

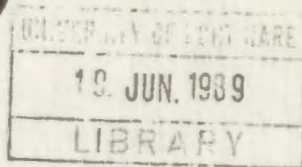

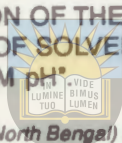

HENDRIK SCHALK THERON

Hendrik Schalk Theron was born in Wynberg, Cape Town in 1945 and completed his schooling at Hertzogville High School in the Orange Free State in 1962.

He obtained the Bachelor of Arts degree at the University of the Orange Free State in 1965 and an Honours degree in 1969 from the same university. In 1977 he was awarded a Masters degree from the University of Port Elizabeth.

He worked for 9 years at the Department of Manpower in South Africa as a psychologist and held the rank of Chief Professional Officer when he left in 1977. From 1977 to 1978 he was a lecturer in the Department of Psychology at the University of the North.

In 1979 he did psychological and research work centring around the screening of employees in the mining industry with the Anglo American Corporation.

In 1980 Mr Theron became the first Student Counsellor to be appointed at the University of Fort Hare and in 1982 he was appointed as Director of the Student Counselling Service. He is a registered Counselling Psychologist with the Ciskei Medical Council and the South African Medical and Dental Council.

The research for his thesis centred on identifying factors which could be used to predict the academic performance of students at the University of Fort Hare and from this to draw up expectancy charts for use in counselling students.

LINDA RUSSELL

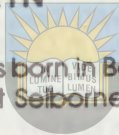
Linda Russell was born and educated in England where she obtained GCE "O" and "A" levels Certificates. She received her B Sc Honours and Post Graduate Certificate of Education at Exeter University.

In 1975 she took up employment at the University of Fort Hare in various technical posts until 1981 when she was appointed as lecturer in the Department of Geology. In 1982 she was awarded the M Sc degree for her dissertation entitled: "Geomorphology of the coastal limestones at the De Hoop Nature Reserve, Southern Cape".

The research for the thesis involved an analysis of Karst Surface land-forms and this is the first comprehensive account of karst in the coastal limestones of the Cape Region.

This is a significant contribution to knowledge of the regional geomorphology of South Africa.

GIDEON JOHANNES STEYN



Gideon Johannes Steyn was born in Barkly East, Cape Province in 1935 and matriculated in 1953 at Seiborne College, in East London.

He obtained a BSc Agric degree at the University of Stellenbosch in 1959 and a B Sc Honours degree in Agricultural Extension at the University of Pretoria. In 1982 he obtained an MSc Agric degree at the University of Fort Hare.

Mr Steyn was employed by the Department of Agricultural Technical Services in 1960 as Professional Officer stationed in Queenstown. He was transferred in 1962 and was promoted to Senior Professional Officer in 1963.

From 1969 to 1977 he was employed as Chief Professional Officer in the Republic of Transkei. In 1978 Mr Steyn was appointed as Principal of Fort Cox College of Agriculture and Forestry. In 1980 he joined the staff of the University of Fort Hare as lecturer in the Department of Agricultural Extension and Rural Development. He was promoted to senior lecturer in 1983.

The research for his thesis centred on analysing farming systems in two areas of the Peddie District in the Republic of Ciskei. This is the first time that research of this nature has been undertaken in the area.

GEORGE GLAESER ANDERSON MUNNIK

George Glaeser Anderson Munnik was born at Dordrecht in the Eastern Cape on 8 November 1921, and attended school first in Cape Town, then in Dordrecht, and obtained a First Class Matriculation at the South African College High School, Cape Town, in 1938, where he was awarded both a SACS Merit Scholarship and the C C Silberbauer Scholarship. From school he enrolled at the University of Cape Town, obtaining a BA degree in 1941 and the LL B in 1943. Besides attending to his Law studies he was active in student affairs at the University, becoming Chairman of both the Debating Society and the Dramatic Society, and winning the Best Speaker's Medal. In his final year he was elected Vice-President of the Students' Representative Council.

The young graduate worked with the Attorneys' firm Dumat, Pitts and Blaine for two years, and practised at the Johannesburg Bar from February 1946, where he had a very busy general practice. He took silk and became Queen's Counsel in October 1958 at the young age of 36. Clearly destined for the Bench, Advocate Munnik was appointed Acting Judge in the Transvaal Provincial Division less than two years later on 1 August 1960 and again in 1961. Early the following year he was appointed Permanent Judge of the Eastern Cape Division of the Supreme Court, on which Bench he served for eleven years with his headquarters in Grahamstown.

In 1972 he started a Transkei High Court at the invitation of the then Minister of Justice of South Africa, becoming the first Chief Justice of a Homeland High Court, as it was then known, on 1 August 1973. With the coming of independence on 26 October 1976 the status of the Court was changed to the Supreme Court, and he became the first Chief Justice of Transkei. He occupied this post until 3 July 1981, when he became Judge President of the Cape of Good Hope Provincial Division of the Supreme Court, a post which he still occupies.

During his many years of public service Judge Munnik has, in addition to his other interests, shown a consistent interest in tertiary education, serving on the highest controlling bodies of five universities, namely the Councils of the Universities of the Witwatersrand, Port Elizabeth, Rhodes University, the University of Transkei, and the University of Fort Hare. To give an example of his devotion to duty, he has served the University of Fort Hare Council for nearly twenty years (having been appointed in February 1970), serving as Chairman for the last ten years, a position which he still holds. This outstanding record of service marks a most significant contribution to tertiary education in Southern Africa.

During this period on the Fort Hare Council Judge Munnik has revealed many of the qualities which have led to success in other walks of life. Eloquent, with a keen and ready sense of humour and a quickness of repartee which have lightened many a lengthy Council meeting, he has also given Council the benefit of a quick and incisive mind, and the ability to handle the most complex and sensitive issues with tact, insight, and sound judgment. His wide experience in public life has made him a most versatile leader of the University Council.

Judge Munnik has inherited a love of the soil and naturally turned his talents to part-time farming. His success in this field led to his appointment as President of the Friesland Cattle Breeders' Association in 1979, and the continuation in this high office to the present date. He breeds Friesland cattle and Dohne Merino sheep on the family farm "Bothashoek" near Dordrecht, something in which he also excels, as is evidenced in his winning of a Gold Cup at the Rand Show in 1973 for the Champion Dairy Breed Cow. He also serves as Administrator's Representative on the Western Province Executive of the Jockey Club of South Africa.

Judge Munnik's roots lie deep in the history of South Africa. His grandfather was Senator G G Munnik, a Magistrate under the Cape Government and later a Landdrost in the South African Republic, who entered politics and was a member of the first Transvaal Legislative Assembly. Later, on the formation of the Union of South Africa in 1910, he became a member of the first Senate, a position which he held until his death in 1935. Judge Munnik's father was a Member of Parliament for Brakpan and Vrededorp from 1920 to 1933.

Judge Munnik married Marie van der Merwe, whose father was an Attorney from Heilbron in the Orange Free State. They have two daughters, one son, and nine grandchildren.

The University of Fort Hare is honoured to have enjoyed the services of such a wise counsellor and loyal friend.
