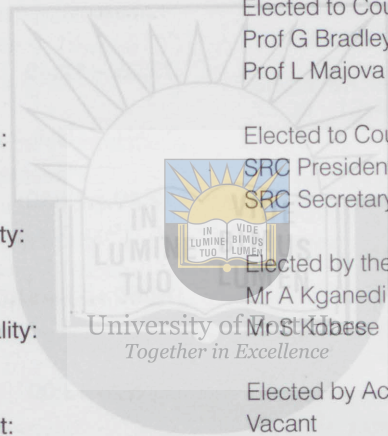

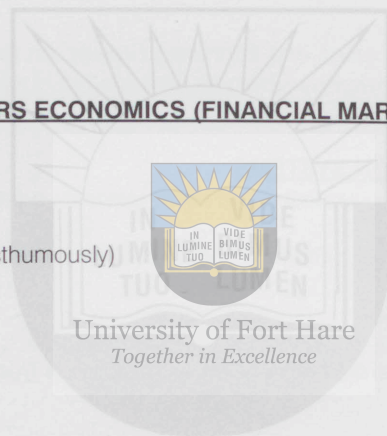

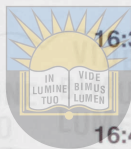

HONORARY DOCTORATE DEGREE

CITATION: DR. LEEPILE MOSHWEU TAUNYANE
(Graduation, May 2012)

Leepile Moshweu Taunyane was born on 14 December 1928 in Alexandra in Johannesburg. Taunyane matriculated from Orlando High School in 1950. Before proceeding to the University of Fort Hare in 1956, he had already completed a Teacher's Diploma at the Bethesda Opleiding Skool – Medium of Afrikaans where he passed Laër, Hoër en Hoogste Taalbond Examinations with flying colours. He enrolled for the B.A. degree at the University College of Fort Hare (while the university was still a constituent college of Rhodes University, Grahamstown) and graduated in 1959. He was conferred with a D.Litt. et Phil degree (honoris causa) in Administration by the University of South Africa in 2006 – to epitomize his enormous contribution to the administrative reform that he was engaged in for a long time in the country.

Taunyane started his teaching career in 1953 and in 1960 he became the Principal of one of the most famous high schools in the Johannesburg area – Alexandra High School until 1975. He moved to Germiston where he was Principal of the Katlehong High School from 1976 until 1993 when he retired.

Dr Taunyane has been involved in Human Rights Activities much earlier than most politicians in South Africa had dreamt of becoming involved in political movements. He is one of the few leaders who had early contact with the world's most famous leader Nelson Mandela during the fifties when his community was harassed by the repressive white minority government. The regime intended to move Black people out of the Alexandra Township to other sprawling townships around the reef in order to turn Alexandra into a Black hostel city. Blacks could only stay and live in the hostel to provide cheap labour to the neighbouring city of Johannesburg and its suburbs. He established the Alexandra Liaison Committee to negotiate with the Peri-Urban Areas Health Board, and invited all progressive political parties to get involved in the fight against the stoppage of the hostel building programme which, they knew, would have had a dreadful effect on the established community in the township. They also wanted to prevent Alexandra from being disestablished as a family based community and stop the out-movement of families.

He was also the first and later Life President, of the then Transvaal United African Teachers Association (TUATA), a Black teachers' association that was formed during the difficult apartheid era purposed to bring all black teachers in the Province together and amass their strengths to fight for a just educational system for all the people of the country.

Dr. Taunyane has served on a number of other organizations and commissions destined to challenge the draconian laws that had disadvantaged Black people politically, economically and socially. He served on the ANC/Government Joint Working Committee; the Interim Education Working Party, and the Mouton Committees, the HSRC De Lange and the Retief Commissions; as well as educational and research bodies, that had focused on the democratization of the system of education in South Africa.

He also led a delegation of the National Professional Teachers Organization of South Africa (NAPTOSA)'s Leaders to the 7th Congress of World Confederation of Teachers in Kuala Lumpur – Malaysia in August 1998. This congress was in pursuit of the ideals of a fair and equitable system of education for all.

Dr. Taunyane has been involved in many organizations that were and still are, engaged in programmes that are fostering the philosophies of non-racialism in the country the most notable is football which has united all races in South Africa. He has personally nurtured those organizations from their humble beginnings. For example, the Alexandra Football Association that has now honoured him with the Life Presidency position, right up to the national football structure – the South African Football Association (SAFA) which has honoured him with a Life Membership status.

Dr. Taunyane has played a critical role in promoting gender equality within the organizations that he had served. He was one of the most instrumental people to promote the ideas of female footballers in the country and today we have a formidable Banyana-Banyana national female soccer squad. He has also supported and even served on other community-based female organizations largely in the Alexandra Township whose influences have impacted on other areas in the country.

Dr. Taunyane is a strong supporter of the University of Fort Hare Alumni Association, Gauteng Provincial Chapter that promotes the University's mission of staying a Leader in the higher education system. He is a selfless leader, like all other great leaders on the mother African Continent, who had crossed the River Tzume many times going either to the famous little town of Alice, or to Kwa-Ntselamanzi to watch sport. This has been his way of life ever since. He played for the first division of the football team of the University, and he also captained the team for more than a year while he was still a student of the institution. The many past and current students of the University from the Gauteng Province have been strongly encouraged and influenced by people like Dr. Taunyane to study at the University of Fort Hare because its reputation and role in the history African higher education.

Dr Taunyane is also an author of note. He has, to his credit a number of books which include:

- An anthology on Setswana poems called – “Tswina”. This book was prescribed at schools where Setswana is taught.
- A History of the Methodist Church in Africa,
- Matseka –a- Malala – Muila – a popular story book in Setswana,

In addition, he translated into Setswana a book entitled, “The Street Detectives” by Janis Ford. He also published number articles pertaining educational issues.

The University of Fort Hare is proud to honour this great leader and activists, with an honorary Doctor of Philosophy in Education.

KHEWU Noncedo

PROFILE

Noncedo Princess Dorcas Khewu was born and bred in Cala in the Eastern Cape Province. She has, to her credit, the following educational qualifications; a Secondary Education Diploma from Free State University (1995); Diploma in Psychology from Intec College (1997); BTech in Education Management from Tshwane University of Technology (1999) and a Masters in Applied Ethics at the University of Stellenbosch (2001).

Noncedo registered for a PhD in Education programme at the University of Fort Hare in 2009. Noncedo's research focused on the problem of discipline in schools. Using a post-positivist mixed methods design the study interrogated the consistency that prevails between disciplinary practices used in schools and principles of Alternative to Corporal Punishment (ATCP) policy; and the implications of this for school leadership.

One of the main findings was that school principals and teachers revealed ambivalence and lack of understanding of the policy. Measures used to instil discipline in schools even though they were said to be based on alternatives to corporal punishment placed heavy emphasis on inflicting pain and relied on extrinsic control of learners. Such measures were found to have weak association with violent behaviour, which alternatives to corporal punishment seek to eradicate. One of the external examiners recommended that the thesis "...be published in a book form to benefit society..."; and another commented that the thesis "...contributes to scholarly debates in the field..."

Noncedo is a mother to two, Lerato the daughter and, Khubalo her son.

PROFILE

Thembinkosi Ncube was born in the city of Bulawayo in the province of Matabeleland in Western Zimbabwe. He did his primary education at St George's school in the small coal mining town of Hwange where he grew up. He did his 'O' level studies at Glog High school and completed his 'A' level at Matopo High school in Matabeleland south.

He was enrolled in the University of Zimbabwe in 1990 to study for a B.A. degree in English, History and Ndebele. In 1993 he taught in high schools in Matabeleland. In 1995, he enrolled at the University of Zimbabwe again to study for a Graduate Certificate in Education. In 1999 out of passion for widening his pedagogical horizons, he enrolled with the Zimbabwe Open University to study for an M.Ed. in Educational Planning and Policy studies. He remained in the classroom and championed the introduction of the first 'A' level programme in the Hwange district at Gebhuza High School where he taught English.

In 2007, because of political and economic problems he crossed over to South Africa where he taught in high schools up to 2008. In 2009, he enrolled for a Ph.D. under a SADC scholarship at the University of Fort Hare. His PhD thesis entitled "A study of the relations of family and school attachment to forms of learner violence in secondary school communities in Amathole Education District, Eastern Cape" explored the attachment theory and how attachment to home and school relates tendencies of verbal and physical violence in adolescent learners in high schools. In this positivist study, he applied Spearman rho tests to gauge the extent to which family and school attachment is associated with verbal and physical violence. Also, Chi Square tests were used to ascertain significant gender and quintile (socio-economic) differences.

His findings revealed that violence prevails in schools and that all stakeholders still have a lot to do. External examiners praised the study as comprehensive and beneficial to attachment studies in Southern Africa. He is currently working on papers based on his study. His Ph.D. thesis implores government and schools in particular, to formulate and adopt programmes that will encourage learner attachment to the school environments. It further appeals to the community to build bridges by reaching out to their own children to lessen incidences of violence resulting from detachment from home.

PROFILE

Phindezwa Elizabeth Mnyaka completed a Bachelor of Arts degree at Rhodes University in 2003. In 2008 she graduated with a Master of Arts in History at the University of Fort Hare while undergoing a research internship at the Fort Hare Institute of Social and Economic Research.

Her doctoral thesis pays attention to the photographic collection of the late archivist, historian and photographer Joseph Denfield. Denfield figures among a small group of powerful colonial photographers who shaped the visual economy of Southern Africa. Thus the thesis subjects him to what he himself called para-photography by which his entire field of endeavour is scrutinised through a series of lenses, which ask us to think about the way photographs constitute history.

Upon reading the thesis the examiners described it is an excellent focused thesis, which has generated substantial new work in terms of connecting public and visual histories in new ways, in challenging photographic genres and interpretations within African and South African historical studies, in providing new, innovative and creative ways to re-read visual, institutional and other archives, and in offering original and substantial new critical histories' deconstructing intellectual settler culture locally and nationally, amongst others.

PROFILE

Born to Elisha Abuya and Abigael Abuya, Willice is the 4th child in a family of six siblings, all university graduates. Willice holds a Honours degree (Sociology and Anthropology), and a Master's degree (Sociology), both obtained at the University of Nairobi, Kenya.

Willice registered for his Doctor of Philosophy degree with the Department of Sociology at the University of Fort Hare in 2008, under the supervision of Prof. Wilson Akpan. His thesis examines mining conflict from an ethno-ecological perspective. It examines how meanings that communities attach to 'nature' and cultural artefacts intersect with local experiences of social

displacement, compensation and resource extraction, and how these mediate and catalyse conflict among the displaced residents of Kwale, Coast Province, Kenya.

The study revealed that socially constructed meanings do play a significant role in mining conflict, and that such meanings are lost in instances of social displacement and mining, and since 'nature' and 'culture' are embedded in communally constructed meanings, socio-environmental remediation practices that fail to take cognizance of them run the risk of not having the desired effect.

The study also revealed the contradictions that could arise when people who uphold or proclaim certain cultural values and attachments are faced with specific economic choices under particular circumstances. Willice has presented research articles based on this thesis in several conferences. Willice has several years teaching experience at Moi University (Kenya), and he has also lectured on part-time basis at UFH during the course of the PhD.

Willice dedicates his thesis to his two lovely sons, Adrian and Brandon Abuya.

PROFILE

Born in Nqamakwe, Eastern Cape, in April 1978, Sonwabile Mwanana attended Toboyi Junior Secondary School and matriculated at Ngubeszwe Senior Secondary School. He received professional teacher training at Dr Rubusana College and Rhodes University. Mwanana is an experienced teacher. He also acquired an Honours degree and a Master's in Education at the University of Fort Hare.

In 2008, he registered for the Doctor of Philosophy in Social Sciences with the Sociology Department at the University of Fort Hare, under the supervision of Professor Wilson Akpan. His thesis examines the character of community participation in mineral wealth utilisation in platinum-rich traditional communities in the North West Province – particularly the conditions under which community participation in natural resource utilisation and management promote or hinder sustainable community development. Among the key findings of the thesis are that despite observed benefits, the interface of resource wealth and community development is fraught with tokenistic participation, elite-targeted grassroots anger, and local tensions – all

linked to the contradictory nature of participation. As such, the study compels a shift of analytical focus from conflict as an epiphenomenon of collective community exclusion and deprivation to conflict as also resulting from collective community inclusion. Mnwana has presented research articles based of this thesis locally and internationally, some of which have been published in accredited journals. He also held several part-time lecturing positions and research supervision during the course of the PhD. Sonwabile is married with three daughters.

PROFILE

Ross Truscott began his PhD in 2008, after completing an MPsych at UWC. His dissertation examines the relationship between post-apartheid nationalism and whiteness, specifically Afrikanerness. The overarching argument presented is that the end of apartheid occasioned a loss for Afrikaners, a loss for which there are not the symbolic resources with which to mark it as a loss – indeed, apartheid is an unmournable loss, producing forms of grief that take on a subterranean, symptomatic afterlife. The picture presented, then, is of a failure to have mourned the past.

Ross has presented his work at various international and South African conferences, published sections of it in peer reviewed international and local journals, and has spent time at the London School of Economics as a visiting research student. The three examiners of his dissertation – established international academics – all passed it unconditionally, a feat in itself. One examiner called his PhD “impeccable and outstanding.” Another said it was “demonstrative of a committed scholarship as broad and comprehensive as it is deep and probing.” The third examiner referred to it as the best dissertation he had ever assessed, as he put it, “a wonderful PhD that sets an impressive precedent for the candidate’s future scholarly output.”
