KURIAH FRANCIS KING'E

PROFILE

It is well known that restoration of habitats altered by nutrient enrichment is difficult, if not impossible. Research into early warning systems of such habitat degradation is thus of paramount importance for establishing preventive measures as management options. Mr. Kuriah's work was aimed at developing a novel approach to assessing river health using stable isotopes. The approach used in his research is innovative and makes a new contribution to the topic of land use impacts on water in a watershed context. Using stable isotopes to link potential nutrient sources to water quality and the food chain uptake has not previously been attempted in Africa. Mr. Kuriah's research is particularly challenging because of the complexity of factors that can influence the isotope ratios.

An improved understanding of anthropogenic effects on river ecosystems requires a new level of information on the ecological and biochemical significance of different sources of organic matter among and within aquatic ecosystems. Mr. Kuriah made a significant advancement in developing a new way of assessing land use, urban development and wastewater-driven eutrophication in riverine and estuarine ecosystems.

MUREGERERA HILDA

A PROFILE

Hilda Muregerera was born in Zimbabwe on the 8th December 1978. She completed her secondary education at Waddilove High School in 1996. She registered at the University of Zimbabwe where she obtained a Bachelor of Science Honours degree in Agricultural Economics in 2000 and a Master of Science in Agriculture degree in Agricultural Economics in 2002 at the University of Fort Hare. Hilda later registered at the University of Fort Hare for the degree of Doctor of Philosophy in Agricultural Economics.

The title of Hilda's thesis is "The importance of communal rangelands: a case study of three districts in Zimbabwe". Communal rangelands are an important source of livelihood goods and services to many households that reside in the rural areas. The focus of this study was to analyse the importance to the local households in Zimbabwe of communal rangelands, which are continually under threat from the increasing human and animal population and the lack of management. This study provides insights of the different uses of communal rangeland goods and services to local households. The one external examiner was of the opinion that studies on valuation of rangelands are relatively rare, not only in Zimbabwe and southern Africa, but in the rest of the

developing world. He had no doubt that the thesis made an original contribution to the discipline of Agricultural Economics and related fields. It would also provide valuable information to policy-makers and researchers in Zimbabwe and provide useful benchmarks to researchers in other countries.

Hilda lectured Agricultural Economics at the University of Zimbabwe from 2005 to 2006. She presently lives in Johannesburg with her husband and two children.

GWAZE FRANCISCA RUMOSA

PROFILE

Francisca Rumosa Gwaze was born in Mashonaland Central, Zimbabwe. After obtaining her Diploma in Education as a Mathematics teacher in 1993/4, she then graduated with a BSc Honours degree in Agriculture (Animal Science) from the University of Zimbabwe in 1999. Having worked as a tutor for three years, she later graduated with an MSc degree (with merit and a University Book Prize) in Animal Science in 2004. In September 2004, she joined the Faculty of Veterinary Science (University of Zimbabwe) as a lecturer up to December 2005. She currently is engaged by the Department of Livestock and Pasture Science as a postdoctoral fellow.

Francisca registered for a PhD in Animal Science in January 2006. Her thesis focused on evaluation of production practices, constraints and production efficiency of communal goats of the Eastern Cape Province. In addition, she also determined nutritional and health status of goats raised by resource-poor communal farmers in the Eastern Cape. Her thesis integrated qualitative and quantitative information into a well balanced study that indicates the complex socio-economic and production constraints communal farmers are challenged with in their daily livelihoods. Her work, therefore, encompassed field work and laboratory analyses that ranged from standard procedures to highly technological analyses using state-of-the-art equipment.

She has revealed that low kidding rate, high disease and gastrointestinal parasite infestation, high kid mortality, helminthes, ownership of a few bucks are the major constraints to goat productivity. The study also revealed that the references values of blood parameters that were developed from exotic breeds are not applicable in monitoring health and nutritional status of indigenous goats. Her work has opened many avenues in shaping rural development programmes in communal areas using goats, and in increasing interest in goat research.

Peer-reviewed papers have been published in recognized journals, such as Small Ruminants Research and Tropical Animal Health and Production. Two articles have been accepted for publication whilst five are at various stages of publication. Francisca is happily married with two daughters, Kudzai and Melody

She then proceeded to the University of Ibadan, Nigeria to study towards a BSc in Agricultural Biology at the Faculty of Agriculture and Forestry from 1988 to 1994. In 1997 she obtained her Master of Science degree majoring in Entomology from the Department of Agricultural Biology, Faculty of Agriculture and Forestry, University of Ibadan, Nigeria.

She then proceeded to do her PhD in Phyto-medicine at the Department of Botany, University of Fort Hare in South Africa. She has attended numerous scientific conferences and workshops in different places which include Botswana, Ghana, Netherlands, Nigeria and South Africa.

For her PhD programme, she worked on the use of essential oils for the control of *Sitophilus Zeamais*, a pest of stored maize grains. Before submitting the thesis for evaluation, Oluwakemi Odeyemi published six articles from this work in international journals. She also presented part of her work in seminar papers at national conferences.

Leocadia Zhou was born in Zvishavane, Midlands Province, in Zimbabwe. She completed her primary and secondary education in Masvingo District, and her Bachelor of Arts Degree at the University of Zimbabwe in 2000. Leocadia Zhou then enrolled at the University of Fort Hare, graduating with the Honours Degree in Geography in 2001 and the Master of Philosophy Degree (Environmental Studies) in 2003.

Leocadia Zhou's doctoral research focused on Tourism Policy, Biodiversity Conservation and Management: A Case Study of the Kruger National Park. The main focus of the thesis concerned policy framework formulation and implementation. She examined the elusive goal of policy integration for complex environmental problems. One of the External Examiners commended Leocadia Zhou on her outstanding ability to structure a difficult research endeavour.

Leocadia Zhou participated and presented research papers in numerous workshops and conferences, both nationally and internationally.

MAISTRY SAVATHRIE MARGIE

PROFILE

Savathrie Margie Maistry is originally from the north coast of Kwa Zulu Natal and moved to the Eastern Cape Province in 2001 after living and working in New Zealand for ten years. While her children were young, she worked full time and studied part-time to obtain a four year degree in Social Work through UNISA. She qualified as a social worker in 1983 and obtained a distinction in Sociology as one of her major subjects and in Community Development practice in the 4th year. As her first professional job, Margie took on the position of community development worker with a child and family welfare organization in Phoenix, Durban. This position was one of the first two officially approved community development worker positions by the apartheid government in the early 1980s.

Margie began her Masters degree in Women and Gender Studies at the then University of Natal, Durban and completed the degree at Waikato University, Hamilton, New Zealand in 1994 with distinction. She lectured at Waikato University for a few years, mainly in Human and Community Development, before occupying the position of Africa Programme Manager for an international development agency based in New Zealand. On her return to South Africa in 2001,

she was employed as a lecturer by Rhodes University, Department of Social Development, East London campus with the main responsibility for the Masters degree specialization in Community Development and for courses in community development in the Social Work degree programmes.

In her current capacity as lecturer in the Department of Social Work and Social Development, University of Fort Hare, East London Campus, Margie introduced a one year Certificate Programme in Social and Community Development in 2007 and one of the outcomes of her research is that she is currently developing a four year degree curriculum in Social and Community Development to be introduced at UFH in 2011.

Collective action against poverty through community development as an intervention strategy is being currently prioritized by the national government in the current context of democracy in South Africa. The Integrated Service Delivery Model (2006) of the National Department of Social Development identifies social work and community development as the two core functions of social welfare services. In the past community development was not encouraged because of its potential for socio-economic and political change. Social Work education mainly focused on provision of services to individuals through the casework method. Education for community development and the education of a new generation of community development professionals

at the higher education level was the focus of Margie's doctoral thesis.

Given that social and community development are relatively new fields of study and profession in the current democratic context of South Africa and the lack of a well established frame of reference for social and community development, part of the research was conducted in the states of Kerala and Andhra Pradesh in India which have a longer history in the developmental approach to welfare and community development education. Lessons learnt from their successes and challenges are considered of value for the South African context.

The study has contributed to new knowledge in the following areas:

- An integrated approach to the development of a curriculum framework for social and community development education
- Philosophy and theory for community development and community development education which emphasizes the integration of individual and collective consciousness for community well-being through the integral and unitary framework for social and community development
- Integral and human values education for a new generation of ethical community development professionals
- Conceptualization of social and community development for the current context of democracy in South Africa.

Margie is currently involved in the development of policy for Community Development by the National Department of Social Development and is on the SAQA Standards Generating Body (SGB) for Community Development.

MAKURA ALFRED HENRY

PROFILE

Alfred Henry Makura, a resident of Gutu district, was born in the Mwenezi district of Masvingo province in Zimbabwe. He did his primary education at Makawire School in Mwenezi and his secondary education at Gokomere in Masvingo Province, and Thekwani high schools. After the closure of the latter high school due to the raging war of independence, Alfred went to Luveve high school in Bulawayo where he completed his secondary education in 1978. Thereafter, he left the country to seek refuge in Botswana, before he proceeded to Swaziland.

On arrival in Swaziland, he enrolled with the then University of Botswana and Swaziland, where he studied for, and acquired a Diploma in Agricultural Education at Luyengo campus in 1982, on a UNESCO/UNDP bursary. He later, in 1983, moved to Lesotho, where he registered at the National University of Lesotho for a Bachelor of Arts with Education degree, majoring in Geography, Development Studies and Education. He briefly taught at three high schools in and outside Zimbabwe. From 1986, Alfred lectured in Agriculture, Social Studies, Environmental Science, Education and Physical Education at Morgenster Teachers College (an associate college of the University of Zimbabwe). However, in 1999 Alfred's quest for more knowledge pushed him to register for and

obtain a Master of Education degree with the National University of Lesotho. Between 2000 and early 2006 he lectured at the Zimbabwe Open University (Z.O.U) in several Education courses/modules at both B.Ed. and M.Ed. degree levels. In 2006 two of his teaching modules were published: Professional Studies (2006) and Interactive Teaching and Learning of Agriculture for the B.Ed. (Secondary) degree programme. In February 2006 Alfred was admitted to read for his Doctor of Philosophy degree at the University of Fort Hare, and was fortunate to secure a supervisor linked bursary under the supervision of Prof. M.J. Matshazi from the Govan Mbeki Research and Development Centre for which he is greatly indebted. Since 2006, Alfred has published five journal articles, three of these in respected International journals. He has presented several papers at regional and International conferences in South Africa and Tanzania and was invited to present a paper in Syria in 2008. His 2008 PhD thesis entitled "An Investigation into Leadership and Management Styles Exhibited By Female Primary School Heads and Their Impact on School Effectiveness: A Case Study of Masvingo Education District in Zimbabwe" was praised by the external assessors, one of whom challenged Alfred to publish papers from the findings. The thesis argues that leadership is gendered and occurs in a

gendered context. The use of psychometric instruments such as the Leader Behavior Description Questionnaire (LBDQ) and the Bem Sex Role Inventory Test (BSRI) in his study revealed that female school heads have adopted the agentic styles of males though their personal narrations reveal otherwise. Broadly, the study showed that females are effective leaders who tend to use the androgynous leadership style. Alfred's thesis implores Governments and organisations to appoint more females into leadership positions not as tokenism but as a nation-building imperative.
