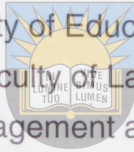

**ADDAM Billey Bright**

#### PROFILE

Billey Bright Kwadwo Addam was born in Accra, Ghana where he did his school and undergraduate education. He came to South Africa in 1994 and joined the Department of Basic Education. He taught mathematics and science in High schools and rose through the ranks to become an Acting Principal in 2006. Mr Addams holds a BSc. in chemistry and an M.Ed degree in Science Education from Rhodes University.

In 2011, he enrolled for a PhD in Education at the University of Fort Hare. His thesis focussed on the use of ICT in teaching and learning in Higher Education. One of the main findings was that lecturers showed some ambivalence in approach which was influenced by in their ontological and epistemological positions informing their practices.

On the one extreme there were lecturers who learned towards the instruction paradigm and who used ICT as a tool for transmission of knowledge. On the other there were lecturers operating within the learning paradigm, who showed awareness of the need to elicit discovery through ICT.

The study concluded that integration of ICT in teaching and learning cannot be understood without exploring the ontological and epistemological

orientations as well as theoretical frameworks that inform lecturers' practices. Two journal articles have been drafted from this thesis.

#### PROFILE

Verity registered for a Doctor of Philosophy Degree in Education at the University of Fort Hare in 2012. Her study adopted a post-positivist paradigm and used the mixed methods approach and concurrent design as the operational framework. The study was guided by the Bernstein framework of Vertical and Horizontal discourses. It established that amongst others, the lecturers were not competent enough to deliver Clothing and Textiles (CT) curriculum. Also the institutions lacked relevant equipment and machinery to deliver CT curriculum, and had no meaningful relationship with the relevant industry.

As a result, the universities were producing students who lacked the hands-on skills necessary for them to make a meaningful contribution into the economy.

The study thus recommends an integrated approach that bridges the gap between the vertical and horizontal discourses of CT curriculum. Such an approach would lead to meaningful collaboration between the universities and the industry, from curriculum design, quality assurance, Work-Integrated Learning; and Assessment. The study therefore suggests an alternative model (Verity's Clothing and Textiles Curriculum delivery model) which the researcher believes will ameliorate the situation in universities.

The three examiners agreed that this was a well substantiated piece of work. Verity has published four articles from the thesis in international peer-reviewed journals.

**PROFILE**

Florence Rutendo Mudehwe was born in Zimbabwe, where she did her primary and secondary education. In 2000 she graduated with a B.A general degree from the University of Zimbabwe. In 2005 she moved to the United Kingdom where, in 2010, she graduated with a master's degree in Teaching English to Speakers Of other Languages Studies of Aston University.

In 2012 she registered for a PhD in Education at the University of Fort Hare. Using Margaret Archer's (2010) morphogenetic analysis her study focussed on the way dialogic pedagogy can help first year university students facing the structural constraints characterised as the 'articulation gap' to exercise agency and transform it to create enabling learning experiences.

One of the main findings was that the pedagogical architecture of the Life Knowledge and Action, grounding programme, promoted liberating dialogue in varied ways depending on the level at which it was carried out on the pedagogical architecture. Evidence of this was strong at the most basic level; and diminishing dialogical moments as one moved to higher levels of the architecture where power dynamics seemed to undermine free dialogue. One examiner commented that "...the thesis is a huge contribution towards an understanding of the learning experiences of first year students in South Africa..."

Results from the study revealed that export diversification has positive influences on economic growth.

#### PROFILE

Born in Butterworth in 1981, this scholar started her educational journey in the 'former Ciskei' at Tolofiyeni BC Primary School in 1986 and matriculated in East London at Cambridge High School in 1998.

Bukelwa registered for her DPhil in Information Systems in 2011. Her doctoral thesis focused on the Information Security behaviour of student mobile phone users. Acknowledging that the mobile phone has become a necessity for many students, the study identified the problem of poor Information Security behaviour emanating from a lack of Information Security awareness, which exposes student mobile phone users to Information Security threats with the potential consequence of students becoming targets of mobile phone crime.

The Action Research study focused on using awareness in order to influence mobile phone security behaviour of students in a developmental university, resulting, in turn, in the development of a

mobile phone Information Security culture.

A key finding of this study was that the security behaviour exhibited by mobile phone users is influenced by a combination of Information Security awareness and Information Security behavioural intention. The study concluded by proposing a behaviour profile forecasting framework based on predefined security behavioural profiles. Bukelwa has published four papers based on this study.

Shehu Folaranmi Gbolahan Yusuf was born in Nigeria. He obtained his BSc (Agricultural Education) from Bendel State University (Now, Ambrose Alli University, Ekpoma) and M Agric (Agricultural Extension and Rural Development) from the Federal University of Agriculture, Abeokuta, Nigeria. He registered for his PhD programme in 2011 at the University of Fort Hare.

His research focused on investigating the potential value and application of the modelling of indigenous poultry production systems as poverty alleviation programmes. An agricultural extension evaluation perspective was successfully applied in the study and an important contribution was made to the development of parameters for the use of indigenous poultry production systems in poverty alleviation. The study identified and characterized the local technical skills inherent in resource-poor farmers in the management of indigenous poultry production (IPP).

An IPP model was developed with an inclusive cooperative society (Abafuyi Benkukhu Zemveli). The model was based on a tripod stand for sustainability revolving round capacity development, equity contributions and marketing channels. The three examiners praised this project for its pragmatic approach to address poverty. Three articles have been accepted for publication from the study in

His research was focused on documenting and validating ethno-veterinary practices and remedies small-holder farmers in Zimbabwe, use in the control of ticks and dermatophilosis, a skin disease of cattle. He further investigated how the interface of *Amblyomma variegatum* and *A. hebraeum* affected the epidemiology of bovine dermatophilosis at selected small-holder areas in North-West Zimbabwe, and the associated risk factors.

During the study, he used a structured questionnaire survey, to document the practices and remedies, and both *in vitro* and *in vivo* experiments to validate and justify the use of the documented ethno-veterinary practices. The results of her study showed that regenerating *G. perpensa* through rhizome segments, pre-treating the seeds by mechanical scarification, plant part substitution, and micropropagation are efficient methods for conserving *G. perpensa*. Her studies have further highlighted the need to conserve our endangered indigenous plant resources before they become extinct.

In his PhD, Alen studied the use of indigenous knowledge systems and scientific approaches on soil classification and land evaluation for identification and delineation of high potential soil of Nkonkobe Municipality. The study revealed complementarity between farmers' assessment and scientific approaches on the cropping potential. Soil factors affecting erosion, the main soil factor affecting cropping potential, were largely influenced by climate. Contents of fine and very fine sand and exchangeable sodium were more influential in arid and semi-arid climate while clay mineralogy, particularly kaolinite and sesquioxide, was dominated in sub-humid and humid areas. Under rainfed conditions, cow pea and sorghum were the most adapted crops while potato and maize were marginally suitable, although preferred.

The thesis, which utilizes a social resilience theoretical approach, examines the differing forms of child-care in the two study areas and draws out the significant similarities and differences between the forms of community and home based care within extended family networks. One of its major contributions is the way that it brings typically “off the radar” people and their concerns, who are generally neither seen nor heard in mainstream public and academic discourse into significant focus through a model of meaningful and ethical research practice. The examiners recommend her work be widely published. She is married to Dr Timothy Sibanda and they have two children.

She then enrolled for a doctoral degree in the same department. Her thesis which is entitled 'Radio Broadcasting, Policy and Local Language Revitalisation in Zimbabwe' examines the role of indigenous language radio broadcasting in preserving minority indigenous languages in Zimbabwe. The study also interrogates the role of radio broadcasting policy in promoting indigenous languages use in radio broadcasting in Zimbabwe.

The study established that there are numerous weaknesses in the current policy, and that these weaknesses are impacting negatively on the role of indigenous language radio stations in protecting the various threatened languages in the country. His research project focussed on Information literacy (IL), which is the ability to find and use information in an environment where almost everyone is a producer and consumer (pronsumer) of information. South African University libraries have developed IL programmes for students with a view to alleviating challenges associated with the ethical and legal use of information. Despite the efforts by South African Universities, Mathew believed that most students

were still not becoming adequately information literate. Against this backdrop, Mathew sought to analyse the content and delivery methods of IL programmes at two South African Universities.

The study found out that the two institutions used IL standards widely adopted internationally. However, unique challenges facing students who graduated mostly from underprivileged schools were not well addressed. Such challenges included IT skills and limited contact time. The research has five publishable outcomes, one of which will be presented at a European Conference on Information Literacy in Croatia, October 2014.

The research was premised on the fact that Gutu residents have succumbed to severe recurrent droughts which have culminated into the residents realising poor harvests. Obert sought to establish whether IK can still be employed in modern agricultural practices. A survey research methodology was employed to gather information on the Gutu district residents' views concerning IK for sustainable livelihoods. The study found out that there have been major shifts in the manner people perceive IK. Locals have abandoned traditional crops in favour of commercial crops which are associated with prosperity. The challenges are a result of the older and younger generations believing that IK is associated with primitivism and no longer relevant in the present day.

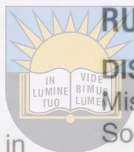

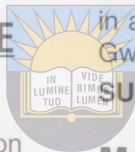

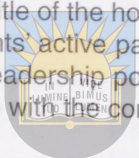
