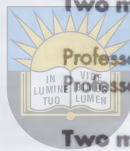

DR DANISA BALOYI

From the humble beginnings of being a part time clerk at IBM SA, Dr. Danisa Baloyi is now the Executive Director of the National Black Business Caucus (NBBC) and a highly regarded stakeholder in South African Business. Dr Baloyi is a Business Development Specialist and Strategist and works as a Management Consultant, by coordinating and directing business organizations. Dr Baloyi received her Doctorate (Ed.D) in International Education and Development from Teachers College, Columbia University in the US.

As Executive Director of the NBBC, Dr. Baloyi sets up business programs between mainstream business and emerging small business and medium sized enterprises, in the process of developing them into fully-fledged businesses that are merged into the mainstream economy. This is Dr Baloyi's forte. She specializes in strategic planning and management of business deals, joint ventures, research development and review of programs of international business with the specific interest of investing in South Africa and other countries.

Dr Baloyi is well respected by both government and the private sector, and in addition to her responsibilities as the Executive Director of the National Black Business Caucus, serves as chairperson for the following organizations: The Advertising Standards Authority, the Monitoring Committee for the Marketing and Communications Industry, the Diabo Shaba Trust for Telkom Employees, the South African Women Investment Holdings (SAWIH), Medikredit, Gauteng Enterprise Propeller (an SMME Agency), National Skills Authority and The Don Group Hotels.

Dr Baloyi is the Deputy Chair of South African Tourism and the Southern African Enterprise Development Fund (SAEDF - US Southern Africa Fund), and sits on the boards of the following JSE Listed Companies: Metrofile, Absa, Enterprise Risk Management and Setpoint. Dr Baloyi has furthermore served on the following boards:

Dr Baloyi is a Signatory of the Black Economic Empowerment Commission (BEECom), reporting as Commissioner, and also sits on the President's Black Business Working Group. She was part of the DTI task team that reviewed the final strategy document on Broad Based Empowerment that went to Parliament and resulted in the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act of 2003. Dr Baloyi also sits on the Board of Governors of the South African Business Coalition on HIV/ AIDS (SABCOHA)

Dr Baloyi spent 12 years in the US both as a student and as an academic. During her stay in the USA she taught as a college professor at different universities such as City University of New York, Rutgers University and Essex County College. She also worked for various entities such as the United Nations Development Fund for Women (UNIFEM), the African - American Institute (AAI), cut her teeth as a Management Consultant with Idea Management Consultants, and also worked at a range of corporate entities as a trainee, before returning to her motherland to make her contribution to South African society. She has also worked for Deloitte & Touche in Johannesburg as a Management Consultant for a number of years.

In 1993 Dr. Baloyi coordinated a historic summit between the ANC leadership, Black business organizations and corporates. The summit concluded with the Mopani Memorandum of Understanding signed between the ANC and Black Business, which outlined the role of business in the new South Africa. The Mopani MOU is regarded as the forerunner to BEE guidelines today.

Dr Baloyi also participates in policy formation activities that are central to the South African governments international business activities. She is the founder of DB Consulting, a Management Consulting Company that deals with Equity Management, BEE Structuring, Diversity Management and all business processes. She also founded Sensas Communications, which specializes in Events, Media Planning, and Management Communications and Logistics. Dr Baloyi is extremely proud of this company since it is wholly comprised of young women from historically disadvantaged communities whom she mentors and assists in breaking through the obstacles and difficulties of entering the corporate sector.

Dr Baloyi was awarded the 2003 'Business Woman of the year' by Top 300 Companies.

On behalf of the Council of the University of Fort Hare, the Vice-Chancellor, Prof. Derrick Swartz, and the entire University of Fort Hare community, it is a signal privilege to introduce Dr. Danisa Baloyi as the new Chancellor of the University of Fort Hare.

Doctor of Philosophy (Ph D) (Honoris Causa)

Dr. Peter Magubane

Dr. Peter Magubane is a virtual institution. As an internationally recognized photojournalist, Dr Magubane is a social realist, who has documented the plight of oppressed people in South Africa, the egregious practices of apartheid, as well as indigenous cultures of the region. His images, captured often at great personal cost, spotlighted the government's callous implementation of its racist policies and were instrumental in turning international indifference into concern opposition. Through his work therefore he has justifiably earned the reputation of being the iconic doyen of the photographic representation of the struggle for democracy in South Africa over the past fifty years.

On an anecdotal note we would like to welcome Dr Magubane back to the University of Fort Hare as he was here forty-seven years ago (1959) to cover the last UFH graduation before the introduction of the Extension of Universities Act, for *Drum Magazine* with the late Nat Makasa. Dr Magubane informs us that he vividly recalls the occasion as Billy Modise, who currently serves in the President's Office, was the SRC President at the time.

Dr. Magubane has developed a consummate skill for using the camera's lens as an instrument of social and political commentary, as well as for capturing key historical moments. Dr. Magubane has similarly used the camera to represent his aesthetic and artistic impressions of indigenous culture in South Africa.

Dr. Magubane's rise to national and international prominence was largely the result of his photographic journalistic career at *Drum Magazine* (1954-1963), at the *Rand Daily Mail* (1967-1980), as well as *Time Magazine* (1978-1998).

Dr Magubane's photographic work has revolved around the following major exhibitions:

In the Social and Political sphere:

Through the respective genres of his photographic exhibitions Dr Magubane has documented the plight of Black people under apartheid for over forty years as well as capturing indigenous cultures of rural South Africa. In this manner he has contributed substantially to preserving and recording their arts and crafts, ceremonies, rites of passage, and religious practices, as social, economic and political changes transform the national landscape.

Dr Magubane was born in Vrededorp, Johannesburg in 1932 and matriculated in Western Native Township High School. Through his life's work, his critical lens brought him to the centre of the anti-apartheid storm. This led to his solitary confinement of 586 days as well as having his nose broken and surviving being shot by a shotgun. Dr Magubane has three children: a daughter who serves as SA Consul General in New York, a son who has his own business, and a son at High School.

It is a privilege for the University of Fort Hare to confer the degree of Doctor of Philosophy (Ph D) (Honoris Causa) on Peter Magubane.

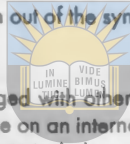
Ms. Lesley Ann Foster

Ms. Lesley Ann Foster was born in East London in 1956 and matriculated at John Bisseker High School in 1975. She is a self-confessed proud daughter of the Eastern Cape. Ms. Foster obtained a Leadership Certificate from Rhodes University in 2001, an Organizational Development Certificate from the Sedipeng Training Institute in 2000, and a Certificate in Women's Leadership from Rutgers University in the USA. She is currently enrolled for the Executive MBA degree in the Graduate School of Business at the University of Cape Town (UCT).

With little else but personal experience of domestic violence and the determination and vision to work to end violence against women, Lesley Ann Foster founded the Masimanyane Women's Support Centre in January 1996. This was the first gender-specific Centre in the central Eastern Cape region and was geared from the beginning to provide support services to victims of rape and battery.

Its encompassing vision is the creation of a society free from gender-based violence in which all women and girls are able to exercise their human rights freely. In its day-to-day work, Masimanyane assists women out of the syndrome of disempowerment that has kept them silent for countless years by offering them both practical and emotional support.

Under Lesley Ann Foster's leadership, Masimanyane has engaged with other NGOs, both provincially and nationally, in actively addressing the question of women's rights. Ms Foster also lobbies for change on an international level, but her essential commitment to the women of South Africa has never wavered, and she has extended Masimanyane to include a community outreach project that serves as a catalyst for reaching women in even the most remote rural areas.

Through the offices of Masimanyane a strong voice for women's rights now exists from local to national level, and women from all over South Africa approach the organization for assistance.

Lesley Ann Foster played a seminal role in the initial drafting of the new Domestic Violence Act, which was a co-ordinated effort by South African NGO's. Other notable achievements by Ms. Foster in this field include co-coordinating the writing of the first Shadow Report to the Convention on the Elimination of Discrimination Against Women (CEDAW - a UN Convention), co-authoring the Exploratory Study of Violence against Women, coordinating the first Survivor's Tribunal held in the Eastern Cape, and being part of the provincial team that made an input to the National White Paper on the Child Act.

Of significance within the changing paradigm of the 21st century is Lesley Ann Foster's unique concept of a women's human rights organization operating within the larger context of being a "human hearts" organization.

Ms. Foster has served on numerous national and international Boards and Committees and she has also attended and presented papers at numerous national and international conferences with a focus on women's rights and gender-based violence.

Some of Ms. Lesley Ann Foster's more recent achievements and activities at local and national level are the following:

- Assisted in the establishment of the following outreach centres:
 - Peddie Women's Support Centre
 - Ikhwezi Women's Support Centre
 - Masonwabisane Women's Support Centre
 - Scenery Park Women's Support Centre
- Setting up of a victim support centre in the Law Courts of East London and Mdantsane.
- Initiated and established a Leadership Training Institute for Women's Development - in partnership with Rhodes University, Grahamstown, and Sydney Technical University, Australia.
- Initiated and coordinated campaign for International Day of No Violence against Women and the 16 Days of Activism in the Eastern Cape.
- Established the Empilisweni HIV/AIDS Centre at Stutterheim.
- Commissioned by the Committee on the Quality of Life and Status of Women to conduct a study into the application and implementation of CEDAW in South Africa (2001).
- Trained women from nine African countries and three Scandinavian countries on the development of Shadow reports (June 2000).
- Appointed to serve on the International Committee for the Coordination of the Global Campaign on the Optional Protocol (CIN) (2000).
- Member of the Coordinating Committee of the Women's Rightsnet, a net Global Internet Training and Information network.
- Has coordinated and led various national, regional and international exchanges and leadership training as part of the International Women's Movement's Local to Global campaign.

It is in recognition of these achievements that she was nominated for the "One Thousand Women Nobel Peace Prize Campaign," in 2004 as well as for the 2003 Checkers SABC "Woman of the Year Award."

Ms. Foster has two sons and a daughter.

In awarding this Honorary Degree to Ms Lesley Ann Foster the University of Fort Hare takes special pride in being a pioneering institution to acknowledge the struggle to eradicate violence against women and to advance women's rights in South Africa.

It is a privilege for the University of Fort Hare to confer the degree of Doctor of Social Science (D Soc Sc) (Honoris Causa) on Lesley Ann Foster.

Mr Polelo Lazarus Zim

Polelo Lazarus Zim was born in Bethlehem in the Free State in 1960. He matriculated at Tiisetsang High School in Bethlehem in 1979, and then proceeded to obtain a Bachelor of Commerce degree from the University of Fort Hare in 1984, a Certificate in Marketing (1987), and a B Com Honours degree in 1988 from Witwatersrand University. He furthermore obtained the Master of Commerce degree from the then Rand Afrikaans University in 1991 and a Programme for the Development and Management of Small Business and Industries from the Israel Institute of Technology.

A self-made man, who grew up in a shack, Lazarus Zim has moved from being a 2nd Grade Clerk with Matric, through working for MIH, overseeing MTN's now lucrative "African expansion strategy" as MTN's CEO, and finally understudying Anglo American's CEO in preparation for his appointment as CEO of Anglo American on 1 February 2005. While at MTN Nigeria Lazarus Zim was instrumental in expanding MTN's interests into other African countries like the Cameroon and Egypt.

Amongst his many tasks at Anglo American, Lazarus Zim was charged with adapting South Africa's Black Economic Empowerment policy for Anglo American's Mining Sector, to enable previously disadvantaged miners to fully participate in the country's economy. The Star Business Report has described Lazarus Zim as one of South Africa's most talented and accomplished top executives.

As CEO Lazarus Zim encouraged further investment by Anglo American in the community through the Chairman's Fund. On his agenda was the empowerment of new entrepreneurs at asset level. This was to be achieved by training programmes that would involve staff who are operationally involved to understand the modalities of running a business. This is an example of Lazarus Zim's commitment to the community through education and the development of skills. In his own words, Lazarus Zim states that his corporate life has been varied, "from finance to academia, to telecoms and media and now mining." He tends to "thrive on diversity and change." Operationalizing transformation and making a positive impact on other people's lives and the economy of this country lies at the heart of Lazarus Zim's vision.

Lazarus Zim saw his role at Anglo American as being given the opportunity to implement transformation-orientated policies and mechanisms for transforming Anglo American Mining. These include, among other things, focusing on employment equity, which would entail bringing in more blacks and females as well as encouraging procurement for small business purposes which would result in more job creation. Lazarus Zim has always led by example and places his own skills to use for the betterment of his fellowmen. While working for the Bophuthatswana National Development Corporation (BNDC) he gained enormous experience in the development of small business industries. During his tenure at the BNDC, small business in the region of Mmabatho and the surrounding areas flourished, significantly due to his untiring efforts and influence. His work in Mmabatho cast Lazarus Zim in the mould of a leader who is committed to uplifting the quality of the lives of formerly disadvantaged communities.

On leaving the CEO position at Anglo American at the end of April 2006, Lazarus Zim's new venture into broad-based Black Economic Empowerment in the mineral sector has been warmly welcomed by not only the black business world, but also the government, and such worker's unions as the NUM, who hope that he will use his authority to accelerate the transformation of this sector.

A PROFILE

Learnmore Kambizi was born on the 1st June 1970 in Guruve District of Zimbabwe. He did his 'O' and 'A Levels at St Philips Magwenya High and Howard Institute in Mashonaland Central Province, Zimbabwe. In 1993 he went to Cuba to pursue a Bachelor of Science degree in Biology before returning home to teach Biological sciences at high school level.

In 2000, he was awarded a scholarship by the Zimbabwean government to study for a Master of Science degree in Botany at the University of Fort Hare. Upon completion in 2001, he registered for a PhD in Plant Science in 2002. After finishing his PhD, he went back to Zimbabwe where he worked as a lecturer at the University of Zimbabwe and the Zimbabwe Open University during the year 2005.

For his doctoral research, an ethnomedical study of plants used for the treatment of sexually transmitted infections in the Eastern Cape was undertaken. Laboratory research was conducted into the antimicrobial properties of some of the frequently used plants. With the isolation of bio-active ingredients, he completed a thorough investigation and validated the efficacy of these plants against the causative organisms of some STIs such as gonorrhoea and genital herpes. Some medicinal plants in the study area were found to be threatened due to intensive utilization. He also undertook some conservation studies during which he developed efficient methods for their rapid propagation. The examiners have described the research as very important and relevant in stimulating future initiative in the field of new drug development and conservation of high value plants. Four peer-reviewed papers have already been published from this research.

Mr. Kambizi is married to Mercy and has one child, Munashe.

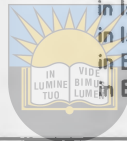
