# HONORARY DOCTORAL DEGREE

**CITATION: DR XAVIER FRANCIS CARELSE  
(DOCTOR OF SCIENCE) (*honoris causa*)**

## PROFILE

Chancellor, Honorable Justice Skweyiya, Vice-Chancellor, Dr Tom, and the entire University of Fort Hare community – it is an honour to present Dr Xavier Francis Carelse, for the honorary degree, Doctor of Science (D Sc.) It is a special privilege to introduce Dr Carelse to the Fort Hare community as he is a distinguished alumnus of the University of Fort Hare, who has done the institution proud as a result of his life-long work in advancing science education on the African continent.

Dr Carelse was born on 11 March 1933 in Kimberley, South Africa. He was the first student to register for three majors in the Faculty of Science at the University College of Fort Hare in 1952 and he was subsequently awarded the Bachelor of Science (B Sc) degree with First Class passes in Physics and Chemistry, and an Upper Second Class pass in Mathematics in 1954. He thereafter obtained the BSc (Honours) degree in Physics from Rhodes University, Grahamstown in 1955, and an MSc degree in Physics from the University of Witwatersrand, Johannesburg, in 1957. The culmination of Dr Carelse's academic education was his obtaining the doctoral degree in Electronic Engineering from Brunel University, at Uxbridge in the United Kingdom in 1973. It is readily apparent that Dr Carelse had an outstanding academic training to pursue his passion for science education in Africa.

In terms of the University of Fort Hare criteria for the awarding of honorary degrees, Dr Carelse meets all the requirements with distinction. The outstanding aspect of the nomination of Dr Carelse for the honorary doctoral degree inScience is, very simply, the manner in which he has dedicated most of his professional life in the cause of advancing science education in Africa. In terms of his contribution to the progressive social, educational and economic development of society, DrCarelse has taught at schools and universities in five African countries, including South Africa, Ghana, Nigeria, Sudan, and especially in Zimbabwe, where he worked for twenty years after independence in 1980. He played a significant role in promoting science education and national post-colonial development in Ghana (1957), Nigeria (1961), and Zimbabwe after 1981. During his stay in Nigeria he was a founder member of the University of Nigeria at Nsukka (UNN), and he assisted in establishing and developing the Department of Physics.

Dr Carelse has gained international recognition for his work in designing high quality electronic equipment for science education at secondary and tertiary levels. This was largely achieved through his work as the Originator of the SLATE (Science Laboratory and Teaching Equipment) Project in Zimbabwe where he designed and commercialized more than 50 products, some of which were exported from Zimbabwe to South Africa, Botswana and Ethiopia.

Between 2003 and 2013 he designed, improved and manufactured the Scientific and Industrial Research and Development Centre (SIRDC),



Microcontroller Training Kit, consisting of more than 20 modules which allowed many Zimbabwean scientists and technicians to contribute to the industrial development of their country.

Dr Carelse served the University of Zimbabwe with distinction in the period 1981 – 1999. In his work in the Physics Department Dr Carelse trained and mentored undergraduate and graduate students for their future role in promoting scientific development in newly-independent Zimbabwe. One of his Masters students, Raphael Mukaro, was acclaimed by the Third World Academy of Sciences as the Young Scientist of the Year for the African continent, in 2004. Dr Carelse has also published extensively: he authored and co-authored numerous articles in refereed scientific journals; he has similarly authored and co-authored numerous books, manuals and reports; his list of conference papers is as impressive as it is extensive. In recognition of his outstanding academic accomplishments he was the recipient of numerous visiting fellowships in Europe and the United States. In recognition of his outstanding contribution to science education and research, Dr Carelse was inducted as a fellow, into the Zimbabwe Academy of Sciences in 2012.

Dr Carelse has in his professional and social activities been a proud ambassador for the historically cherished Fort Hare ideals especially with regard to Human Rights, non-racialism and gender equality. Dr Carelse's advancement of the ideals of non-racialism is by virtue of his pioneering personal example of scholarly achievements. At the height of the policies of racial segregation and apartheid in South Africa, he was the first Fort Harian to be accepted for enrolment at Rhodes University when it was a

segregated whites-only university, as well as being the first Fort Harian to be awarded the Rhodes University Foundation scholarship which is given annually to the best graduate at Rhodes University. Dr Carelse was also the first black person in South Africa to be appointed by Dr Basil Schonland as a Research Officer at the Bernard Price Institute (BPI) for Geophysical Research at the University of Witwatersrand (WITS), and in 1957, the first scientist, black or white, to obtain a higher degree based on research conducted at the BPI.

In terms of gender equality Dr Carelse promoted equal opportunities for male and female students in his academic programmes as well the research institutes he was involved with. In 2002 he appointed male and female technicians into his team that formed the nucleus of the Electronic and Communications Institute that he established at the Scientific and Industrial Research and Development Centre (SIRDC), in Harare. Because of his encouragement and training female students proceeded to enrol for degrees in Electronic Engineering at the Harare Institute of Technology.

Although Dr Carelse spent most of his professional life beyond the borders of South Africa, his commitment to advancing non-racialism and human rights in his native country was unwavering. He addressed numerous forums abroad on the situation in apartheid South Africa, especially regarding the imprisonment of Nelson Mandela and other political prisoners.

Dr Carelse has also had an abiding interest in promoting the Arts. During his tenure at the University of Nigeria, he assisted as Stage Manager for the College of Drama to launch a series of African-based stage musicals including



“King Kong,” “Aida,” “No Strings,” and “Witch Boy,” which was based on the American musical “Dark of the Moon.” In 1996 he became a founder member of the Zimbabwe Academic and Non-fiction Authors Association (ZANA), and has served on its National Executive Committee since its inauguration. In this capacity he assisted promising young Zimbabwean authors to publish their works of non-fiction.

There is a parable, an instructive lesson in selfless service, in the return, to acclaim, of this accomplished son of the University of Fort Hare to his *alma mater* after 61 years. He has represented the finest values, the finest traditions, of this historic institution, in his life of service to science education in Africa.

Chancellor, Honourable Justice Skweyiya, Vice Chancellor, Dr Tom, and the assembled University of Fort Hare community, it is a distinct honour to present Dr Xavier Carelse for the degree, Doctor of Science (D Sc) (*honoris causa*).

## **DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY IN AGRICULTURAL ECONOMICS**

**FAKUNLE Olufemi Oyedokun**

### **PROFILE**

Olufemi Oyedekun Fakunle holds a Bachelor of Agriculture, Honours (Agricultural Economics) from the Federal University of Agriculture, Abeokuta, MSc (Agricultural Economics) from the University of Ibadan, and Masters in Business Administration from the University of Ilorin, all in Nigeria. Olufemi worked at Intercontinental Bank PLC, Nigeria and WEMA Bank PLC, in various capacities including as Business Development Manager.

For his PhD, Olufemi examined the role of motivational factors in small farmer water use preferences, focusing on crop enterprises in the former homelands of the Eastern Cape Province. The study yielded important insights about the path and dimensions of the on-going agricultural transformation in the smallholder sector and how they are conditioned by human behaviour key elements of which are amenable to direct interventions to align them to policies that contribute to national developmental goals. Olufemi is grateful to the Water Research Commission and GMRDC for supporting his research.

## **DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY IN AGRICULTURAL ECONOMICS**

**MAPFUMO Alexander**

### **PROFILE**

Mapfumo Alexander was awarded the Zimbabwe Presidential Scholarship in 2010 where he graduated with a cum laude in BSc. (Honours) in Agricultural Economics in 2011 and MSc in Agricultural Economics in 2012 at University of Fort Hare.

His PhD thesis is entitled *“Livelihood strategies and food security for resettled smallholder tobacco and non-tobacco farmers: The case of Manicaland Province in Zimbabwe”*. The study was crucial as it formulated important policy implications and livelihood strategies to make positive exits from food insecurity.

He has worked as a high school teacher in Masvingo, Zimbabwe for a year. He is currently a Lecturer at Great Zimbabwe University. He has published five peer reviewed journal articles and presented some of his work at conferences.

### **DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY IN ANIMAL SCIENCE**

#### **CHULAYO Amanda Yucca**

#### **PROFILE**

Amanda CHULAYO enrolled for her PhD in Animal Science in 2012 which was sponsored by the National Research Foundation (NRF) - Scarce Skills Bursary and the RMRDSA. Her study focused on the effects of transportation, distance travelled, lairage duration and animal-related factors on pre-slaughter stress indicators, carcass characteristics, nanostructure and technological properties of beef from six genotypes of cattle. She found out that exposing animals to longer hours of transportation did not only reduce glucose levels, but also increased the expression of heat shock proteins, cortisol, creatine kinase and lactate dehydrogenase which are good indicators of animal welfare.

Furthermore, pre-slaughter stress negatively affected the beef nanostructure and technological properties, and heifers had the best muscle fibres, sarcomere length and visible intercalated discs with improved tenderness, colour and pH. She presented her work at the International Congress on Meat Science and Technology in Ghent, Belgium (2012), Izmir, Turkey (2013) and Punta del Este, Uruguay (2014) and at the South African Society for Animal Science Congresses. One paper from her PhD has been accepted by the

journal, *Meat Science* and four others are under review in different high impact international journals, including *Meat Science*. To her credit, Amanda has published six papers.

### **DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY IN SOIL SCIENCE**

#### **MUPAMBWA Hupenyu Allan**

#### **PROFILE**

After graduating with his BSc degree, Hupenyu Allan Mupambwa worked as a researcher for the government department of research in Zimbabwe for 4 years. He graduated with an MSc degree from the University of Fort Hare in 2012, and proceeded to undertake his PhD studies at the same University, with funding from GMRDC and the NRF Incentive funding for rated scientists.

Hupenyu's PhD studies focused on improving the fertilizer value of fly ash, a product of coal combustion. His research showed that fly ash incorporation at a specific ratio of 1:2 into optimized cow dung – waste paper mixtures resulted in effective microbial – earthworm activity that generated a phosphorus rich vermicompost. The inclusion of effective microorganisms during vermicomposting increased enzyme activities and created an optimum earthworm- microbe environment. These results indicated that



optimized vermicomposting of fly ash presents an opportunity for effective coal waste beneficiation.

One of his examiners recommended unconditional acceptance of the thesis title: and another described his research as seminal. Three manuscripts from his results have been published in 3 high impact ISI listed journals, and 3 others are at different stages of publication.

**MUPAMBWA Hupenyu Allan**

**DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY IN SOIL SCIENCE**

**UNUOFIN Frank Oshioname**

**PROFILE**

Frank Oshioname Unuofin completed his Bachelor's degree in Soil Science and Land Management from the Federal University of Agriculture, Abeokuta, Nigeria in 2002. He graduated with an MSc degree in Soil Science from the University of Ibadan, Nigeria, in 2006. He is employed as a Senior Research Officer by the Forestry Research Institute of Nigeria. In 2011, he enrolled for his doctoral studies in Soil Science at

the University of Fort Hare sponsored by the GMRDC.

Frank's PhD work aimed at optimizing the vermicomposting of cow dung – waste paper mixtures as a strategy for waste paper management and organic fertilizer production. He showed that the optimum earthworm stocking density for the waste mixture bioconversion was much lower than that needed for maximum nutrient release from the resultant vermicomposts. His study established the minimum rate of rock phosphate incorporation into the waste mixture necessary for efficient biodegradation. He further demonstrated that the phosphorus in rock phosphate was responsible for the enhanced biodegradation of cow dung-waste paper mixtures.

Frank has so far published one paper in a high impact ISI listed journal and two other manuscripts are at different stages of publication. He is a member of the Soil Science Society of South Africa (SSSSA) and the Soil Science Society of Nigeria (SSSN).

### **PROFILE**

Opeyemi Nudewhenu Avoseh attended Iworo Ajido High School, Badagry and had his Bachelor of Honours in Chemistry from Lagos State University, Lagos in 2004 where he emerged as best graduating student and his MSc in Organic Chemistry from the University of Ibadan, Nigeria (2009). He is currently an Assistant Lecturer in Chemistry Department of Lagos State University, Lagos. He became a PhD student in Natural Product and Organic synthetic Group of Chemistry department, University of Fort Hare where his research was centred on Isolation, Characterisation of Terpenoids and Biosynof Silver Nanoparticles of *Acacia mearnsii* De Wild and *Acacia karroo* Hayne and Their Bioassays.

The study evaluated the chemical and pharmacological importance of invasive species of *Acacia*. The isolated metabolites also exhibit an extremely high anti-inflammatory ability on an animal model. In addition, novel Silver nanoparticles were synthesized from hydrosols of the plant species which display diverse biological potential. His research captured under NRF-IKS, is an evidence based evaluation of local and indigenous plant species. Avoseh has published 2 articles in International peer review journals and about 4 articles are under different review stages. He is a member of South Africa Chemical Institute

(SACI) and IUPAC international and has attended and presented oral and poster presentations in several national conferences.

**MUNGONDORI Henry Heroe**

### **PROFILE**

Henry Heroe Mungondori holds a BSc Chemistry and Biochemistry degree from the University of Zimbabwe. In 2008 he worked for Swartland Ostrich Tannery and Cape Game Skin as a laboratory chemist. Henry obtained a BSc (Honours) in Chemistry (2011) and an MSc in Chemistry (2012) from the University of Fort Hare. He also studied advanced water treatment courses at MSc level with Wageningen University in Netherlands.

In his PhD, Henry specialized in water and wastewater treatment using advanced oxidation and membrane technologies. He prepared novel photo-catalytic copolymer grafted asymmetric membranes which he employed in the treatment of water contaminated with organic, inorganic and microbial pollutants. The study revealed that the



photo-catalytic membranes possess antifouling and antimicrobial properties, and are capable of photo-oxidizing organic pollutants (bentazon, atrazine and paraquat). The study is a huge contribution towards titanium dioxide commercialization. The main technical challenge of this photo-catalyst is removal of the spent fine powders from water after the treatment process. His findings have been published in international peer reviewed journals and he is in the process of writing more manuscripts.

The research project had covered a wide range of geological subjects, dealing with stratigraphy, tectonic setting, sedimentary facies, coal petrology, geochemical exploration, geophysical investigation, depositional environments, diagenetic evolution and basin subsidence history of the Soutpansberg and Tuli Coalfields and quantified the factors controlling the formation



processes of the coal-deposits. The research has led to a deeper understanding of the coal formation in South Africa, and provides a staunch example for coal research and basin analysis. The research has in particular, practical use and economic significance in the coal exploration and mining industry in South Africa.

Mr Malaza's main research interests are in the Karoo basins in South Africa, including Waterberg, Soutpansberg, Tuli, Springbok Flats and KaNgwane Basins. Based on his research, he has already published 3 papers in the accredited journals, and more publications are in the preparations.

During her doctoral studies, Iren focused on the kinetics of biomass with Sorbent blends using both the model-free and model-fitting approaches in order to understand the degradation mechanism of the solid state reaction. Biomass is one of the main renewable energy sources. The addition of sorbents such as Calcium Oxide (CaO) and or Magnesium Oxide (MgO) sorbents enhances the biomass conversion efficiency during gasification. The kinetic study of materials is undertaken to establish the possible thermal behavior of the materials, and this information is also used in the assessment of possible design parameters for industrial biomass conversion technologies.



Iren also established the mixing ratios that results in enhanced conversion efficiency during gasification. The reaction kinetics of various biomass materials have been well researched, however this was the first study that looked at the reaction kinetics of biomass with sorbent materials, and it attracted a lot of attention at national and International conferences. Iren also developed a mathematical model that can be used to predict the reaction kinetics of the materials studied under various conditions. A financial model was also developed assuming a 2MW electricity generation facility using the studied materials.

During her PhD studies, Iren published two papers in peer-reviewed journals and two papers in the conference proceedings. She also presented two papers in International conferences, and two more papers were presented in national conferences.

# DOCTORATE DEGREES

## **DOCTOR OF ADMINISTRATION**

**MASUKU Khethokwakhe Wiseman**

### **PROFILE**

Masuku is among the few doctoral students in the country to focus on indigenous M&E approach. This is in line with the “Back to Basics approach” within African Renaissance. His thesis provides an integration of traditional leadership into modern governance through Participatory Monitoring and Evaluation (PME). The conceptual question deals with the relevance of traditional leaders (Amakhosi) in modern governance.

His findings reveal that Uthungulu District Municipality (UDM) in KZN is running governance without being held accountable by the communities through Amakhosi. The study concludes that the absence of M&E approach in rural municipalities like UDM requires a PM&E to allow Amakhosi to participate in both planning (Integrated Development Plan) and in Monitoring, Reporting, and Evaluation. This is because traditional governance complements modern governance in rural municipalities. The study recommends the development of a White Paper, and the designing of planning principles for PM&E. It is recommended that countries that have integrated the institution of traditional governance into modern governance should be explored.

### **PROFILE**

Viola Matunhu holds various academic and professional qualifications in Nursing Science including the MSc in Human Resources Management with MSU. She is currently the Director of Health Services at Midlands State University. She registered her D.Admin degree in 2013 and is thankful to GMRDC for the financial support.

The study established that there is a rampant abuse and misuse of agro-chemicals and this is definitely a challenge for policy implementation. It also emerged that there are counterfeit agro-chemicals that are being dispensed by unregistered individuals in the District.

The thesis concludes that while the fast track land reform programme is successful in empowering the previously economically disempowered Zimbabweans, the implementation of the Public health policy is crucial. All the three external examiners passed the thesis title with good ratings. One of the international examiners described the thesis title as both distinctive and ground breaking.

#### **PROFILE**

Ms Muswaka completed her undergraduate studies at the University of Zimbabwe in 2010 after which she attained a Bachelor of Social Science degree in Administration. In 2011, Ms Muswaka registered at the University of Fort Hare to pursue her Honours degree in Administration and graduated in 2012. In 2012, she was awarded a supervisor linked bursary by Govern Mbeki Research and Development Centre to pursue her Masters studies in Administration (Public Administration) which she completed and managed to graduate in 2013.

The thesis argues that the effectual implementation of good governance principles within local government institutions has become a global issue yet Zimbabwe continues to lag behind in this regard. This is mainly due to the fact that despite the reformation in the Zimbabwean constitution (2013) to accommodate good governance, the existence of good governance practices within local institutions still remains questionable. All the examiners praised and highly commended the candidate for this excellent academic work. One international examiner highlighted that good governance is a very crucial in promoting sound administration and it would be beneficial for municipal leaders to take

cognisance of the findings and recommendations highlighted by the candidate.

The thesis argues that local government in Zimbabwe is showing evidence of failure to discharge its mandate due to inter-alia its inability to make live its human resource management strategies. The thesis revealed that good HRM strategies are not being implemented properly. The study recommends among others a review of the legal framework of local government so that it can be held accountable for employing competent and capable employees.

### **PROFILE**

Nkosiphendule Mlamli Myataza holds a B.Sc Honours degree (Unitra), a PGCE (Unisa) and an MBA (Milpark). He served in the Department of Education as an Educator and Education Specialist. Nkosiphendule has also been a part-time lecturer with the NMMU (SMATE programme) whose focus was on science and mathematics education for educators. In his current employment by the Eastern Cape Legislature's Research Unit he has directed some research studies on the Provincial Procurement Price Index, Provincial department's compliance to budgeting processes and the Provincial municipalities' compliance to the financial management oversight prescripts on behalf of the Portfolio Committee on Finance and Provincial Expenditure. The thesis explored the current status of e-procurement implementation in the Eastern Cape government together with attendant change management strategies.

Based on findings the study formed a framework to enhance e-procurement in the Province. The model brings to the fore a secure intranet, a supplier's database, a service providers' extranet, bridging of the digital divide, change management strategies as well as the inculcation of ethical behaviour.

Pastor Olusola obtained his first degree in Accountancy in 1991 followed by an MBA in 2009. He registered for PhD in 2013.

The aim of the thesis is to develop strategies by which township dwellers would "mind their own business" and become "masters of their own destinies". The study revealed that in spite of South Africa's remarkable political transition through various policies; economic transformation remains incomplete as it excludes the majority especially those in the townships.

A survey conducted in Khayelitsha, revealed a high level of unwillingness towards entrepreneurial activities. The recommendations are embedded in the acronyms "*NEEDS HELP*": "*Neighbourhood Enhancement and Environmental Development Strategy*" and "*Holistic Entrepreneurial Lifestyle Programme*". One of the international examiners remarked that "the thesis is an excellent product of academic exercise". A paper is awaiting approval for presentation in a workshop in Washington, USA. Oduwole is thankful to GMRDC for their financial support and to his supervisor for his excellent academic skills and motivation which inspired him to finish within two years.

**ADEWUMI Toyin Mary**

### **PROFILE**

Oluwatoyin obtained Bachelor of Education Honours in Educational Management at the University of Ilorin, Nigeria in 2003. In 2012, she graduated with Master of Education in Curriculum Studies (*Cum Laude*) from the University of Fort Hare, and immediately proceeded with her PhD studies.

Her doctoral thesis assessed the implementation of inclusion policy for learners with special education needs in selected Primary Schools in the Fort Beaufort Education District. The study was located within the post-positivism paradigm and used a mixed method research approach. The study revealed that while the inclusion policy is being implemented, there are pockets of good practice in spite of the challenges encountered in the process. The study recommended an alternative model for the implementation of inclusion programmes that may yield better results.

All the external examiners agreed that the study was well conceptualised and adds new knowledge to the implementation of inclusion policy for learners with special education needs. One examiner commented that *“On the whole, the candidate is capable of conducting independent research.... some parts of the study should be*

*published.”* Toyin has contributed three educational publications in various Educational journals and others are currently under review for publication in accredited journals.

### **PROFILE**

Ms Manthekeleng holds a B.Ed (Pedagogy); B.Hons. (Social Sciences); M.Ed (Education) all from the University of Fort Hare. In 2006 she registered for a PhD in Education.

The focus of the study was on understanding the students' English First Additional Language reading and response in the Faculty of Education at the University of Fort Hare. Using a qualitative research method, the study used a constructivist perspective to assist students to read and respond. In this longitudinal study over a period of four years data were collected through documents, participant observation, journal entry, assessments and focus groups interviews. The study signals a deliberate foreswearing of voice



and agency through the subjective nature of her interpretations. One of the main findings was that language learning can be easier if it is considered as social practice with academic purpose.

One of the external examiners observed that the study is “...*ground clearing ...for across the country...*” investigation. An article from the study has been accepted for publication and two others are under review in peer-reviewed Journals.

### **PROFILE**

Miriam Mutirwara holds a Master of Education in Educational Administration, Planning and Policy Studies (Zimbabwe Open University); Bachelor of Arts (University of South Africa) and a Certificate in Education (University of Zimbabwe; Gweru Teacher’s College). In 2012 she registered for a PhD in Education.

The study explored the domains of graduateness and employability at one Polytechnic in Zimbabwe. The focus was on how instructional delivery strategies and assessment tools could embed domains of graduateness and employer expectations. A phenomenological approach was used in conducting the study. Human capital, teaching methods and flexible training models,

among others, emerged as major strengths in training. However, a need to revisit the hidden (covert) curriculum was identified, as training was sometimes dependent on the availability of resources. The study proposes a framework for promoting graduateness and enhancing employability. One examiner remarked that “*this is a well written thesis and contributes to scholarly debates in the field*”.

### **PROFILE**

Alnord Levison Dave Mwanza has the following qualifications to his credit: a Diploma in Mechanical Engineering (with credit); Bachelor of Science (Technical Education) with distinction; Bachelor of Education (Honours) in Mathematics; Master of Education (Policy, Planning and Leadership) with distinction at the University of Malawi. In 2011 he registered for PhD in Education at the University of Fort Hare.

The purpose of the study was to investigate how the quality of mentoring was assured during a year-long teaching practice in the Malawi one-year-of-theory and one-year-of-practicum model of initial teacher education. The study used a sequential mixed methods approach anchored in a post-positivist paradigm. One of the key findings was that there were ill defined norms and standards at the *antecedent; process; moderator*



and *outcome* levels of the mentoring practices in schools.

The study thus confirmed one of the most enduring dilemmas in pre-service teacher education; that of the misalignment between theory and practice. It further demonstrated the difficulty of assuring the quality of mentoring in an environment that is weak in systems and structures for monitoring practical teaching. One of the examiners praised it for “...*the scholarship demonstrated in the thesis...*” Seven journal articles have been harvested from the thesis and they have all been submitted to accredited journals for peer review.

Uloma Nkpurunma Obi holds a National Certificate in Education from Nigeria, Bachelor of Education from University of Port Harcourt, Nigeria, and Master of Arts in Education from University of Bath, United Kingdom. She registered for PhD at the University of Fort Hare in 2011.

Her study is titled *Stakeholders' participation in curriculum development in four secondary schools*

*in Fort Beaufort Education District, Eastern Cape Province: towards a participatory curriculum model.* The study adopted an interpretive paradigm and case study design. It was guided by two main theories/models, namely the Taylor's model of Participatory Curriculum Development (PCD) and the Arnstein's Ladder of Participation. The study revealed that teachers and subject advisers participated in the process of curriculum development being mostly involved in the implementation stage and only marginally at the design and evaluation stages.

The study proposed an alternative participatory model focusing on enhanced impact. It recommended that teachers and subject advisers be involved at all stages of curriculum development where their decisions will have impact on the entire process.

All external examiners agreed that the study came up with valuable information and contributed new knowledge in curriculum development specifically teachers and subject advisors participation in the process. Three manuscripts based on her thesis are currently under review for publication.

## PROFILE

Chancellor, Honorable Justice Skweyiya, Vice-Chancellor, Dr Tom, and the entire University of Fort Hare community – it is an honour to present Dr Pumzile Mlambo-Ngcuka, for the honorary degree, Doctor of Social Science.

Pumzile Mlambo-Ngcuka was born on 3 November 1955 in Cleremont, Durban, KwaZulu-Natal.

She matriculated from Ohlange High School in Inanda, and enrolled at the National University of Lesotho for a Bachelor of Arts degree in Social Science and Education. After graduating she lectured at Mpumalanga Teachers College from 1980 – 1981, and also taught at Ohlange High School from 1981 – 1983. Thereafter Dr Mlambo-Ngcuka obtained qualifications in Gender Policy and Planning at the Development Planning Unit at the University College, London, in 1988. She furthermore obtained a Masters in Philosophy degree in Education Planning and Policy from the University of Cape Town (UCT) in 2003, and in the same year was awarded an Honorary Doctorate from the Witwatersrand Technikon. Dr Mlambo-Ngcuka has served as Chancellor of the Tshwane University of Technology since 2007. Dr Mlambo-Ngcuka's crowning academic and educational achievement was in 2013 when she was awarded a doctorate from the University of Warwick in England, for her work on using mobile

technologies to support Teacher Development in resource poor nations.

Dr Mlambo-Ngcuka has gained a prominent profile in South African society because of her proven contribution to national development and social cohesion at local, national, and international levels.

At local level, Dr Mlambo-Ngcuka began her professional life as a teacher in local schools in KwaZulu-Natal. She then became involved in community development, especially in the Western Cape where she was a founding member of the Gugulethu Community Development Corporation. She also worked for the World University Service South Africa (WUS) based in Cape Town. This body provided support to organizations promoting literacy, rural development and outreach to marginal communities.

At national level, Dr Mlambo-Ngcuka has served as a cabinet minister, and was also appointed as the first female Deputy-President of the Republic of South Africa. From 2005 to 2008, she served as Deputy President of South Africa, overseeing programmes to combat poverty and to bring the advantages of a growing economy to the poor, with a particular focus on women. Prior to this, she served as Minister of Minerals and Energy from 1999 to 2005, and as Deputy Minister in the Department of Trade and Industry from 1996 to 1999. She was a Member of Parliament from 1994 to 1996 as part of South Africa's first democratic government. She initiated, and was involved in, national economic development



programmes, such as the Accelerated and Shared Growth Initiative for South Africa (ASGISA), the Reconstruction and Development Programme (RDP), and the Joint Initiative on Priority Skills Acquisition (JIPSA).

At international level, she worked as a youth director for the Young Women's Christian Association (YWCA) Board in Geneva where she was involved in promoting the development of education in Africa, Asia, and the Middle East. She was also appointed as the Executive Director of the United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and Empowerment of Women (UN Women) on 10 July 2013.

Dr Mlambo-Ngcuka has met the University of Fort Hare criteria and values for the awarding of honorary degrees in an outstanding manner.

With regard to gender equality Dr Mlambo-Ngcuka has displayed exemplary values.

Dr Mlambo-Ngcuka's interest in gender equality dates back to her student days. A few years after completing her first degree in Social Science and Education at the National University of Lesotho, she also obtained a qualification in Gender Policy and Planning at the University College of London. She later became the President of the Natal Organization of Women under the auspices of the United Democratic Front. Later still, she worked for the YWCA in Geneva. She was also the Director of a Cape Town-based organization known as "TEAM," where she was involved in promoting economic self-reliance and skills training programmes among women in informal settlements and African Independent Churches. Dr Mlambo-Ngcuka also worked as a management consultant at Phumelela Services promoting race- and gender-sensitive

organizational development. As mentioned above, in February 2006, Dr Mlambo-Ngcuka became the first woman to be appointed Deputy President of the Republic of South Africa, and in July 2013, she was appointed as Executive Director of the United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and Empowerment of Women (UN Women). The fact that she has occupied many high-ranking positions that are not commonly occupied by women has no doubt also served to pioneer and to promote gender equality and non-sexism in society.

Dr Mlambo-Ngcuka's contribution to a South African society based on the values of human rights, democratic principles, and non-racialism is well-documented and well-known.

Dr Mlambo-Ngcuka has at various times been a staunch member of organizations that fought for human rights, democracy, and non-racialism. Examples of these are her engagement in the United Democratic Front (UDF) and the African National Congress (ANC) in the South African liberation struggle. She has also participated in many community development initiatives, and gender activist movements, that intersect with human rights, democracy, and non-racialism, and that operated under the umbrella of these bodies. Her commitment to the consolidation of democracy and human rights in South Africa have been outlined in her service in government above.

Dr Mlambo-Ngcuka has similarly made significant contributions to the progressive social, educational, and economic development of South African society.

Dr Mlambo-Ngcuka has been highly successful in promoting commitment to education. She has done this through personal example in the first



place. She has availed herself of every possible opportunity to further her studies. She has done this until she reached the pinnacle of education – the doctoral degree – at the age of 58 in 2013.

After vacating her cabinet positions, Dr Mlambo-Ngcuka established her own foundation – known as the Umlambo Foundation – to provide support to schools in impoverished areas. She did this in the hope of improving the quality of education in these schools, and thus helping in eradicating poverty in the country. The Foundation currently supports 33 schools in all provinces.

According to its Vision and Mission, the University of Fort Hare is not only committed to teaching and research excellence, but it also aspires to use the knowledge thus generated for the scientific, technological, and socio-economic development of our nation and the wider world. This is exactly what Dr Mlambo-Ngcuka has done for many years. She has equipped herself with a high level of education and has used that education not only for her own benefit, but for the benefit of society at large both in South Africa and elsewhere. She worked for the political emancipation of South Africa, which was of benefit not only to the people of this country but to the whole world. Her work in gender equality has been for the benefit, not only of Africa, but parts of Asia, and the Middle East as well. With her appointment as the Executive Director of the United Nations Entity for Gender Equality and Empowerment of Women, she now clearly works for the benefit of the whole world.

Chancellor, Honourable Justice Skweyiya, Vice Chancellor, Dr Tom, and the assembled University of Fort Hare community, for her lifelong commitment to, and participation in, the political struggle for democracy, for non-racialism, for non-sexism and gender equality, and for advancing

social cohesion and development, through raising the profile of education in South Africa, it is a distinct privilege for the University of Fort Hare to award the degree of *Doctor of Social Science* (D SocSc) (honoris causa) to Pumzile Mlambo-Ngcuka.

### **PROFILE**

The study investigated socio-linguistic factors contributing to the blurring of boundaries in the Zimbabwean press print media genres. It focused on the nature and trends of manifestation of the blurring and on the intricacies contributing to this state of affairs. The study was informed by the increasing erasure of demarcations between genres in the press print media in Zimbabwe.

The study established that there are socio-political, socio-linguistic, socio-economic as well as technological factors at play in the blurring of boundaries. News makers give in to pressure from different sources in the process of producing news, thus allowing their stories to often respond to factors that are otherwise extra-textual and in the process flouting and blurring generic boundaries. Different social players have a hold over the media, either through legislative and political powers or through ownership patterns. As a result, boundaries between traditionally distinct genres in the print news media in Zimbabwe have blurred.

Following these findings, the study recommended that understanding of the relationship between genres be reconfigured to incorporate the extra-textual components of language usage; taking into

account the new relationships now in existence between the potentially different genres in the press print media.

### **PROFILE**

The study investigated the Crosslinguistic Interface between English and Selected Indigenous Languages in Zimbabwe namely Shona and Ndebele. The study critically examined how Shona and Ndebele have influenced non-native English written production through analysing written discourses for crosslinguistic phenomena. The thesis employed a qualitative case study approach to analyse excerpts from four literary texts written by Zimbabwean authors and 40 essays written by university final year undergraduate students.

The research findings indicated that all linguist domains were vulnerable to crosslinguistic influence to varying degrees. While deviating from Standard British English norms, the English that



has resulted from an interface of Shona and Ndebele with English is a functional variety regardless of phonological, lexical, morpho-syntactic, semantic and pragmatic deviations from Standard British English and resemblance to Shona and Ndebele. While illustrating the presence of crosslinguistic influences across all linguistic domains, Zimbabwean English remained largely comprehensible and communicative. The existence of a Zimbabwean variety of English and its functionality in communication was a reflection of language evolution and change indicating the capacity for Zimbabwean English to stand out as one of the African Englishes.

The findings further demonstrated that incorporation of indigenous features into English indicated the need to affirm indigenous identity and pride of ownership of Zimbabwean English. It would benefit Zimbabweans if the power of indigenous languages can be harnessed through policy planning to reverse the marginalization of indigenous languages in the private and public spheres.

### **PROFILE**

The candidate is a holder of a Master of Social Science degree in Sociology from the University of Fort Hare. The core argument of her doctoral thesis is that the intersection between gender and IKS has two opposing possibilities for food security.

On the one hand, through the various roles of women in the application of IKS in rural areas, the interplay of IK and gender relations can operate to enhance the likelihood of achieving sustainable rural livelihoods and hence food security. On the other hand, gender oppression, subjugation, exclusion and marginalization through various practices such as the utilization of discriminatory African patriarchal cultural values and norms can inhibit the application of the rich folk knowledge reservoir of ideas held by women in food production processes.

Key illustrative examples of the constraints imposed by cultural traditions that pose problems for the realization of sustainable rural livelihoods are cultural practices which prohibit women to inter alia own and inherit land. These cultural practices also deprive women the liberty to make their own decisions without the consultation of men despite being sole providers of their own households. This has been found to be true for



rural households in Khambashe in the Eastern Cape. The examiners have found the possibility of enhancing a waning IKS as presenting a potential solution to food security.
