalence and aetiology of obesity among primary healthcare (PHC) professional nurses, and further developed health promotion guidelines for nurses as key stakeholders in the management and education of obese patients in the Eastern Cape Province. The study findings revealed an alarmingly high prevalence of obesity, hypertension, unawareness and uncontrolled hypertension among professional primary healthcare nurses in the region.

The study developed guidelines for management of obese patients in PHC facilities to facilitate the development of a preventive strategy for health care problems associated with obesity and proposed cut-off points in diagnosing obesity among nurses, thus, contributing to the body of knowledge on country-specific cut-off points in diagnosing obesity in populations. It recommends a need for the implementation of workplace wellness programme that will foster healthy lifestyle behaviours among nurses.

One manuscript has been published in an accredited journal, one accepted for publication, and three submitted to peer-reviewed and accredited international journals for publication.

Daphne Murray's study developed a model of support for divorced professional nurses in the healthcare facilities of the Eastern Cape and a conceptual framework which culminated in a description of the model. Multiple levels of triangulation approaches ensured scientific and academic rigor including credibility of the study.

This model of support for divorced professional nurses is unique in the context of health care facilities and is the first support model developed in the South African context for divorced professional nurses. Nurse Managers and educators can use the model for their specific situational context. The study's position is that there need to develop, implement and evaluate a 24-hour programme for divorced professional nurses to test the ability of this model to promote health and productivity among divorced professional nurses working in health facilities in the Eastern Cape.

Nomandithini Senti's study focused on development of a programme of academic support for students at a public nursing college in the Eastern Cape Province. The findings of the study demonstrated that student nurses were dissatisfied with the unavailability of college library resources, mentoring, recreation, stakeholders' and parental involvement and emotional support.

The candidate developed a conceptual framework for academic support programme, and guidelines for implementation and evaluation of the academic support programme was developed. The academic programme will guide the academic staff regarding student academic performance, improve the quality and competence of student nurses, and develop nurses as scholars in their profession. The guidelines require further testing regarding the implementation of the academic programme.

Three manuscripts have been submitted for peer-review in accredited journals while four articles have been published in accredited national journals.

Nonceba Vellem's study focused on the promotion of healthy lifestyle for pregnant women and women with gestational diabetes mellitus through modified diet and planned physical activity using their context specific situations. The study found that low and high risk pregnant women with diabetes mellitus were overweight and obese due to poor lifestyle (diet and low levels of physical activity). She thus developed guidelines for modified diet and planned physical activity for low and high risk pregnant women and women with gestational diabetes mellitus.

The study recommends frequent counselling on the beneficial effects of modified diet and planned physical activity for the mother and unborn baby and motivating and supporting pregnant women to participate in physical activity in order to meet the WHO physical activity criteria (150 minutes of moderate-intensity activity per week).
